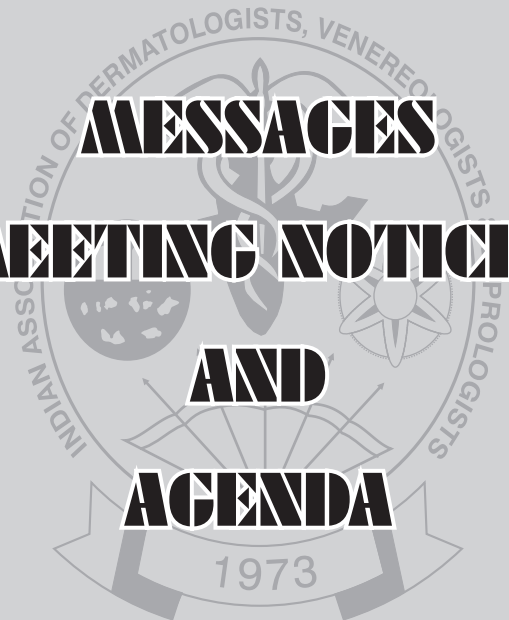

1. How to login ?

IADVL website has been revamped though there are still some problems which will get solved in the next few months. To login you have to use your LM number without the slashes and dashes eg LMUP2251 and for password use IADVL for the first time. Once you login change your password immediately to prevent misuse of your account and remember not to pass the details to anyone. You can modify your address under user profile. Please remember to mention the date of modifying your address and other details in the last block on the page.

2. How to find a dermatologist ?

You can use the website to find a dermatologist in any part of India provided he / she is a member of the association. You can find them using the name / surname / city / colony / location / pincode/ telephone number. Please remember to look under USER PROFILES on the page displayed.

Steps for how to search for Dermatologists and Website Content:

- 1) www.iadvl.org features a universal search bar on the top left column. This single search bar allows a user to search for website content as well as member profiles / dermatologist details.
- 2) For eg. Type Mehta in the search bar. You will get a page saying that no search results were found. That is because there is no website content matching the keyword. But if you click the USER PROFILES link in the results page, you can see all the MEHTA dermatologists by LM NO. Click the LM NO for their details.

Though there are many requests for change of address by surface mail as well as through the state branches and we are updating those addresses too. I would



still request all to use and encourage others to use the website www.iadvl.org to update their addresses or else provide an email with the address update requests.

IADVL website has been revamped though there are still some problems which will get solved in the next few months. To login you have to use your LM number without the slashes and dashes eg LMUP2251 and for password use iadvl for the first time. Once you login change your password immediately to prevent misuse of your account and remember not to pass the details to anyone. You can modify your address under user profile. Please remember to mention the date of modifying your address and other details in the last block on the page.

You can use the website to find a dermatologist in any part of India provided he / she is a member of the association. You can find them using the name / surname / city / colony / location / pincode/ telephone number. Please remember to look under USER PROFILES on the page displayed.

There is a mass mailing facility on the website which can help any information reach all registered life members on click of a mouse. This process is still in its infancy and I am confident that it will be fully functional by the time I hand over the charge to the next Honorary General Secretary in April 2010.

All members interested in various activities of IADVL must visit the website and look for new information under announcements.

Like the IADVL E - groups attempt is being made to start discussion threads on the IADVL website itself. In the near future it can be done by logging on to the website and then participating in the ongoing discussion(s).

Remember your visits to the website will increase the number of hits on the website and thus the visibility on the net. It will also attract more sponsors to the website and help IADVL collect funds for the activities of the association and its members.

IADVL E groups: are functioning well, though within a small group of members. I would like to see more members interacting on these groups. IADVL-Committee for Development of digital teaching and public awareness material has done a wonderful job under the leadership of Dr. R. G. Torsekar. This has been converted to MS power point presentations and were supposed to be loaded on the IADVL website during the CC MIDERMAMEET 09 at Delhi. I am yet to receive a copy of these lectures in MS Power point format to be uploaded on the website. The moment they are received they can be uploaded on the IADVL website - in member's area only.

