Dr. Ramesh Bhat organized the EC meet at Mangalore, welcomed all the members. Dr. Hemangi Jerajani gave the Presidential remarks and requested the members to give their opinion and have fruitful discussions. She also mentioned about the dynamic team of the IADVL. The meeting was inaugurated by the president and other dignitaries. The president also released the new issue of IADVL news (April 2010). Dr. Ramesh Bhat informed that a considerable reduction in the cost of printing has been made possible

1. **Indian Dermatology Online Journal (IDOJ)**

Dr. Koushik Lahiri presented the progress made in the initiation of the Journal. Dr. V.K. Sharma suggested that editor IDOJ can take suggestions from IJDVL editor in running the journal. Dr. R.G. Valia asked whether IDOJ Editor should be given a place in the EC. It was decided to wait till the journal is established. Dr. Hemangi Jerajani pointed out that Text Book Editor, is also not given place in the EC. Financial support is from Galderma for 3 yrs. Tenure of the editor to be decided in next GB

Dr. H. Jerajani sought permission to start an online Atlas of diseases of the Indian Skin as Neutrogena has come forward to support this venture. A new editor will be appointed for this post after inviting the applications. Dr. V.K. Sharma opined that all financial matters regarding sponsorship has to be discussed with finance committee. Dr. H. Jerajani opined that there is no need for any new committees and the existing committee will look in to the matters. She also opined that IADVL should have legal advisor in considering the agreements.



2. IADVL UG Text Book of Dermatology

Dr. Manas Chatterjee presented the ground work done in publishing the UG text book of Dermatology. However it was later decided to wait till the selection of new Editor for this project through application.

3. Special Interest Groups :

Dr. Arjit Coondoo presented the various SIGs

- Environmental dermatoses – Dr.C. R Srinivas
- Pemphigus group – Dr. Jyoti Nath
- Genodermatosis group : Dr. Arun C. Inamadar
- Dermatopathology Group : Dr. Mysore Venkatram, Dr. Asha Kubba
- Dermatology clinical trial group – Dr. A. S. Kumar
- Tele Dermatology Group – Dr. Jayakar Thomas
- Dermatology Nursing Group - Dr. Vineet Kaur
- Urticaria group - Dr. Kiran Godse
- Paediatric Dermatology Drug formulary group – Dr. Rajeev Sharma

Dr. Coondoo elaborated on the origin of SIGs and informed that a few of these groups have already started functioning. He mentioned in detail suggestions by Dr Arun Inamdar regarding SIGs. First report is expected by July 2010. Dr. Jerajani informed that Dermatotomy has been excluded because ACSI has been given as a Sister Society status.

4. Sister Society Status :

Dr. Ramesh Bhat informed that there is good response for various sub speciality societies regarding sister society status. Presently ACSI, CODFI, ISPD, Pathology society of India, TeleDermatology have shown interest. Responses from ACSI, IAL & IASTD have not yet been received. It was proposed to frame guidelines to accept these associations as sister society. Further it was decided to name sister society meetings during DERMACONS as Ancillary Meetings. It was also decided to write to these societies that the scientific agenda and speakers list should be given to the organizers of DERMACON in advance and has to be approved by the scientific committee

5. Membership :

It was informed to the house that membership fees has been hiked to Rs 5,000/- for life members and PLM's. It was also agreed to have associate life members and international life members without voting rights. It was decided that PLM status will be for 5 yrs and within that period they have to furnish the proof for completion of degree with recognition. Dr. Jayadev suggested to allot a separate PLM numbers. It was also proposed to have special fees (like members from India) for members of SAARC countries. Dr. Jerajani felt the need for online registration and payment in future.

6. Insurance Schemes:

Dr. Jayadev, the treasurer presented the group insurance with professional indemnity insurance. He mentioned that LIC group insurance is available at low costs. He mentioned the problems and solutions involved in this scheme.

7. MCI Issues :

Dr. Ranjan Rawal presented the various aspects of MCI issues. It was decided to form a committee consisting of the following members.

