Sacchidanand ,past president IADVL, Past Presidents of IADVL, Office bears of national executive for 2009 and 2010 , International and national speakers, invitees, my dear colleagues, friends, ladies and gentlemen,

It is a real privilege to represent, the esteemed organization the Indian Association of Dermatologists Venereologists and Leprologists, an association of more than 6000 dermatologists. I sincerely thank each one of you for giving me this opportunity to serve as President in the year 2009. It is exactly one year ago on Jan 2009 I took charge and in short period of one year, we the national executive have set our agenda to modernize IADVL , improve standards of care by Indian dermatologists, increase fund collections, transparency in dealing with pharmaceuticals. To this end we have been fairly successful.

We were able to publish guidelines for SJS-TEN, Psoriasis and Vitiligo, Acne . In addition , we brought out supplements to IJDVL on Dermatotomy by active efforts of Dr Venkat Mysore and his team.

We improved finances by cutting down on expenditure and raising funds e.g. booking IADVL Pharmaceuticals Orations for next 5 years, increasing membership fees. We are grateful to Central Committee members who accepted to travel by 2nd AC train for IADVL meetings. The savings helped us to fund two supplements of Indian Journal of Dermatology and IADVL Handbook for residents that was distributed to all provisional life members (PLMs).

We were also able to complete network of zonal meetings by starting DERMAZONE WEST under guidance of Dr Joshipura, Past President IADVL and Dr Bela Shah. Now the IADVL members who were not able to attend national meetings can improve their knowledge and skills by attending DERMAZONES. DERMAZONES will also give opportunity to smaller towns that were not able to organize national meetings to organize DERMAZONES .

To increase transparency we have started No Conflict Interest Undertaking from all office bearers , Conference Organisers and Editor in Chief of IJDVL and it can be extended to all state and zonal conferences organizers. This in line with OPPI recommendations that are being adopted by Govt of India.

We were also able to make IADVL academy of Dermatology active and the selection of Orations./awards was streamlined under guidance of Dr AK Bajaj, Chairman IADVL Academy of Dermatology. We have laid down well defined parameters for selection of papers for awards at DERMACONS.

We also instituted new awards like Dr LK Bhutani memorial award for teaching and Reasearch, Dr Ganapati Panja award for Dermatology and Dermatopathology, Dr Senthamil Selvi award for work on Mycology and



several awards are awaiting final approval.

Another achievement is institution of IADVL La Oreal Pigmentation Research Grant and three projects have been selected and would be awarded on IADVL Felicitation Day on January 9, 2010.

We have also managed to publish History Book of IADVL under guidance of Dr Joshipura and Uday Khandpur and it is being released.

It has been decided by IADVL to bring international conferences to India and committee under guidance of Dr Chetan Oberai, Past President IADVL is working on it. In this direction, we have already bid for World Congress of International Society of Dermatology (ISD) in 2013 at Delhi, India. PROPOSAL REGARDING THE DERMATOLOGY ONLINE JOURNAL FROM INDIA

- Perspective and Mission statement:
- The need for giving impetus to publishing by our colleagues in Dermatology has been felt for some time now-especially when India marches into International limelight and publishing remains one of the key modes of getting the long overdue visibility to Indian dermatology.

- In the present context of multiple scientific Dermatology related conferences in India there is an urgent need for an Outlet for many Lectures/case presentations etc which our members, who could not attend the original Meetings, can access to. It is the desire of many members from different states and regions of the Country to start/initiate the Institution of an OnLine Interactive Journal of Dermatology under the auspices of IADVL at the earliest.

- This journal will not be competing with the mother journal of the parent organisation, i.e. IJDVL of IADVL. Rather it will only supplement or compliment it.

- The proposal:

- In view of that we propose that a new journal 'IADVL Academy of Dermatology Online Journal (IADOJ) or Indian Dermatology Online Journal (Indian DOJ)' be established by IADVL.

- This will be free, this will be available online 24x7 and as there will be no printing cost involved, it will require a very minimal budget without any major implications for IADVL/and or necessity for sponsorship by advertisers.

- This proposed Online Journal will be Complementary to the existing Printed IJDVL and should be placed in such a way that it does not interfere in any way with or be a substitute for, the current activities of the said IJDVL.

- The roadmap:

- The CC and GB of IADVL may discuss and approve this project in this conference itself The name can be IADVL Academy of Dermatology Online Journal (IADOJ) or Indian Dermatology Online Journal (Indian DOJ) as the General Body desires.



• We suggest the following preliminary matters may be taken up.

• After it is accepted and passed in the GB, the President of IADVL may form a committee under the chairperson of the IADVL Academy of Dermatology to decide about the structural and functional details like:

• 1. Selection/Election (or nomination) of Editor of the proposed journal based on application for a specified period (we can follow the same guideline framed to select the editor of IJDVL)

2. The selected editor will, in turn, select his team.

3. The financial implications of starting the proposed Online Journal

4. Frequency [not to coincide with regular IJDVL

5. Type of Articles, process of peer review, etc.

6. Other matters which crop up in due course will be discussed by the Editorial Board at later stage.

- Decision of the house : To have a new online journal

Not to have a name with the word 'Indian' as the starting point due to Government of India Guidelines To work independently from IJDVL & IADVL Academy.