Scholarships and Fellowships: We have been successful in rolling out several scholarships and fellowships for our younger colleagues.

IADVL - Neutrogena AAD fellowships: It was started during DERMACON 2009 at a very short notice and two members were selected. After finalising the rules this year they are being awarded to three IADVL members passing their PG exams in 2009. We have selected three members and their names will be announced during DERMACON 2010 as per norms. Attempt has been to make this process more and more transparent. Three judges are assessing the CVs of the members and sending their marks to the secretary who then prepares the merit list. The same procedure has been followed for all fellowships and scholarships this year. I am sure this will be made more transparent in the near future with marks being put up on the website too. It is very unfortunate that the selected members are not submitting papers for presentation during the Annual AAD conferences. Rules are being modified and it is proposed to take an undertaking from those selected regarding this issue of paper / poster presentation.

IADVL La Oreal Pigmentation Research Grant: This year we could start the IADVL - La Oreal Pigmentation Research Grant. After the meeting of the Jury on 2nd December at Delhi three projects were selected and would be awarded on IADVL Felicitation Day.

IADVL Training fellowship is continuing to be the most sought after fellowship amongst the members below 35 years of age. We need to change the rules and make it available only to life -members and maybe within 3-5 years of their passing the PG exam. The reason behind this suggestion is the inability of the Post Graduate students to get leave for 4 weeks from the department to pursue this fellowship. We have added some more centers and fellowships. At present training fellowship is being offered by 13 centers across the country.

I am glad to inform that this year till 25th December only 4 out of 13 have failed to complete their fellowship. The situation was pitiful last year as only 3 candidates selected for the fellowships had completed their training till 15th December 2008. It is time that IADVL starts taking an undertaking from those allotted the training fellowships that they will complete their training within the stipulated time. Those who are unable to do so may not be considered for any other fellowship by and through IADVL in the next few years. They are in fact denying others below them in the merit list a chance to do these fellowships.

IADVL Thesis evaluation award has once again created tremendous enthusiasm among the young members of IADVL. This year also we are continuing to get many applications for this award.

IADVL-GSK National Quiz for the postgraduate (IGNQPP) touched a high this year. It was organized in many cities across India. I would like to thank the National Coordinators Dr. Anil Abraham and Dr. M. Ramam, all the quiz masters and coordinators, all the state Presidents and Secretaries, Organising secretaries of CUTICONS and DERMAZONES, IADVL observers and of course the participants for making it a grand success.

The support of the GSK Derma Team, in smooth conduct of the program, especially from Ms Teenaz M. Bamji (Product Manager) is worth mentioning.

We have renewed our membership by paying the annual subscription to the International League of Dermatological Societies (ILDS) in 2009 and will be doing so in January too.

Sister Society meeting in the International Congress of Dermatology (ICD) at Prague in May 2009 where a separate scientific session was held with Dr. Vinod K. Sharma, Dr. Hemangi R Jerajani, Dr. Koushik Lahiri and many others from IADVL attending the session.

DERMAZONE: We were having zonal conferences DERMAZONES in South, East and North for the last few





years and this year the network of zonal meetings has been completed by starting DERMAZONE WEST under guidance of Dr. Suresh P. Joshipura one of our Past Presidents and Dr Bela Shah (President of Gujarat Branch) and her team. The details are being published in this issue of IADVL News. Another Zonal conference DERMAZONE North was held at Chandigarh and the report is still awaited from the organizing secretary. The first conference in North zone was organized at Delhi in 2008 and has contributed to the IADVL kitty a substantial amount for the first time, since DERMAZONES were asked to contribute 50% of their savings to the IADVL funds. The organizers of this conference deserve a special applause.

Now the IADVL members who are unable to attend national meetings for various reasons can improve their knowledge and skills by attending DERMAZONES. DERMAZONES will also give opportunity to smaller towns that were not allotted a DERMACON for various reasons.

