

IADVL for the first time organised Ancillary meeting at Seoul during WCD, 2011 and Sister Society meeting during EADV Congress at Lisbon. Dr Premalatha, IADVL nominee was awarded the ILDS Certificate of appreciation award. Dr Hemangi Jerajani got elected as the Regional director of ILDS. However IADVL didn't succeed in 2015 WCD bid. ICd was officially awarded to IADVL during March 2011. IADVL concise text book of Dermatology and IADVL text book of Dermatology projects are progressing satisfactorily. Indian Dermatology Online journal and IADVL GSK National quiz Programme for Post graduates are marching ahead.

IADVL is also happy to announce the commencement of PPLFBS scheme. This year we had a successful Elections with record number of candidates and record voting. We are also planning to introduce E voting.

DERMAZONE WEST 2011

The IInd Biennial Conference of IADVL West-Zone i.e. DERMAZONE WEST 2011 was organized by IADVL MP State Branch, on 23rd,24th & 25th Sept.,2011,in School of Computer Sciences, D.A.V.V. Indore. This mega academic event was attended by nearly 240 delegates, not only from five constituent states but also by delegates from other parts of country, giving it a look of mini-national conference.

The conference started on 23rd Sept.,2011, with a very exhaustive-live workshop on various dermato-surgical procedures befitting its Theme-"Exploring New Horizons in Managing Aging Face & Body", Overseas speakers Dr. Minal Patwardhan (Dubai) elaborated and demonstrated Spectra Q- Switch Nd : YAG Laser for Managing resistant Melasma. She was assisted by Dr. Anil Soni. Davia Matar, a noted pharmacist from Jordon-demonstrated Esthelan Renew System for Facial Rejuvenation, Dr. Girish Shah (Mumbai) demonstrated subcision of acne scars with corneal knife, Dermal Graft and Fractional CO2 laser in reducing the acne scars. He also presented a video for obtaining Melanocyte rich-suspension and its use in correcting stable vitiligo.Dr. Jagdish Sakhia demonstrated a simple but very useful technique-of PRP (Platlet Rich Plasma) Rejuvenation. Dr. Satish Shah demonstrated CO2 laser resurfacing. Dr. Dilip Hemnani demonstrated Cleft Ear repair by using ablative RF and nectacryl. Dr. B S Chandrashekher demonstrated microneedle RF Technology for sculpting of face for the first time in India and also mesotherapy for hair loss and Skin Rejuvention.

Dr. Swati Shrivastava demonstrated Botox and fillers right from basics. She along with workshop chairperson

Dr. Atul Kathed, conducted a "Hands on Traning" workshop on Botox & Fillers.

In the evening the inaugural function of DERMAZONE WEST 2011 was solemnized in which Dr. Suresh Joshipura (Past President IADVL) & Dr. H.C. Timbadia(Jt.Sect. IADVL), expressed their views and congratulated IADVL-MP in organizing DERMAZONE WEST in such a grand manner.

Dr. Yogesh Marfatia in his talk mentioned art of using systemic steroids in a way to maximize their efficiency but minimizing side effects. Dr. Sudhir Pujara gave various therapeutics tips which were widely admired not only during conference but also in IADVL-ACAD group.

Dr. Raj Kubba, an international authority on acne, gave new insights in etiopathogenesis of acne & its management.He rightly mentioned that acne has all the ingredients much like a Bollywood masala movie.

Prof. Dr. V.K. Sharma (AIIMS) talked about early recognition of sepsis in Dermatology patients and its energetic management, to avoid any casualty. Our national president elect Dr. C.R. Srinivas, gave his ideas in using phototherapy in his own witty style, which kept the audience enthralled. Psoriasis, Acne & Vitiligo patiens form large bulk of our clientale. Dr. Chitra Nayak on 24th sept. spoke on how to choose rationale treatment for psoriasis. A panel discussion on 25/9/11 was well moderated by Dr. Narendra Gokhale in which panelists, Dr. Yogesh B. Shah, DR. Vinay Saraf, Dr. Bela Shah, Dr. Amit Valia, gave their ideas in how to cope up and live with psoriasis.

