NOTES FROM TREASURER'S DESK


Dear colleagues,

TREASURES REPORT:

Dr. Jayadev Betkerur presented the financial position of IADVL as on July 31st 2010. He informed that Rs. 2 crores will be kept in RBI bonds. He informed that a sum of Rs. 1 crore 19 Lakhs is expected from DERMACON Lucknow.

REPORT OF VARIOUS COMMITTEES

IADVL Academy of Dermatology:

Dr. Manas Chatterjee presented the report.

In view of revamping the IADVL fellowship programme applications from the existing and new centers have been invited. He informed that only three centers have applied so far. Dr. Coondoo informed that a few new centers have also applied for fellowship programmes.

Instructions for chair persons in DERMACON : This has been prepared and will be followed in future. Dr. Rajan Grewal informed that Chairpersons should moderate the speaker. Dr. Jerajani told that it will be conveyed to the DERMACON 2011 team during the scientific committee meeting.

Patient information leaflets will be prepared by members of IADVL Academy and SIGs. Dr. Godse enquired whether financial grant can be accepted for the guidelines and in particular to the urticaria including SIG meets.

The president requested to arrange teleconference of various SIG's

The president complemented the IADVL Academy for the good work

Text book advisory committee:

Dr. S. Sacchidanand has been selected as the new editor for IADVL text book of Dermatology. Dr. Ameet Valia was chosen for the co-editor post. However Dr. Ameet Valia expressed his inability to take up this responsibility and declined the offer.

Dr. Vishalakshi Vishwanath is selected as the editor for UG textbook of Dermatology.

Dr. Manas Chatterjee is selected as the editor for IADVL online atlas of Dermatology

Constitutional Committee report

IADVL constitution Committee – Dr. R G Valia presented the minutes of IADVL constitution committee. It was informed that the new constitution will be printed and released during DERMACON 2011

Chairperson of Academy is appointed by three presidents – immediate past, present and president elect, so is the convener.

Scientific committee members should not be selected for any oration or award. Tenure of chairperson and convener of IADVL Academy of Dermatology will be 2 years. Individual member's term is also for 2 yrs with a 50 % turnover each year. The nominated members of IADVL executive committee need not resign to contest an IADVL election. Dr. Mysore Venkatram pointed at the issue of conflict of interests and later it was decided that nominated members also should resign if they want to contest. IADVL Academy chairpersons will be selected 1 year in advance. Orations will be awarded only once in a lifetime. Regarding the fellowships new updated list of centers will be available by next year. Dr. Venkataram felt that this list need not be incorporated in the constitution as it can be changed.



Audited account of zonal conferences should reach the centre within six months and surplus should be de divided 50 % each. All the surpluses of international conference should go to IADVL National. International conferences should not be combined with DERMACONS, however in case of emergency it can be in conjunction. We should have clear understanding with the international body regarding sharing surplus amount. The office bearers and president should be taken into confidence regarding international conference and account should be audited by IADVL auditor. Dr. Joshipura opined that IADVL general body should be taken into confidence in forming organizing committee and local members should be taken into confidence. Dr. Koushik Lahiri felt that combined ICD and DERMACON decision can be taken only by AGBM. He also added that during the recent ISD inspection team meeting it was clearly conveyed on behalf of ISD that no major conference can be organized by the host country during or within very short period of the proposed ICD. Dr.Kalyan Banerjee asked regarding the transfer of surplus to ISD and expressed his apprehension based on past experience.

International members and NRIs should be charged in the same way. Dr. Manas Chatterjee, Dr. Venkatram and Dr. Chetan Oberoi participated in the discussion. PLM status is for 5 yrs. Dr. Rajan wanted to have special consideration for SAARC members. National president felt that SARAD members should have the same membership fees like IADVL. The President, Secretary and Treasurer should be given TA where they visit for IADVL purposes. President clarified that it is at the discretion of organizing committee. General body is the supreme body. Interpretations can be done by the constitutional committee without harming the sanctity.