We have been observing Vitiligo day, HIV Day, Leprosy Day, IADVL Day IADVL has all over the country to increase public awareness about skin diseases by mass campaign. Observing different days are steps in that direction.

IADVL observes "Vitiligo day" every year on 19th May. I am very happy to say that as a result of the active participation of many state branches of IADVL through organizing media campaign, lectures, meet the public, free medical camps etc. IADVL will continue to try to erase the stigma and unscientific propaganda attached with this disease. This has to be undertaken by individuals as well.

IADVL continues to observe Leprosy day on 30th January and HIV and AIDS day on 1st December to establish the composite nature of our discipline and sensitize common people and different Government/non government agencies about the paramount importance of our subjects.

Many state branches are regularly observing these days very sincerely, we are really thankful to them.

day is observed every year during DERMACON to commemorate that historic day of establishment of our association. Five eminent teachers of Dermatology / dermatologists are being honored during this event.

IADVL Academy is beginning to take its shape and the functioning has begun. This year the members of the IADVL academy took active part in the selection of Orations and awards. The process of selection made transparent and was streamlined under guidance of Dr. A.K. Bajaj, Chairman IADVL Academy of Dermatology. The Academy has laid down well defined parameters for selection of papers for awards at DERMACONS. It was possible because of the involvement of the Honorary General secretary as the convener of the activities of the Academy. It has yet to take up activities of various committees like IADVL Faculty forum, Task force for the guideline in dermatosurgery, Therapeutic guidelines committee, National quiz committee, Thesis evaluation etc.

I am sure with the next honorary general secretary taking over, the academy will see more fruitful days and come out with more academic feasts at various levels.

ARMED FORCES DERMATOLOGY GROUP

1. HIV/AIDS Palliative Care Workshop

A three day HIV/AIDS Palliative Care Workshop, a collaboration between Armed Forces Medical Services & United States Pacific Command was organized by the Department of Dermatology, AFMC and Command Hospital (Southern Command) from 23 Apr 2009 to 25 April 2009, at Bhardwaja Auditorium, AFMC. This academic event highlighted the various facets of management and care in HIV /AIDS with special emphasis on the concept of palliation. Col R S Grewal, VSM, Professor and Head, Department of Dermatology was the Chairman Organising Committee and Lt Col Manas Chatterjee, Associate Professor, Dermatology was the Organising Secretary.

Any important points brought out : This collaborative venture between the Indian Armed Forces Medical Services and the Centre of Excellence of The United States Pacific Command, was inaugurated by Maj Gen (now Lt Gen) H L Kakria, AVSM, VSM**, Major General (Med), HQ Southern Command. Maj Gen (now Lt Gen) B S Rathore, VSM, Addl DGAFMS (HR) released the souvenir cum scientific abstract book of the workshop and Maj Gen D P Vats, SM, VSM released the CD containing the full text articles of the proceedings, selected powerpoint presentations, guidelines and other useful resource material as well as an ebook on palliative care in HIV/AIDS.

Special emphasis was laid on post exposure prophylaxis, maternal and paediatric HIV/AIDS, opportunistic infections, psychiatric & cutaneous manifestations, antiretroviral treatment, drug resistance & second line therapy. The 2-day conference was organised at Tagore Hall in Ahmedabad. A record attendance of about 400 delegates from Gujarat state and 120 delegates from other states.