In another panel discussion on 24/9/11(Moderator-Dr. Satish Udare) panelists Dr. S.K. Punshi, Dr. Arijit Coondoo, Dr. Ranjan Raval, Dr. N.G. Patwardhan & Dr. Sanjay Dubey- gave their views in how to deal with challenges in managing vitiligo.

Dr. B.S. Chandrashekhar clearly mentioned that for Indian skin, 980 mm pulsed diode laser is best for hair removal.

Dr. Arijit Coondoo spoke on Paederus Dermatatis and Dr. D.G. Saple elaborarted on non sexual genital lesions.

Dr. Ranjan Raval discussed usefullnesss of Autogous serum skin test (ASST) in managing chronic idiopathic urticaria & Dr. Hema Jerajani discussed patch testing with patients own products("as is") in the diagnosis of Allergic contact Dermatitis. Dr. Rita Vipul Vora discussed in detail various pregnancy related dermatoses and their management.

Dr. Asit Mittal updated with What's New in Medical Dermatology'. Dr. Lalit Gupta vividly discussed clinically significant Drug Interaction in Dermatology. Dr. Sanjeev Vaishampayan who belongs to Indore, discussed usage of IVIG in various serious

dermatological disorders, only hinderance in its use being high cost. Prof. Dr. M.K. Singhi, gave various tips in how to manage oral ulcers while Dr. Bela Shah discussed etiopathogenesis of hirsutism and its management, both medical as well as lasers and electrolysis.

Dr. Sanjay Dubey discussed as how the teledermatology has revolutionized the whole concept of practice in healthcare systems, year 2011 being turning point with advent of 3G mobile telecommunications.

Dr. Subodh Sirur, mentioned that due to increased consumer awareness, number of litigation are increasing everyday and we have to be conversant with basic principles of law as applicable to our specialty.

Our own senior colleague Dr. Chetan Patel(Vadodara) who could not attend conference due to some personal reasons, in last CC meet at Banglore has proposed an insurance scheme- even for Dermato surgery, hope this is soon finalized and implemented.

On the last day(25/9/11), Dr. Suresh Joshipura discussed how to manage Delusion of Parsitoses, while Dr. Yogesh B Shah talked about various systemic immunomodulatory and immunosuppressive drug in managing skin disorders and how to monitor them especially a serological test is now available for diagnosing early hepatic fibrosis, in those receiving long term methotrexate.

Dr. J. Maniar was at his best when he discussed various challenges in managing HIV infections. Dr. D.G. Saple mentioned that by deleting genome D-232, by gene therapy a person can get rid off from HIV- permanently.

This gene therapy is being perfected in Germany and will be introduced in near future, thus offering a real cure for HIVafflicted.

In Paediatric Dermatology section-the Trio of Dr. Deepak Parikh, DR. Arun Imandar & Dr. Sandipan Dhar were at their best giving scientific input of highest quality.

Dr. Deepak Parikh talked about his approach in a child with fever and rash with excellent photographs and tricky questions.

Dr. Arun Inamdaar talked about neonatal emergencies and art of managing them.

Dr. Sandipan Dhar discussed comprehensive approach for management of atopic child.

Dr. Chetan Oberai discussed various types of facial hypermalaneoses and their management, emphasizing long term follow up and treatment for melasma. He talked about judicious usage of topicals, peels , sunscreens and lasers in its management.

Dr. Uday Khopkar- gave 10 tips in improving skin biopsy outcomes i.e.:

- 1. involve the patient in decision about biopsy
- 2. choose fully evolved lesion
- 3. two biopsies are better than one
- 4. do deeper biopsies
- 5. use a needle
- 6. train your technician
- 7. clinico pathological correlation is gold standard
- 8. criteria for histopathological diagnosis of leprosy need to be spurced up
- 9. non specific dermatitis can become specific on clinicopathological correlation
- 10. better planning

Dr. Ramesh M. Bhat discussed about current concepts in management of reactions in leprosy. Besides steroids and thalidomide, one can use pentoxyphyline, cyclophosphomide, azathioprine and methotrexate. Also corticosteroid pulse therapy, IVIG, plasmapheresis, tenidab and thalidomide analogue revimid can be used.