Dr. Koushik Lahri has suggested that

- ✓ All the resolutions passed in the GB should be comprehensively taken up by the constitution committee by the next midterm CC meeting and a yearly constitution update/ammendment draft should be prepared in a meeting before that midterm CC meeting.
- ✓ This draft has to be placed and presented in the CC meeting.
- ✓ Subsequently that yearly update/ammendment draft has to be placed in the GB of the closing year.

After further ratification this has to be floated to the net in www.iadvl.org for all the members to see.

Social Security Scheme :

Dr. Jaydev Betkerur and Dr. Chetan Patel presented the social security scheme which can be managed by LIC and IADVL respectively. Dr. Jaydev presented the LIC scheme as a group insurance till the age of sixty. Premium is payable once a year. The age limit and the premium are negotiable.

Dr. Chetan Patel presented with scheme that can be run by IADVL on its own. It requires permanent office and dedicated team and Gujarat IADVL is ready to take task.

Dr. Chetan Oberai also participated in the discussion

The President Dr.Hemangi Jerjani entrusted the task to Dr. Chetan Patel and Dr. Jayadev Betkerur in consultation with Dr. Kuriyeppe and Dr. Critton and to present the final product in next AGBM of IADVL.

ICD matters –Dr. V.K.Sharma presented the ICD matters and informed that ICD has been officially allotted to India in the month of March during the AAD. Considering the experience of 1994 ICD IADVL is cautiously proceeding. ISD has started charging 75,000 dollars as the initial royalty money. Since last ISD they have also asked for 50 % of profit share. However this time ISD is planning to organize two successive congresses in two consecutive years(within six months actually) considering this as an unusual event we have to bargain for less royalty money. This conference has large number of scholarships which is also a large amount. We can offer approximately 200 scholarships and royalty amount reduced to 25,000 US \$. Dr. V. K.Sharma will be the congress president and Dr.Hemangi Jerjani will be the secretary general. The committee will be formed later. Website will be launched very soon. Dr. Narendra Patwardhan enquired about the liabilities such as sponsoring scientific committee members. Dr. V.K. Sharma informed that till now they have not asked for it. However we may have to sponsor ISD scientific committee members. Dr. Venkatram asked whether Argentina conference can be cancelled. The President informed that it may not be possible now but some negotiations can be made. Dr. Koushik Lahri informed that in the Prague GB meeting of ISD there was no proposal for two conferences. Dr. Shyam Verma informed that negotiations can be made during EADV Dr. V.K.Sharma informed that they have to pay tax 10% for the surplus money. Dr. Joshipura wanted to have a modified agreement. Dr. Venkataram wanted a project report to be submitted during DERMACON 2011

Dr. Sacchidanand presented the WCD matters website www.wcd2015.in has been launched. Vancouver, Isthambul, Rome, Vienna are the other competitors. WCD has not been held in this part of the world. IADVL will arrange a lunch/ high tea during Seoul conference.



Dr. D.M.Thappa, Editor in chief, Indian Journal of Dermatology, Venereology and Leprology (IJDVL) presented the IJDVL matters.

Proud moment for IJDVL and its IADVL members is that Indian Journal of Dermatology, Venereology and Leprology (IJDVL) had received its first impact factor and it is 0.976 as on June 2009. Dr. Thappa gave the credit for this remarkable phenomenon to the former editor of IJDVL, Dr. Uday Khopkar, He informed the house that IJDVL is placed at number three amongst the medical journals published from India according to its impact factor. He also explained the newer facilities at the website, www.ijdv.com. Dr.Thappa was granted one more term of 3 years as an editor of IJDVL by Hon. President Dr. Hemajerani. The national president informed the authors that editor will communicate regarding the reasons for rejecting the articles submitted to IJDVL. Dr. Thappa appreciated the contribution of its members as author/s and reviewers and invited them to join it as a referee to strengthen its review process.

Dr. Shyam Verma presented the activities of the newly launched Indian Dermatology Online Journal (IDOJ). The website www.idoj.in is active from July first. He explained the outline of the journal. He requested to motivate more members to submit the article to the journal Dr. Verma informed that in another two months first issue may be ready. Dr. Bushan Kumar opined that two journals may not be required from the associations. However the president replied that IDOJ will not compete with IJDVL and many associations have multiple journals. Dr. C.R Srinivas opined that more acceptances will encourage members to write more.