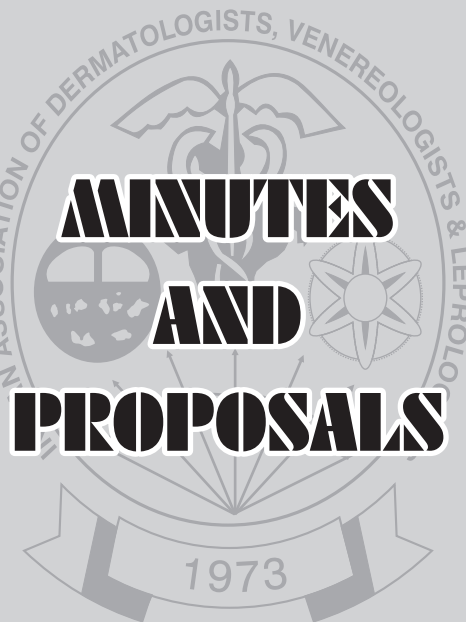

Midterm E.C. meeting minutes were presented before the house.

1. Issue of reducing the expenses of IADVL and increasing the income of IADVL were discussed.

Started in Feb. 09, 19 Journals published by Blackwell Science 44 satellite editors and reviewer have access after written understanding functions. No money can be charged as per agreement. 750 articles downloaded till date, all 10 years issues and other available on the net. Rupees 6.5 lakhs needed every year to continue. An additional satellite editor per state may be added. This facility is to be given to referees of 1 year standing.

Name of satellite editors must be published with referees list.

Cost effectiveness needs to be worked out as only 750 articles were downloaded for Rupees 12.5 lakhs.

Since this is the first year, we must continue with the project though there may be no direct benefit to the members, the project needs to be published via different ways, IADVL News, IJDVL, Websites of IADVL and IJDVL

State branch website should have details of e-library project and names and contact details of satellite editors. IJDVL and IADVL should also publicize the project.

Sixty five percent of the 44 satellite editors have downloaded 750 articles used the facility by downloading 15-20 articles. This agreement is only for IJDVL and its functionaries.

Annual expenses must be met by the IJDVL itself. It has to be given in 2010 February, budgeting must be done for next three years as per the balance sheet.

Indian government has set up International Conference Promotion Bureau (ICPB) a separate wing for promotion of conference bidding. Apart from local association backing we should have support from Tourism Ministry.

Ministry gives money only after successful bidding.

Members of state branch of the city to which a conference is awarded may be involved.

The whole issue is to be dealt with by the IADVL national executive.

Funds saved from DERMACON Surplus starting from Chandigarh 25% is to be kept for international conference bidding.

Bangalore has facilities for hosting an international conference and hence is a viable site for WCD 2015. A few international conferences have been held and some more are to be held from 2010 onwards. A venue called Bangalore International Exhibition Center about 7 km s from the city on Mangalore Bangalore Road, has plenty of covered air conditioned area. A single hall with 10,000 people capacity is available with Hot-spots etc.

Bangalore connected to 25 international destinations. Adequate rooms are available for guests.

Argentina had 11,000 delegates. Seoul is expecting 15 - 17 thousand. Bangalore must expect about 20 thousand delegates.

All bidding countries will have combined lunch during WCD 2011, so IADVL will have to bear 1/5th of the cost.

A new state of art convention center will be ready by 2013.

The cost of Visit of ILDS Inspectors to venue must also be worked out. ILDS policy must be found and worked out accordingly. Budgets must be worked out accordingly.

We must keep in mind the transportation system during the conference.

Total Budget of WCD 2015 must be worked out. It must be between 30-50 crores. We must plan whether we can raise this much of money. The main expenses are Scholarships and freebies to chairpersons and speakers.

It was decided to go ahead. Brochures will be distributed in EADV, AAD, ACD, and other international conferences. All

IADVL members speaking at International forums must use the WCD 2015 logo, in their slides.

Asian Dermatological Congress to be held at Mumbai under Dr. Hemangi R Jerajani. Asian Dermatological association though a small group and may be very useful for WCD bid. During the Hong Kong conference IADVL can bid for Asian Dermatological congress 2013/15. As Dr. Suresh Joshipuraa is going for the council meeting of ADA in December, he can carry some fliers and brochure to the meeting and sensitize the members about our plans. For ACD a budget has to be sanctioned.