Dr. Rashmikant Shah discussed role of vitamins & anti oxidants in dermatology, rightly emphasizing judicious use so as to avoid hypervitaminosis.

Dr. Vijay P. Zawar, mentioned that deviations from classical presentation of HSV are increasingly observed in respect to typical morphology, anatomical locations, clinical severity& systemic manifestations. It is important to be aware of such unusual or unknown clinical features in order to facilitate early diagnosis and management.

Dr. Bipin D. Mehta emphasized that thyroid gland is the most important endocrine gland for skin.

In hypothyroidism one can observe palmo planter keratoderma, diffuse hair loss, icthyosis etc.

Also some autoimmune cutaneous disorders like vitiligo, urticaria, melasma and alopecia areata are associated with hypothyroidism, T.S.H. estimation is best screening test for detecting hypothyroidism . Hyperthyroidism is not associated with skin disease.

Dr. Suresh Talwar presented his study of 100 newly diagnosed patients of Psoriasis in whom he could not find any association with metabolic syndrome. This is in contrast to western studies where increased prevalence of obesity, abnormal BMI and hypertension by themselves lead to metabolic abnormalities.

Dr. Sumit Kar discussed various aspects of cutaneous TB, mentioning that scrofuloderma is the most common skin TB, followed by lupus vulgaris.

Dr. Kiran Godse discussed pathophysiology of Post Acne Pigmentation which is more comman and distressing in darker Indian skin.

He clearly summarized that triple combination using fluocinolone and glycolic peels are useful and safe for management of post acne pigmentation.

PG section: About 60 PG students from all 5 states, enthusiastically participated for Award Paper, Poster presentation and remaining for free papers. 13 PG students were selected for award paper .

Dr.Jayadev Betkerur presented the present financial status of IADVL. He informed that 4 crores is in fixed deposit and nearly a liquid cash of 64 lakhs. 50 lakhs has been paid to ICD 2013. A sum of Rs. 15 lakhs has been given as seed money for DERMACON 2012. DERMCON 2013 also requested to pay an advance money of Rs. 20 lakhs to book the venue in advance as an exceptional circumstance as per the approval by finance committee & AGBM. A sum of Rs.1,42,000 has been paid to SIG on contact dermatitis for conducting a study on parthenium dermatitis through IADVL academy. Money has been released for constitution book and IADVL UG text book of dermatology. The registration renewal of IADVL was done through Dr. Roopak Saxena. Money also has been paid for IADVL news and WCD bidding expenses sum of nearly 34 lakhs has been spent. A sum of 4,54,000 has been given from DERMAZONE south. Dr. P.K.Roy presented a sum of Rs.100,000 to IADVL out of which Rs. 50,000 will go to the state branch. A surplus of 1 crore 20 lakhs was submitted from Dr. V.K.Jain on behalf of DERMACON 2011. House endorsed treasurer's report

IADVL Academy of Dermatology :

The president informed that Dr.Arun Inamdar & Dr. Shymanta Barua have been selected as the chairperson & convener respectively, as Dr. Coondoo & Dr. Manas have resigned from the post. Dr. Shymanta presented the report. He presented the structure of IADVL academy. There are 16 SIGS as to date. SIG on environmental dermatology has asked for Rs. 1,42,000/- which has been released. SIG dermatopathology conducted dermatopathology quiz during DERMACON & slide seminar at AIIMS. 3 days international symposium being held in Delhi in November. IADVL text book of dermatopathology has been taken up by SIG. IADVL teachers training programme is started at Pune, Delhi, AIIMS & Venkatcharmalaya. An agreement has been reached with International society of dermatopathology have done 2 online CMEs. Video conferences in dermatosurgey, psoriasis, bullous disorders and Vitiligo have been conducted. A centre of teledermatology is in process of being created at Chennai. SIG urticaria have written book with the help of international experts. Dr. Kiran Godse informed UCB has come forward to print the booklet. SIG Pemphigus group have prepared pamphlets on Pemphigus. They are also planning to start multicentric study on pulse therapy. SIG on dermatological nursing have prepared a nursing curriculum which will be printed & circulated. A workshop was held at BHU Varanasi. A two day workshop for nurses will be held at Mangalore on Jan 7, 8, 2012