8 Vitiligo day observation

Dr. Ramesh Bhat M informed the house that DVDs on vitiligo documentary has been sent to all the state branches so that it can be translated in local languages and screened throughout India. IADVL academy has prepared posters to be sent to all the branches

Dr. Jerajani informed that media can be approached to have a wider publicity

9. IADVL Directory :

Dr. S.D. N Gupta and Dr. Majumdar presented the road map to prepare a new IADVL directory

10. Review of Various Committees

1. Matters related to ICD 2013: The EC appreciated the efforts of Dr. V. K. Sharma and others to get ICD 2013 to India. Dr. V.K.Sharma informed that ICD requires assurance regarding the transfer of funds to ISD from the conference savings. He informed that formal declaration regarding hosting ICD in India has already been done but formal allotment has not been done. He suggested combining 2014 DERMACON along with ICD. Dr. Jerajani informed that the National IADVL should do ICD & DERMACON, not the Delhi branch. She also advised to find whether the advanced payment to the ISD can be made in installment as the transfer of money now itself results in loss of interest to IADVL. Dr. V.K.Sharma informed the house that as per the discussion during the ICD inspection in New Delhi earlier this year it was tentatively decided that ICD 2013 may be conducted in Nov/ Dec 2013.

2. IADVL Text Book Committee :

Dr. Joshipura informed that the Honorary General Secretary will scrutinize the eligibility criteria of the applicants before the committee performs the screening and sends the recommendation to IADVL general body.

3. IADVL GSK Quiz :

Dr. Raghunatha Reddy & Dr. Atul Kochhar are the National Coordinators and the guidelines for conduction of the quiz has been prepared. Dr. Ramesh Bhat informed that the quiz programme for this year will be initiated during CUTICON Kerala at Kannur in the month of May

4. IADVL Academy :

Dr. Manas presented the issues related to IADVL Academy. The details presented has to be forwarded to the constitution committee for the updating. It was informed that the curriculum has been recently updated by MCI. Dr. Jerajani informed that is better to call *IADVL consensus statement on steroids and herpes* instead of guidelines, to be published in IJDVL as a supplement.

CME Accreditation :

State medical council will have to be approached to get CME accreditation. Dr. Atul Kochhar will inform the Delhi Medical Council guidelines. IADVL will accredit points for CME and conferences organized by IADVL state branches of subspecialty societies



Fellowship of IADVL academy (FIAD)

It was decided to award fellowship from this year onwards. Dr. Jerajani informed that IDOJ will be under the National Executive like IJDVL. It was also approved to make it mandatory to monitor the conflicts of interest during the presentation in the conference.

5. Matters related to DERMACON 2011

Dr. VK. Jain presented the progress of DERMACON 2011. It was decided to use the term ancillary meeting instead of sister society meeting. All oration will be named as IADVL(systopic / Neurtogena etc). There will not be any parallel sessions during IADVL GSK quiz. Dr. V.K. Jain explained the problems related to filing returns and tax aspects of DERMACON. Dr. Coondoo presented the scientific aspects of the DERMACON

6. Matters related to DERMACON 2012

Dr. Jerajani informed that venue inspection has not been done for the year 2012. IADVL Rajasthan branch has proposed the inspection in the month of July. The state branch has to bear the expenses.

7 IADVL Constitution committee

Dr. Suresh Joshipura presented the updating of the constitution

- a. Membership : International life member NRIs of other foreign members can be enrolled without having voting right , fees is 500\$
- b. CC MIDERMAMEET will not take any decision to make change in constitutional provisions.

Non functional committee to be omitted

It is emphasized that the President of the IADVL, the highest dignitary during the inauguration and presidential speech will not be curtailed under any circumstances.

It was decided to consider MD Venereology with MCI recognition for membership of IADVL

The constitution committee will prepare the final draft by CC MIDERMAMEET and can be printed. A meeting of the Constitution committee members will be held during the CC MIDERMAMEET.

8. Matters related to WCD :

Dr. Sacchidanand presented the initial preparations for WCD bidding.

The presentation related to ILDS matters was elaborated by Dr. Chetan Oberai. He also informed that the month of September is ideal for the WCD

9 Election 2010 :

Dr. Chetan Oberai is the Election Officer for this year. It was also decided to explore the possibility of electronic voting in future.

