Dr Madura C has been included in SIG Dermatosurgery as Dr Umashankar Nagaraju resigned following his election as National Honorary Secretary General.

### **IADVL Observerships**

A total of 22 centers have been chosen as observership centers for 2018 of which 6 have been initiated in 2018. One of the centres of 2017 has declined to take observers for 2018. The dermatopathology observership programme director for CMC Vellore has been changed from Dr.Renu George to Dr.Sussane Pulimood.

applicants had applied for 22 centres for 2018. Applications for each center were evaluated by two Academy members or SIG Coordinators independently using a scoring sheet. Top scored candidates were selected as per the number of candidates allotted to each centre. Based on this evaluation, 109 were selected (98<35 years of age, 11 > 35 years). After the AGBM approval at DERMACON Kochi, candidates were provided their choice of observership, and contacted to confirm their acceptance of programme. In order to decrease the attrition rate of observership, the observers were asked to send email of their acceptance and also instructed to inform the exact dates of observership by March end after coordinating with the Directors.

A total of 106 observers have finally accepted to complete the observership this year; 9 were of >35 years of 2 week observership without stipend and 97 were <35 years for 4 week observership with Rs.10,000 stipend. Dr Sindhura Manne has been selected for the Smt. Mayadevi Observership in Dermatosurgery under DrSubrata Malakar in the Rita Skin Foundation, Kolkata and Dr Ranjana Benniwal for the Dr P B Haribhakti Observership in Dermatopathology under Dr Uday Khopkar in KEM Hospital & Seth GS Medical College, Mumbai.

The feedback forms for both the observers and centre have been modified. A WhatsApp group has been started for ease of communication which include the programme directors, observers, the chairperson, convener and co-ordinators of the observership programme.

Currently 3 have Completed and 5 have ongoing observership.

#### **DERMAGYAN – IADVL online lecture series 2018**

Dermagyan lecture on 'Antinuclear Antibody Tests: Rationale and Clinical

Utilities" by Debabrata Bandyopadhyay released on website on 28th February.

Applications were invited for 18 proposed DERMAGYAN- IADVL Online Lectures for 2018-2019, that is being continued with an educational grant from Alkem Pharmaceuticals. The 6 received applications were evaluated by the Academy members by the use of a pre-decided scoring sheet to select the suitable candidate and topic. A speaker was selected based on significant contribution to the topic, the relevance of the topic opted for and whether or not the same had been covered in the past Dermagyan lectures. A minimum score of 50 out of 100 was required for consideration as a speaker. The selected speakers include: Dr Jaykar Thomas (Pediatric Psoriasis- Challenges and Solutions); Dr. (Brigadier) Sanjeev Vaishampayan (Acute Skin Failure- Pathophysiology and Management including IVIG) and Dr G Venkat Ramana (Sexual Medicine). Instructions for recording have been framed and shared with speakers for scheduled recordings in April and May. Alkem and 6 Sigma are coordinating the same. Date of first recording is scheduled on 25th March.

# जीरो लेप्रोसी मिशन- डॉ. कोठीवाला

भारतीय चर्म, यीन रोग एवं कुष्ठ रोग संगठन के राज्य सचिव डॉ. राजकुमार कोठीवाला ने बताया कि बच्चों में लेप्रोसी खत्म करने के लिए जनजागरकता के कई आयोजन किए गए। खासकर जीरो लेप्रोसी मिशन पर देश व प्रदेशभर में आयोजन किए गए। इस रोग के प्रति लोगों में प्रांतियां हैं, वे बिल्कुल झुठी है। यह एक जीवाणुजनित ग्रेप है जो टीबी की तरह एक माइकाबैक्टीरियम लेपरी नामक जीवाणु से होता है। प्रदेश के सभी मेडिकल कॉलेज के साथ अजमेर के जेएलएन मेडिकल कॉलेज में भी लेप्रोसी सर्वे टीमों का गठन किया गया है। सर्वे के लिए सभी मेडिकल कॉलेजों, जिला अस्पतालों, प्राइवेट अस्पतालों के चर्म रोग विशेषज्ञों की टीम बनाई गई है।