SIG dermatosurgery has organised a dermatosurgery workshop on lasers on September 18, 2011 at Lucknow. SIG leprosy, SIG pigmentary dermatosis are the other two newly formed SIGs. The consensus statements on topical steroids and herpes have been sent for publication. SIG coordinators have been sent for publication. SIG coordinators have been sent for publication. SIG coordinators have been assigned to prepare consensus statements to their subspecialities. The IJDVL & IDOJ have been requested to offer symposium to the SIGs on rotational basis. An online IADVL academy newsletter has been proposed. IADVL will take a decision on starting its own registries. MCI Issues:

The MCI has agreed in principle to implement 2 weeks internship and 25 marks for dermatology in medicine paper II. Dr. Sehegal asked whether this is the proposal or accepted by MCI. The president gave the answer Dr. Thapa told that he was the coordinator for preparing the UG curriculum. Dr. Sehgal asked who will set the questions. Dr. Thapa answered that MCI gives broad outlines and universities have to implement it. Dr. Garg informed that he is involved in preparing PG curriculum. Delhi university has asked the comments regarding the IADVL letter to MCI. Dr. Garg informed that the issues of association will be put forward to MCI. Dr. Sharma informed that this will cover only Delhi university

Constitution Committee:

Dr. Suresh Joshipura thanked all the constitution committee members in bringing out new edition. Dr. Betkarur read the minutes of meeting. First point was about the DERMACON 2014 bid by Tamilnadu. Honorary Secretary mentioned the various events. Dr. C. R. Srinivas abstained from the meeting. The constitution committee unanimously resolved that DERMACON 2014 bid on IADVL TN branch was not in order because following reasons :-

- 1. It was not sent by TN branch as a resolution endorsed by AGBM
- 2. It was sent by an individual member as an EC approval instead of AGBM approval (rule no Part II byelaus clause IX A & B)

Regarding the expansion of EC which took place last year. The constitution committee opined that only elected members constitute EC as per clause – 24 A (1-60nly). Other member will not be included in EC.

The right of rejection by constitution committee members proposal was discussed & point was clarified and it was opined that same proposal though it was rejected by constitution committee can be put forward by the member to the GB (proposed by Dr. Venkataram)

It was also decided that the central council shall be called as principal governing body of IADVL instead of primary or supreme body of IADVL as mentioned in the constitution clause – 15.

Dr. Sacchidanand mentioned that IJDVL editor was the member of EC hence other editors were also included in the EC. He asked whether IJDVL editor has also been removed from EC. Dr. Jayadev informed that only 1-6 elected members constitute EC. He also objected that nobody had objected for the place of IJDVL editor EC so far. Dr. V. K. Sharma informed that a sudden expansion has been taken without approval of constitution committee. Others can be only invitees. Dr. Sacchidanand informed that it was approved by AGBM & IJDVL editor was included in EC without approval from constitution committee. Dr. Sehgal informed that status quo should be continued Dr. Deepak informed that previously editor was not a part of EC, only elected members should be in EC. Dr. Jaydev mentioned that the recommendation of constitution committee should be ratified by AGBM.

PPLFBS (Professional Protection Linked Family Benefit Scheme) :

Dr. Chetan Patel and Dr. Jaydev Betkerur presented the scheme. The scheme has been registered as Dermatologist, Venereologists & Leprologists welfare trust in Gujarat. The scheme helps to provide financial assistance to the family of member of scheme in the event of his/ her death, the members in case of permanent disability. It also provides professional protection & financial assistance in the event of hospitalization. Dr. Venkataram suggested that an expert committee is required to decide the level of negligence to evaluate the claims. Dr. Handa enquired whether this is under IADVL. Dr. Jaydev Betkerur replied that it is under IADVL without any financial liability. It will start from DERMACON 2012 Dr. Jayakar, Dr. Saple & Dr. Srinivas participated in the discussion. The trust will give legal assistance and liability will be paid by the trust upto Rs. 7,00,000/ case / member or Rs. 15,00,000/- per year. Dr. Gupta congratulated all those who are involved in this project. He also mentioned that this scheme was dreamed by Dr Kuriyipe and it has taken so many years to come into practice. Dr. Deepak Parekh & Dr. Venkataram were congratulated EC for this scheme.