Election issues: Dr. Chetan Oberai presented the system of dual voting. The cost of electronic voting is around 30,000/-. The electronic votes have to be opened on the voting day itself. Dr. Coondoo opined to have a dummy run before implementation. Dr. V.K.Jain presented the issues related to DERMACON 2011. Final announcement has been released already, scientific programme has been finalized. Slots have been given to six sister societies. Aesthetic dermatology is the CME topic. DERMACON 2012: Dr.U.S. Aggarwal presented the issues related to DERMACON 2012. The IADVL official team has visited the proposed venue.

As the office bearers of IADVL, the EC members are duty bound to all the dermacons till they are in office. at the conference we are expected to attend meetings which last for long time. we often miss scientific sessions. with present MCI guidelines we will have to make our own arrangements for stay and local travel. my proposal is that the Organising committee of Dermacons should take care of local hospitality, like accommodation & local transport of **servicing** EC members. this will make their job more easy and concentration the real work. at present the President and Hon Secretary are given this privilege. Hope you will add this for discussion during CC Meet at Mumbai This issue has already been discussed

1. We see from our IADVL website that the website for the DERMACON 2012 at Jaipur is given as a link on the homepage, not as part of the IADVL website. This is against our approved proposal in AGM Lucknow 2010 – that hereafter all DERMACON websites have to be part of IADVL websites so that all the conference details can be preserved for posterity and therefore should be named as www.iadv.org/conferences/dermacon/2012. During any future attempt to deal with the IADVL history these data will be of utmost importance. If we don't care now, invaluable history will be lost forever. Further, this is how conference websites are named and cited with respect to all major International conferences such as AAD, EADV, ICD, etc We request the hon. secretary to kindly explain why the AGM directive has not been followed.

- ✓ 2. This point also illustrates that under the current system there is no proper followup of the AGM approved points, and that there is no archives or updating in the constitution of all such points which are approved in AGM. We therefore submit that, hereafter, any point which is approved by AGM should immediately be sent to constitution committee for language formatting, codification and categorization under appropriate byelaws, and the same should be updated on to our website within three months of the approval. If there is any such point which is found difficult or impractical to implement, such points should be brought before the immediate next central council meeting for discussion. As a matter of courtesy and propriety, the concerned members who raised that point in AGM should also be prior informed, so that they can participate in CC discussion.
- ✓ 3. There used to be a link to the archives section in IADVL website. This section used to store the Presidential addresses and Honorary General Secretary's reports since 2005. Currently this section cannot be traced on the web now. Kindly take care so that this section is properly preserved and updated on the web for future references.

- ✓ 1. As a National body looking after the skin health of people in India, we must adopt a strategy to curb irresponsible, unproved, potentially harmful and misleading advertisements of skin care products.
- 2. Approach the authorities to curb the sale of prescription drugs (including topicals), without proper prescription.

The president informed that advertisement itchmasol has been withdrawn. Any other complaints should be given with proof. Dr Khopkar enquired about providing provision for complaints in the website.

Voting for election of National Body of IADVL should be done during the conference (DERMACON)
Method: Ballot Papers should be given to the delegates at the time of registration and to be dropped by the voters in a Ballot Box kept nearby the Registration Counter after casting the votes. The voting process and counting will be completed before the last General Body meeting.

- 8). Department of Dermatology & STD
- 9). Department of Dermatology, STD & Leprosy

The first four names sound outdated and unscientific. However they have been in vogue long enough and is easily understood by common man. Should we move on with changing times and adopt No.8 or No.9?

What should be the correct and uniform nomenclature. I wish all the Departments across various Medical Colleges should adopt a uniform nomenclature. I am sure IADVL will resolve this issue.