10 Finance Committee:

It was opined that fixed deposit for longer duration is advisable and money has to be deposited in public sector banks only. It is also necessary to budget WCD and ICD. It was also opined that it is necessary to seek minimal assurance money from DERMACON organizers

Matters related to IJDVL :

Dr. Thappa, the Editor presented matters related to IJDVL. He informed that IADVL has to transfer the interest to IJDVL. He informed that in the present IJDVL an infold has been created for the advertisement which will fetch a Rs. 4 Lakhs a year. The website is presently sponsored by GALDERMA (Rs.4 Lakhs /year)

Miscellaneous

Dr. Joshipura presented a cheque of Rs. 1 lakh to IADVL from the savings of DERMAZONE West.

Proposals from members

Jayadev betkerur.LM/KN/2009, Hon Treasurer,IADVL

As the office bearers of IADVL ,the EC members are duty bound to all the dermacons till they are in office. at the conference we are expected to attend meetings which last for long time. We often miss scientific sessions, with present MCI guideline we will have to make our own arrangements for stay and local travel. My proposal is that the Organising committee of Dermacons should take care of local hospitality ,like accommodation & local transport of serving EC members. This will make their job more easy and concentrate on the real work. at present the President and Hon Secretary are given this privilage. Hope you will add this for discussion during CC Meet at Mumbai.



Venkataram Mysore(LM/KN/3211) and Koushik Lahiri(LM/WB/2503)

1. We see from our IADVL website that the website for the DERMACON 2012 at Jaipur is given as a link on the homepage, not as part of the IADVL website. This is against our approved proposal in AGM Lucknow 2010 – that hereafter all DERMACON websites have to be part of IADVL websites so that all the conference details can be preserved for posterity and therefore should be named as www.iadvl.org/conferences/dermacon/2012. During any future attempt to deal with the IADVL history these data will be of utmost importance. If we don't care now, invaluable history will be lost forever. Further, this is how conference websites are named and cited with respect to all major International conferences such as AAD, EADV, ICD, etc. We request the hon. secretary to kindly explain why the AGM directive has not been followed.

2. His point also illustrates that under the current system there is no proper followup of the AGM approved points, and that there is no archives or updating in the constitution of all such points which are approved in AGM. We therefore submit that, hereafter, any point which is approved by AGM should immediately be sent to constitution committee for language formatting, codification and categorization under appropriate byelaws, and the same should be updated on to our website within three months of the approval. If there is any such point which is found difficult or impractical to implement, such points should be brought before the immediate next central council meeting for discussion. As a matter of courtesy and propriety, the concerned members who raised that point in AGM should also be prior informed, so that they can participate in CC discussion.

3. There used to be a link to the archives section in IADVL website. This section used to store the Presidential addresses and Honorary General Secretary's reports since 2005. Currently this section cannot be traced on the web now. Kindly take care so that this section is properly preserved and updated on the web for future references.

Advantages:

- i) Participation will be more than the postal one.
- ii) Will save a good amount of time & money for postage.
- iii) Grievances of non-receipt of Ballot Papers will be nil.
- iv) Reluctance of our members regarding voting will be minimized.
- v) All candidates will be able to be present during the counting.

Some sister organizations have gained success in this process.

2. IADVL NEWS :

Instead of 3(three) IADVL News, only one issue can be published after Mid-Dermameet will suffice the need of the members, really interested for IADVL News. Any important information in between can be circulated to the members either by letter or a separate sheet in IJDVL.

Advantages: It will save a good amount of money (printing, posting etc) as IADVL is going through a financial scarcity.

She has published more than 85 articles - National (more than 55) and International journals (30). About 10 of her publications have been quoted as references in standard text books of Dermatology.

She has authored a book- 'Synopsis and Similes of Dermatopathology', a booklet on 'Easyway to learn dermatological syndromes through cartoons' and a chapter in IADVL textbook of Dermatology, 3rd Ed, 2008.

She has given many Orations and received many Awards to her credit including 'Teacher par Excellence Award' during DERMACON 2007.

She was one among the very few, to receive the prestigious FAMS Award (Fellow of National Academy of Medical Sciences), New Delhi in 1994, in recognition of her research works, publications and other scientific contributions to the field of Dermatology.

This award is for best research paper published in Dermatology.