IJDVL Issues :

Dr. Thapa, the editor of journal, invited the CC members to become reviewers who have more than 5 indexed publications. In 2010, 3 symposia were published. In 2011, Dermatosurgery taskforce guidelines were published. He mentioned that plagiarism is a major threat. The proposed IJDVL awards for best case reports (Rs.5,000/-) best better to the editor (Rs.3,000) and best image in clinical practice (Rs.2,000) with certificates. It is only for Indian authors. He presented the financial position of IJDVL. Dr. Joshipura wantd to have facebook interaction of IJDVL like JAAD. Dr. Patnaik complained that articles from Eastern states are not published inspite of its originality where as editor publishes his own 5-6 articles either as 1 $^{
m si}$ author and 2nd author. Members of Odisha feel that lobbying is required to publish the articles which has resulted in frustration among members, Dr. Thapa replied that if there are grievances it can be sent to him which can be forwarded to ombudsman Dr. A.K.Bajaj Dr. Jerajani informed that even her articles were rejected when she was President. Always we have to accept rejection and improve. Dr. Putta Srinivas informed that it is difficult to have standards of AIIMS or PGI in all institutions so this has to be considered at the time of rejection. He also opined that editor should not publish too many of his own articles in each issue. Dr. Venkatram informed that rejected articles can be sent to IDOJ and journal has to maintain its standard. The rejection at editorial level is very high and also contribution from members of editorial board is more. Dr. Raghunath Reddy commented that rejection at editorial level is high and instantaneous. Dr. Vijay Zawar mentioned that comments of editor are disheartening. Dr. Narasimha Rao informed that as a reviewer he feels that many a times the articles are of poor standard. The president concluded that the matter will be discussed with editor.

IDOJ matters :

Dr. Shyam Verma, the editor informed that 3rd issue of IDOJ will be uploaded next month. He also told that the question is to have 3 issues instead of 2. The rejection rate for the original articles are relatively high because of low quality. The maximum thurst is on case reports and letters. Average acceptance rate is only 28 %. He assured that in future it may be indexed on pubmed. He requested for more reviewers. He praised the efforts of Dr. Ashique.

Indian Dermatology Online Atlas issues :

Dr. Manas Chatterjee mentioned that even though home page has been created, there is problem in the launching of the atlas. He complained that Medknow has not shown much interest in this project. So, are planning to contact6 summer uinfosystems. They have quoted a sum of Rs. 80,000/-. Dr. Hemangi Jerajani asked whether it is possible to build on what Medknow has done. Dr. V.K. Sharma suggested that if photographs collected for textbook can be used. Dr. Hemangi mentioned that the copyright is with Bhalani. Dr. Patwardhan wanted more advertisement. Dr.Shyam Verma opined that the uploading of photograph should be made hastle free. Dr. Amit Walia informed that copyright is with the author. Dr. Venkataram opined that money for altas appears to be quite high. Dr. Manas clarified that it is mainly for space than for design. The house approved for change in the web designer.

IADVL Text book

Dr. S. Sacchidanand, editor gave the details. He mentioned that Bhalani publishers have given the CD form of textbook. Roadmap has been drawn. Dr. Arun inamdar has resigned from co-editor post in view of brief selected as IADVL academy chairperson. Dr. Chetan oberoi has been elevated to the post of co-editor. Several authors have been contacted. Text book will be released in DERMACON 2013. Dr. Siddappa informed that an agreement has reached for 5 editions. Dr. Siddappa also enquired about the recognition for the work. Dr. Srinivas informed that first pages of 1st edition should be retained in all editions. Dr. Sacchidand told that an international editon also can be published. The house approved. Dr. Sharma wanted to know whether international authors are required. He also informed that continuity is required. Dr. Handa expressed his reservations about international authors. Dr. Narsimha Rao wanted that chance should be given to Indian Authors. It was agreed to give responsibility to editor in selecting authors. Dr. Chetan Oberoi informed that expertise of International authors will be utilized in areas which are grey in India.