• Proposals To Increase Number of Subscribers of IADVL E-groups

• Background After more than 1000 days since the e-groups were established in late 2006, only little 200 members subscribe to the e-groups out of a total of 6000 members. This is not even 5% of the total strength !!! This is sad . To make the IADVL e-groups more vibrant and effective I may humbly suggest the following.

• Proposals:

1. General discussion group: IADVL e-groups are like IADVL NEWS and IJDVL. So by default all members should subscribe the basic general discussion e-group. As a first step let us enroll all available valid e-mail ids of members to the general discussion group list server. All new LM should be automatically enrolled in this e-group henceforth. [However, the individual members will reserve the right to unsubscribe from this group at any point of time.]

2. ACAD_IADVL group: The Hony Secretary / moderator will send a request mail to all the available and valid e-mail ids to join this ACAD group. When they agree, the Hony. Secretary will include the ids immediately as and when received.

4. CC_IADVL: This group was conceptualized exclusively for central council members. It is defunct now for various reasons. This very important e-group should be revived and maintained updated with the help of state secretaries

- Appointing Convener For IADVL Academy of Dermatology

- In the original proposal for IADVL Academy of Dermatology, it was proposed that the council should have a convener.

- However that was revised subsequently and now Hony General Secretary is the convener. This goes against the vision and fundamentals on which this academy was conceived and we feel this is one of the main reasons why even after four years the IADVL ACADEMY OF DERMATOLOGY could not properly take off the ground. We propose, as the original accepted proposal, we should have a separate convener for IADVL ACADEMY.

- The need of an academy to deal with all the academic facets of the association was felt, floated and passed in the general body of IADVL. This was basically to streamline IADVL activity and lessen the burden from the shoulder of Hony General Secretary. The perspective behind this proposal is briefed below:

- The job of IADVL Hony General Secretary is almost 24X7 with managing the huge database, updating, interacting with the states, maintenance of minutes and keeping records of various business meetings, properly maintaining the Constitutional amendments, organizing various business meetings round the year, helping the organizers of DERMACONS regarding the organizing part of the conference, preparing the directory, maintaining the website, moderating IADVL E-groups, maintaining accounts... so on and so forth.

- IADVL Academy on the other hand should concentrate on the scientific part of a DERMACON, IADVL guidelines, IADVL thesis evaluation, Organizing IADVL quiz, liaise with IJDVL team, co-ordinating with the special interest groups, faculty's forum, MCI issue (academic part), formulating patients' education materials, IADVL publications, etc. This academy should also supervise IADVL training centers, IADVL fellowships and scholarships etc.

- We believe if we want to take IADVL to the next level and to make it compatible with other advanced International bodies we need to instill structured,

compartmentalized, efficient and professional work culture. A strong functional and active IADVL Academy is a step to that direction.

- To make that happen, along with the Chairperson we need to have a convener who will work in tandem with the Hony. General Secretary, IADVL President and ofcourse the chairperson of the academy.

- The Chairperson and Convener should be appointed by the President and the names should be ratified in the GB. The term of office of IADVL chairman and convener should be ONE year.

- We request the august general body to kindly consider these points and give their opinion

- The three Presidents will nominate the Chairperson and Convener of the IADVL Academy. Members are nominated by the President and due consideration will be given for Zonal representation

- It has been seen on many occasions in the past that many projects needing considerable financial expenditure were submitted by members and often accepted by AGM. Some of these projects also entailed recurrent expenditure in future years also. These future financial implications were not clearly brought out during discussions in AGM and such situations can often lead to fiscal problems for the association. In view of this, we propose that any project /proposal submitted to IADVL secretary for consideration in AGM, with possible financial implications, should be first sent by IADVL secretary to the treasurer, finance committee chairperson, IADVL presidents(current, past and elect) to obtain their opinion. Their opinion on the financial implications of the project should be made available to the General body after submission of the agenda, for its consideration. This will enable the AGM to take a considered view based on all inputs and decide in the best interests of the association

- We request the august body to kindly deliberate on this proposal and give appropriate directives.