ICD inspection team is coming in January 2010 to see the venue. The DERMACON 2010 organisers will provide hospitality and bear travel expenses. IADVL and DERMACON 2010 to bear-50% each of the expenses of the ICD inspectors visit.

IADVL Textbook Committee: Dr R G Vatia to be the head of committee due to bad health of Dr K. Siddappa. About 2800 copies of IADVL textbook sold in 6 months. Another 500 are being reprinted. A royalty of 22 Lacs is being paid. IADVL has been given a post-dated cheque. TDS has been deducted in March 2009 as has been done for the previous editions in the past.

DERMACON 2010: The final brochure was appreciated and applauded by all. Dr Suresh Taiwar extended personal invitation to all to attend the Conference.

DERMACON 2011: Dr. V. K. Jain explained that the city of Gurgaon is 10 kms from International Airport. It is well connected by road and Metro. The conference will be held in Leisure valley an open area of about 2000 meters. The Hangers will be created. Government of Haryana have provided the permission to the Haryana state branch of IADVL to hold the conference at the venue. New Hotels are being built and many new rooms will become available due to commonwealth games of 2010.





Proposals from various members:

Those who were not present could not discuss their proposals.

1. To get maximum returns from DERMACON. Proposal to get a fixed percentage to 20% of the collection per DERMACON. **Not approved.**
2. 20% raise in registration fee every year for DERMACON, every year till DERMACON becomes self sufficient. **Approved.**
3. To increase source of income of IADVL. Dermatologists to wear IADVL Aprons and other such material, can be sold through IADVL including ties, OT dresses. Tie pins etc. Things need to be attractive so as

to force everyone to buy.

4. Lab coats may not be suitable as mostly people are not wearing them.
5. A T-shirt can be made and distributed free. Tie can continue m/u I, epn., tape pins. etc.
6. **Special sessions for sister societies:** CSI has a proposal to hold a session during **DERMACONS.**

Most societies are not under IADVL. Like CODFI, Pediatric Dermatology, Dermato-surgery, Dermato- pathology they can also be allowed.

It was proposed to have a written agreement with other societies under IADVL-constitution, The sister society meetings can be held a day prior to the CME or on the last day as parallel sessions.

We must work out the pros and cons as well the practical aspects of sister societies, as they are increasing in number,

He asked about issue of duplicate ballot papers? **It was decided that no duplicate ballot papers should to be issued.**

When should be ballot papers sent? **It was proposed that they should be sent in 1st week of October.**

Dr. V. P. Kuriyipe then congratulated the president and the secretary on successful conduct of Midterm CC meeting against all odds.

Dr. V. K. Sharma thanked everyone for his or her cooperation during the conduct of the meeting.

Minutes of Meeting of State Presidents and Secretaries



Dr. V. K. Sharma started the proceedings of the meeting with other office bearers of IADVL National executive in chair.

The Honorary General Secretary reported that only seven state branches have sent their quarterly report. Active discussion on IADVL_CC groups has not been possible due to delay in sending the list of CC members from the state branch to the national secretariat. This delay in sending the report and the list of office bearers has delayed the whole process.

There is also an unwarranted delay in sending the membership forms of the new members. It must be hastened. A direct registration with central branch is the only alternative with members. The cut off line of 1 month must be fixed for sending the forms and contribution (membership fee). A word file with detail of the members can be sent immediately by email.

Transfer of members, specially of PLMs from one state to other is putting additional burden on them. It is proposed to have PLMs through central branch as after conversion to life member, they can choose the state branch and the money can be transferred to the respective state branch. This was agreed to for the members who are likely to change their state after finishing their post graduation.

Dates of CUTICONS need to be informed well in advanced to plan IADVL-GSK Quiz program with CUTICONS and DERMAZONES. The dates must reach the Honorary General Secretary before the CC MIDERMAMEET every year.

All presidents and secretaries must join CC_IADVL group and it is mandatory for all state branch office bearers. It is best to join and contribute to discussions.