9. Venkataram Mysore LM/KN/3211 and Sacchidanand S LM/KN/1937

We would like to submit the proposal as convener and chairman, IADVL taskforce dermatosurgery

Taskforce guidelines have been published so far in 2008,2009 and are under publication for 2010.A total of 18 topics have been drafted and published/under publication. While these were published as IJDVL supplements in 2008, 2009, they are being included in separate issues of the journal this year, because of budgetary constraints. .We propose that all 18 guidelines prepared so far be published as a book. This would not only be a highly useful desktop reference for our members, but also earn Royalty for the association. We request for permission from this august house to go ahead for this publication. We will also present details of our negotiation with publication house.

10. Proposal from Venkataram Mysore KN/LM/3211 and Sacchidanand S

IADVL elections have always faced multiple problems such as nonreceipt of ballot papers, postage difficulties, expense, poor voting percentage etc.In order to overcome these, we suggest that in stead of postal ballot, we should have conference elections-elections during dermacon.This would make the job easier, cheaper and ensure greater member participation. Such an arrangement has already been adopted successfully by other associations such as plastic surgery and obstetrics-Gynaecology.

We request this august body to deliberate on this issue and give guidelines

11. Venkataram Mysore LM/KN/3211, Asha Kubba LM/ND/1404

1.Publishing an IADVL textbook on dermpath: This was approved in principle by CC meeting. It is proposed to start working on a multiauthor IADVL text book on dermatopathology of size 600-800 pages, with experts in dermatopathology. The book will specifically focus on topics of relevance to India, which are not dealt with in sufficient detail in western books. This would not only give a fillip to the subject, but also enhance the image of our association. In addition the royalty earned can be used to create a Dermatopathology fund to promote the subject. A concrete proposal with details about contract with publisher is being submitted to AGM for approval.

2. Current IADVL fellowships in dermatopathology are of one month duration.SIG Dermatopathology members feel it is inadequate.We request the AGM to enhance the fellowship duration for 3 months

3. To enhance teaching of dermatopathology in different postgraduate teaching centres, it is important that teachers are aware of the subject. To ensure this,we request AGM to approve a " Dermatopathology PG Teachers' training program" as follows:

IADVL will start a teaching program to cover one teacher from each PG departments in each college over a five year period. One teacher(to be designated by each HOD of recognised teaching centre) will be awarded the above three months fellowship in each approved centre for fellowship.The program would cover all PG departments in the country over a five year period. IADVL should provide financial assistance to the teacher for the fellowship and also to centre for conduct such fellowships.

4. CC meeting had already approved best paper award, best poster award, best published (in IJDVL) paper awards and quiz in dermatopathology and have been implemented in this Dermacon itself. We request the august body to approve these so that they can be incorporated in future dermacons.

We request the august body to kindly consider these proposals and give approval.



13. Dr V K Sharma(LM/ND/1652)

World congress by IADVL

If any member state or recognized body wants to organise world congress or international conference in dermatology/venereology and leprology, or related subjects, prior approval of EC, IADVL would be essential before declaration of conference is made.

International conferences would normally be organised by IADVL rather than state IADVL /city IADVL

17. Proposed by: Dr.M.Subramania Adityan, LM/TN/4835, Seconded by: Dr.P.P.Ramaswamy, LM/TN/210, Dr.S.Byaravarathinam, LM/TN1838

We intend to draw your attention to a 'clear and present danger' to ethical, qualified dermatology practice. Recently, as you all are aware of, there is **an attempt by the state IMA of Tamil Nadu to conduct a 9 month fellowship course of dermatology for general practitioners**. This is a very serious issue, and if not curbed at an early stage, will emerge as a major threat, not only to professionally qualified dermatologists, but also to the society as a whole, since such a 'fast-food' approach cannot be a substitute for years of rigorous training, especially in a complex, vast specialty, with over 2500 diseases like ours.

That apart, what is the pertinent need for churning out such 'half-baked' products, when already 33 M.D (D.V.L) students and 31 D.D.V.L students are passing out of Medical colleges every year in Tamil Nadu alone, after undergoing methodical training as per MCI guidelines for three/two years and proper evaluation by university examinations.