IADVL Concise text book of Dermatology

Dr. Vishalakshi Viswanath briefed about the progress made. Publishers are Wiley Blackwell. The contract is for 5 years and with 15 % royality. There was a meeting with publishers on 22nd march 2011. Estimated expense is Rs. 70,000/-. The final version from publisher is expected by DERMACON 2012.

Elections 2012

Dr. Suresh Joshipura, the chief election officer, informed that there are 21 contestants this year. The ballots will be sent from 1st Oct by registered post. Only trial run of electronic voting will be done this year. No duplicate ballots will not be sent as per constitution. Dr. Patwardhan informed that the roadmap for e – voting. He mentioned that there will be dual form of voting. He informed that date of birth of members required to register for e-voting. Dr. Puttasrinivas wanted the returned ballots to be resend to the new addresses. Dr. Ravi Vadevru Dr. Marfatia, Dr. Handa & Dr. Kaushik Lahiri participated in the discussion.

International Conference Matters.

Dr. V. K.Sharma mentioned that venue has been booked for ICD – 2013 & Dr. C.R.Srinivas, the local scientific committee chairperson, is finalizing the program. Dr. Rajiv Sharma, the secretary general, briefed about the ICD 2013. Great Indian Expo mart at Noida is the venue. Contract has been signed on March 17, 2011 by ISD President, IADVL President & ICD President. The conference will be from Dec 4 to 7 Dec. Dr. Thomas Ruzicka is the chairman of scientific committee. He presented the members of Scientific & local scientific committee. Dr. C. R. Srinivas is the local scientific committee co-oridnator. A local meeting was conducted on 12, June 2011. 31 March will be last date for early bird registration, abstract registeration, scholarship application & abstract submission. There will be a meeting with ISD during EADV at Lisbon. Dr. V.K. Sharma informed tht Scientific programme is being prepared & website is already working (www.icd2013.com). He told that we have not yet come to know about liabilities of scholarship programme. The rough estimated budget is 8 crores & a sum of Rs. 3 crores is expected from registration. For plenary session speak ers all facilities are given whereas for chairpersons registration fee will be waved. For the query from Dr. Chetan Oberoi, Dr. Sharma replied that formalities followed by ISD will be followed regarding facilities offered for speakers. Dr. Joshipura advised that it is necessary to contact all international societies for more registration and offer them sister society slots.

WCD issues.

Dr. S. Sacchidanand, international conference bidding committee chairperson, thanked IADVL – EC for permitting to bid WCD. He told that our bid was started late & we lost to Vancouver, for whoom this was the 3rd attempt. He insisted that we have to continue our attempts for WCD bidding. If is required to campaign in various international conferences. Dr. Sacchidanand told that he can try collecting money for the bid. Dr. Sharma informed that a minimum of Rs. 10 crores is required to have to successful bids. Dr. Chetan Oberoi informed that we need to have stalls in each conferences till the bidding comes. Dr. Kiran Godse wanted to concentrate only on ILDS delegates. Dr. Vijay Garg & Dr. Venkatram expressed their opinions. Dr. Siddharth Das and Dr. Handa expressed their concern regarding the money spent. Dr. Handa wanted more active core committee & the members who attend international conferences should be in core committee. He also wanted the Sister Societies of IADVL to become members of ILDS. Dr. Sacchidanand was requested to continue as Chairman till DERMACON 2012.