State branch websites should have information about their CUTICON and its organizing secretary.

Subscription fee for IADVL life and provisional life membership has been raised to Rs. 2400 as per the constitution and may be increased to Rs 5000/-, if approved

by AGBM.

IADVL news is published before the EC and CC meetings. Updated Membership application form becomes available on the website as soon as some changes are made and they have been sent to the state branch secretaries also by email.

The forms are to be filled in duplicate, as the IJDVL (Journal) office does not need the form they only need the addresses.

Members should be asked to give typed name, address, email ID and phone numbers on a plain paper while submitting the forms to the state Branch.

These things must be mentioned in the new forms to be published in the next Issue of IADVL News as well as on the website.

CUTICON and DERMAZONE accounts must be sent to the central office as per constitution.

PAN cards must be obtained for all state branches. It is not the duty of the National Secretariat to provide PAN cards

The first DERMAZONE of North Zone was organised by the Delhi branch. It is about to send the 50% share of the surplus to IADVL funds. It is for the first time it is being done. Others must follow the example.

If the State branches are unable to get the accounts from the CUTICAN or DERMAZONE organizers, the IADVL headquarters must be informed in writing and then the person can be made a member of '**not-good standing**' in the association. We must persuade members to submit the account. In near future an agreement can be made between State branch executives and organisers.

Branches without a website should soon have one for the members.

The Draft made should be made payable at AGRA as the treasurer's office and IADVL bank account is in Agra, The money can be deposited by bank transfer but the National Treasurer and Honorary General secretary must be informed about the details once the transfer has succeeded. Multicity cheques /cheque of CBS branches also may be used.

Stress was laid on faster communication and creation of paperless office. Even SMS can be used to and communication.

Overlapping of confreres with other sub specialties needs to be avoided. For thus the state-branches need to hasten the finalization of dates in CUTICONS, and DERMAZONES.

Since the members could not introduce themselves in the beginning of the meeting, Dr Rajeev Shame introduced the state Branch Presidents and Secretaries to the National Executive.

The President Dr. V. K. Sharma then thanked those present for a fruitful discussion.

Rule 4 (i) of the IADVL Constitution (Membership) states that only practitioners with registered qualification in Allopathic Medicines under the Indian Medical Degree Act 1916 Clause 2 Act VII (with degree or diploma in Dermatology, Venereology and Leprology) shall be eligible for membership of IADVL.

Hence it is hereby proposed as an addition to Rule 4(1) that " the names of members in the IADVL records and registers should be identical (without any abbreviation, addition or alteration) to their names as they appear in their certificate of Registration issued by their respective State Medical Councils. Any abbreviation, addition or alteration made thereafter should be done only by an affidavit before a legal authority and should have previously been recorded in the registers of their respective state Medical Councils before any change in name is made in the registers of IADVL"

We would be obliged if this proposal is included in the Agenda for the aforementioned AGBM.

This journal will not be competing with the mother journal of the parent organisation, i.e. IJDVL of IADVL. Rather it will only supplement or compliment it.

The proposal:

In view of that we propose that a new journal 'IADVL Academy of Dermatology Online Journal (IADOJ) or Indian Dermatology Online Journal (Indian DOJ)' be established by IADVL.

This will be free, this will be available online 24x7 and as there will be no printing cost involved, it will require a very minimal budget without any major implications for IADVL/and or necessity for sponsorship by advertisers.

This proposed Online Journal will be Complementary to the existing Printed IJDVL and should be placed in such a way that it does not interfere in any way with or be a substitute for, the current activities of the said IJDVL.

The roadmap:

The CC and GB of IADVL may discuss and approve this

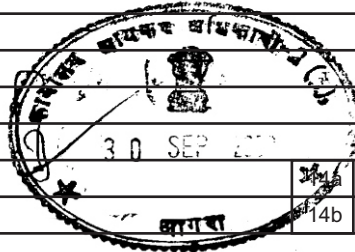