We are sure that every qualified dermatologist would agree that a 9 month correspondence course with nine contact classes (each class for just 3 HRS) cannot prepare a doctor to become a clinical dermatologist. **Moreover this is against the principle of IMA itself**, which is against 3 years M.B.,B.S course. Then why this double standards? .To satisfy the vested interests of a handful of people?.

We appeal to the GB to take a strong note of this issue and take appropriate measures to stop such courses anywhere in the country, and pass a strict resolution to stem the rot, so **that nobody tries to conduct such courses in the future**.

18. Dr S. Sanadan (LM/TN)

A proposal has been put by Indian Medical Association, Tamil Nadu Branch to start a Certificate Course in Dermatology for a period of 9 months. There was no information nor approval obtained from IADVL, T.N.State Branch. I have received phone calls, SMS and email from members of IADVL –Tamil Nadu, Puducherry and rest of India raising their concern regarding the proposed course.

I request you to take up this issue in the General Body Meeting of IADVL to be held on 4th of February 2011 during the National Conference at Gurgaon.

19. Dr. Suresh Talwar (LM/UP2339)

Elections :Election process should start on 15 Oct and all those who do not receive ballots by 15 Nov may be issued duplicate ballots on request .Duplicate ballots may be marked as duplicate . All ballots should bear serial number,signature of election officer and carry IADVL monogram . Ballots should be dispatched by speedpost .

Blue book : There should be a separate booklet on guidelines to conduct DERMACON giving details of orations , medals , inaugural function , IADVL day celebration , Valedictory function , GSK quiz , cultural programme , finances , audit , sharing of surplus , constitution of committees ,complementary stay , registration etc .It will be handy for organizers of the conference .

Audit : All state conferences should also submit audited report of the annual conference to the national body although they may be allowed to retain the entire surplus for promotion of the speciality in the state .

Zonal representation :National conference should be allotted on zonal basis . It can be seen that out of last 4 conferences 3 have been organized in North . Similarly national presidents should also be elected in rotation on zonal basis .

Venue : Conference should be allotted to venues which has facility to organize conference in a pucca structure (major portion) . Organising conference in hangers incurs additional expenditure of 50 to 75 lacs . IADVL can easily save this money.

OBITUARY



Dr. RAM PRASAD OKHANDIAR (Past President IADVL 1995) **(Dr. R.P. OKHANDIAR) – 14 . 7 . 1929 --- 20. 8 . 2010**

Dr Ram Prasad Okhandiar, popularly known as Okhandiar Saheb, breathed his last on 20th August 2010 in Scotland, UK, in a private nursing home. An eminent dermatologist of Bhagalpur, his birthplace, and of Bihar, and India, he also had a pathological lab in which he invested for the all round development of Medical Sciences in Bhagalpur.

Born to Mr Hari Narayan Prasad Okhandiar, Railway engineer in Jamalpur Wagon Factory of the Railways and Mrs Chandra Okhandiar on 14th July 1929 in Gaya, Bihar, he did his schooling from Jamalpur and lucknow and then went on to graduate from Prince of Wales Medical College, Patna way back in 1952. He did his D.Phil in Dermatology, went to England, worked at St. John's Hospital and returned to India to set up his own establishment.

My colleagues and I met him first 20 years back when we were drumming up support for our conference. Reaching Bhagalpur from Patna meant reaching or leaving Bhagalpur at midnight and we were scared of the outcome but Okhandiar Saheb was there, waiting for us at the station at midnight. He had made all arrangements for our stay and was the host for the day. He saw us off at the station at midnight and as the train was late, was hovering around from the station-master's office to our perch with his typical smile and cheer on his face, when all of us were so exhausted that we could not stand on our feet! We now realise that he was a man of inexhaustible energy and go. He had made us so much at home that we had also forgotten that he was at least 20 years our senior, he felt just like one of us, such was his self effacing, loving and caring nature.

In between coming and going we visited his residence and there I saw the biggest dermatological library till date, a room full of books, stored methodically in racks, extending from the roof to the floor of the room, and covering all the walls – bigger than most of the libraries in medical colleges. It contained virtually all national and international journals.
