IADVL Academy Report: 16th July to 15th December 2020


IADVL Academy has gone through another successful year with the support of IADVL EC, though the activities remained limited on the web due to the prevailing conditions. This year marked the initiation of the IADVL Digital Academy platform at https://iadvl.mediknit.org/. This provided the opportunity for many academic activities on the web that could be perused by IADVL members across the country without being limited to a state or a zone.

Applications were invited for new observership centers and candidates, new centers for IADVL training courses, MIDDERMACON 2020 Academy sessions, DERMACON Orations, Dr B.V. Satyanarayana best thesis award 2020 and editors and authors for IADVL books. Application forms have been specifically designed by Academy members (and approved by the EC) to allow objective evaluation, using a scoring sheet to ensure selection by merit. Confidential evaluation of SIG functioning, verification visits to new observership centers and monitoring of e-library usage were regularly performed. Formal feedbacks were obtained for PGCONs, basic and advanced PGPDTs, Research Methodology and how to publish workshop and from Observership candidates.

CONFERENCES, CMEs & WORKSHOPS

IADVL Research Methodology and How to Publish Workshop-2020

A central full day workshop on the web on research methodology and how to publish was held on 01.11.2020. This workshop was coordinated by SIG Dermatology Clinical Research (Dr Brijesh Nair, Coordinator; Dr Ajithkumar K, Convener). A quiz was held as a part of the program with enthusiastic participation.




IADVL- Aesthetics workshops




Urticaria webinars


IADVL- IPCA PRP workshops

Four workshops covering all aspects of PRP were held on 23.08.2020, 13.09.2020, 04.10.2020 and 18.10.2020. The content as standardized slide deck was developed by the IADVL PRP taskforce members (Dr Kavish Chouhan, Coordinator and Dr Ankur Talwar, Convener). IADVL Resident Program (PGCON)

Postgraduate conference (PGCON) was conducted centrally on the web unlike zonal conferences in other years. This was held on 19.09.2020 and 20.09.2020. This program was supported by an educational grant from Intas Pharmaceuticals. Faculties and delegates (Provisional and Life IADVL members), from across the country participated and a positive feedback was received from the Postgraduate participants. A quiz was held as a part of the program with enthusiastic participation.



MIDDERMACON-2020

SIG Pruritus and SIG Trichology and Hair Transplantation and two Academy sessions on Lichenoid disorders and Non-venereal genital dermatoses/ HIV were held during MIDDERMACON-2020, at Chennai, Tamilnadu (on the web). The faculty for the Academy sessions were by invited applications.

e-DERMACON 2021

This year is special in many ways, one of them being that the IADVL Academy is also contributing as the scientific Committee of e-DERMACON 2021. The pre-conference workshops (14 in number) will be held on 31.01.2021. A half day CME on clinical dermatology, procedural dermatology and STI/ leprosy will be held on 05.02.2021. Conference will be held on 06.02.2021 and 07.02.2021. Eighteen international faculty and national faculty of repute, including several young colleagues, will be participating in scientific deliberations. The scientific program is being given final touches.

SIGs (Aesthetics, Lasers, Dermatosurgery, Leprosy and pediatric dermatology) are participating in the SIG sessions at e-DERMACON 2021. The speakers for the IADVL Research Grant session were finalized.



IADVL OBSERVERSHIPS

Ninety-three observers were selected for observerships in 2020. Eighty-one of them were upto 35 years of age (4 weeks observership with Rs.10,000 stipend) and 12 were of more than 35 years in age (2 weeks Observership without stipend). So far, only 3 candidates could complete their observership due to the prevailing situation. Rest of them can complete their observership by June 30, 2021 as per approval of EC 2020. Ten candidates withdrew from joining the observership due to personal reasons.

For Observerships 2020, 211 applications were received for the 35 centers. Evaluation is being caried out and the list of selected candidates will be announced before e-DERMACON 2021.

IADVL International Dermatopathology Obseverships

None of the candidates selected for IADVL International Dermatopathology Observership in 2020 could initiate it. The candidates have communicated with the respective program directors and are rescheduling it in 2021. Fresh applications for observership in 2021 were not invited.

IADVL Training Courses

As per approval of AGBM held during DERMACON 2020 at Pune, IADVL training courses in Dermatopathology, Hair Restoration, Procedural Dermatology and Pediatric Dermatology were to be initiated. The basic differences with ongoing observerships is that the training is as per structured curriculum, longer duration of 3 months and formal assessment during and at the completion of the course. Applications for centers willing to hold these training courses have been received. After evaluation of the applications by IADVL Academy and physical verification of the shortlisted centers, applications will be sought from IADVL members interested in these training courses for 2021.

Research projects and Grants

IADVL Research Grants-2020

Applications were invited from members of IADVL for research grants for projects in Dermatology, Leprosy and STIs. A total of 26 research proposals were submitted by the IADVL members for research grant for the year 2020. The comments of initial review by the members of SIG Dermatology Clinical research were communicated to the Principal Investigators. All the revised proposals were discussed and scored by the jury members during the IADVL Academy meeting held on 13th June 2019. Various aspects including funding, sample size, methodology, novelty, feasibility and ethical issues were taken into consideration while deciding the research grant. Based on the scores obtained 10 proposals were shortlisted for IADVL Research Grants for 2020. The investigators of all the shortlisted proposals were informed regarding the results of jury meeting along with jury's comments related to budget allocations and research methodology. Based on the satisfactory modification of shortlisted proposals the final list of 7 research proposals eligible for IADVL Research Grant 2020 were announced on 03.10.2020 along with a request to submit necessary documents for disbursement of first instalment of grant. The investigators of the non-selected proposals were also informed with the reasons for not making the final list. Till now investigators of 1 research project has submitted all the necessary documents and

were given first instalment of the grant.