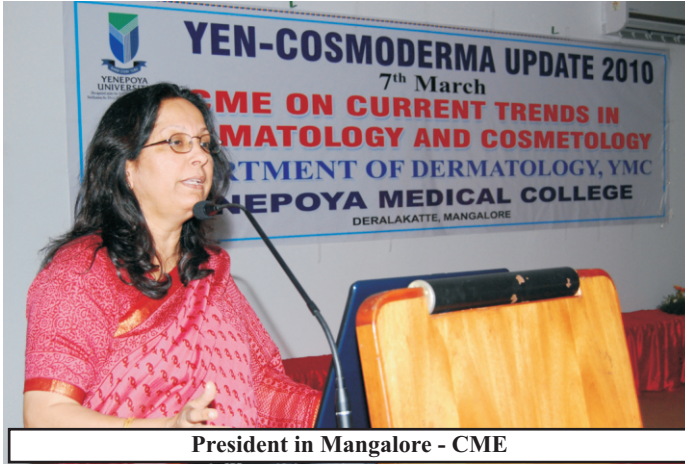

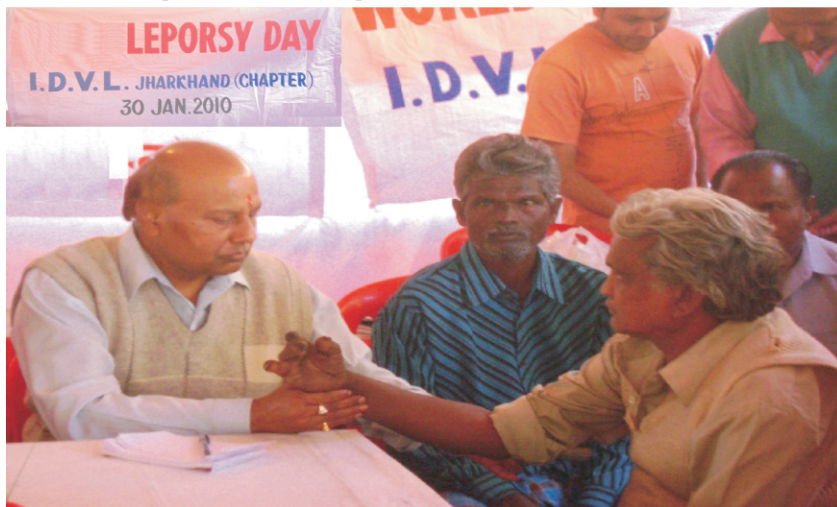

Dr. S. Premalatha is one of the senior professors in dermatology, did her UG and PG studies in Madras Medical College. Served in early half of her career Madras Medical College, later Stanley medical college and other Institutions including 'Sri Ramachandra Medical College and Research Institute-a deemed University' at Chennai.

She underwent special training in the techniques and analysis of finger printing at Finger print bureau of Investigations, Tamil Nadu, prior to her PhD in 'Palmar dermatoglyphics in genodermatoses' and awarded her PhD in 1982 from Madras University.

She is very much research oriented and did an analytical study of about 40 cases of cutaneous leishmaniasis, when she went to Saudi Arabia on Govt deputation for about an year. She guided many research programmes including a research project on Tuberculosis Cutis with reference to dermatopathological study at Tuberculosis Research Center at Chennai.

Her special interests are in Clinical dermatology and Dermatopathology. 'Cerebriform tongue' - Tongue sign in Pemphigus vegetans was first described by her. She has published more than 85 articles - National (more than 55) and International journals (30). About 10 of her publications have been quoted as references in standard text books of Dermatology.

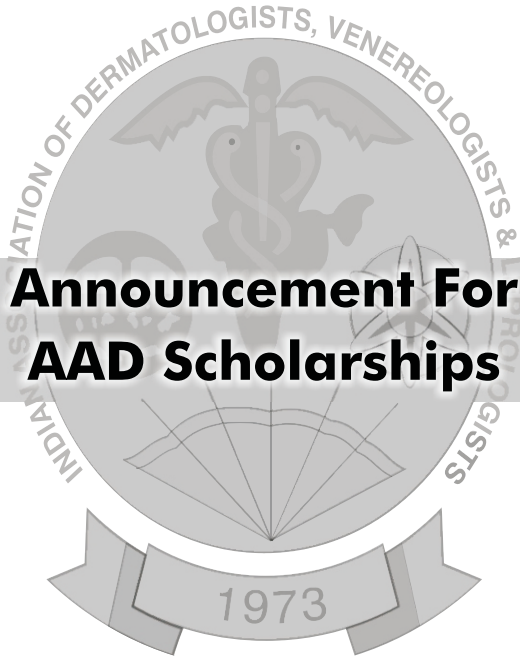

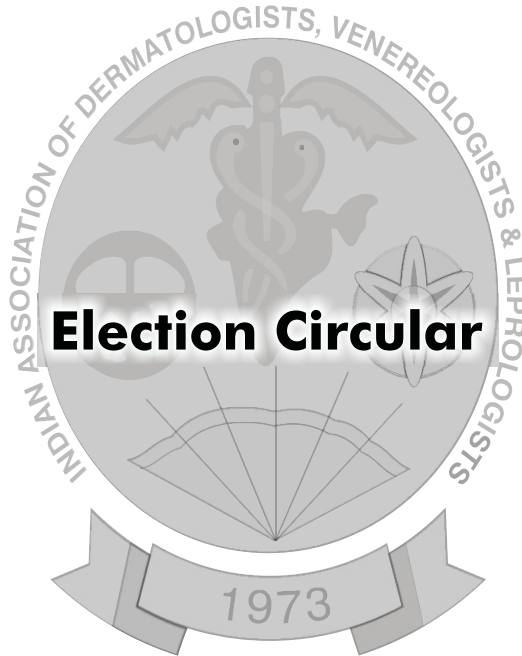