DERMACON 2012 & 2013 issues

Dr. U.S. Aggarwal briefed about the preparations for DERMACON 2012. He briefed about the Scientific Programme. Dr. Patnaik complained that the poor audience response during post lunch session is discouraging to presenter. Dr. Rajesh Verma & Dr. Kaushik Lahiri participated in the discussion. Dr. Mittal Scientific committee chairman informed that the programme is arranged to cater the needs of all category of Dermatologists. Dr. C. R. Srinivas wanted that the announcements in exhibition area should not disturb the scientific programme. Dr. Thimabdia informed that it is the quality of Scientific programme attracts the delegates.

DERMACON 2013 will be on January 24 – 27. Inspection was carried out on 3rd April 2011. The conference has been arranged at Gujarat University exhibition hall. Dr. Ranjan Rawal thanked the national executive for giving advance money. She mentioned the probable theme of conference. The CME will be on current concepts in Dermatology. Dr. Siddappa announced that he will send Rs. 40,000/- towards Dr. Siddappa medal. He wanted other donors also to come forward to increase the contribution. The secretary informed that IADVL is adding for this medal.

Proposals from members :

- 1. Proposal from Dr. Jayakar Thomas & Dr. Parimohan Kumar regarding honouring late Prof Thambaiah with Kandhari award. President informed that decision has to be taken during AGBM
- 2. History book corrections & additions can be included in next edition of history book. Dr.Kaushik informed that this will go to history committee.
- 3. Regarding ILDS appreciation award, secretary informed that EC too the decision. Dr. V.K.Sharma informed that now onwards it can be discussed during CC meet and names can be finalized. It was agreed to have a regular process. It was decided to ask the award committee to prepare guidelines for these awards.
 - a. Dr. Siddappa wanted to know whether Thambaiah can be awarded when he is not a member of IADVL
 - b. Regarding DERMACON 2014 Coimbatore bid & decision has been taken by constitution committee.
 - c. Dr.Sacchidanand informed that we had only constitution updating committee & it should not take any decision. However Dr. Srinivas felt that as they have updated the constitution, they have right to take decisions also. Dr. Sharma opined that there is only constitution committee which updates the constitution. Dr.Bajaj opined that many of these nominations and meets have come up recently. He also opined that all the resolutions should go to constitution committee who can return the objectionable resolutions to AGBM

Proposals from Dr. Srinivas : regarding conferences organised by local bodies pertaining to subspecialities (Vitilicon, Photocon). These types of conferences should be permitted by IADVL only on specified dates. Profits can be used by SIGs for research purpose. Dr. Sharma opined that IADVL should allocate 10-15 lakhs towards non pigmentary disorders. Dr.Jerajani opined that city branches also require financial support. Dr. Srinivas informed that as IADVL members are providing the expertise & participation, IADVL should get the money. Dr. Sacchidanand wanted that IADVL should not curb branches to organize CMEs & conferences. House agreed in principle about this proposal. Dr. V.K.Sinha and Dr. Venkatram & Dr. Kaushik Lahiri participated in the discussion. It was decided to discuss during GB more about this. There was a discussion about constitution & constitution update committee. Dr. Coondoo wanted the GB to take the decision regarding this matter. Dr.Walia confirmed that it is constitution committee only.

Dr. Sharma wanted the resolution of spending money on research should be passed.

Proposals from Dr. Venkatram.

Regarding financial proposals to go to finance committee instead of directly to AGBM which has been missed in the updated constitution issue. Dr. Sharma informed that we require to have standard operation procedure book. It was agreed to include this in the constitution. Reasoning: Conference need reforms. Organizer is suspicious of reforms if he plans to contest elections.

He also gets undue advantage over other contestants.

4)NRI DATA BASE :We need more basic research. Our PG students are not interested in Basic research. India has a vast pool of NRI involved in basic research. These include, scientists, PhD students, employees in Pharma industry and also in high places such as NASA etc. IADVL should for a small committee which will include the Honorary Secretary and Joint Secretary and Vice President. A data base should be created and the expertise and infrastructure available to NRI should be made available to dermatologists in India.IADVL can fund such studies . Initially we can limit our self to one or 2 such projects for which applications should be invited. Primary Investigator will be from India and Co –investigator from elsewhere who can be a non dermatologist.

5) IADVL inauguration should be scraped. The meeting should begin with the welcome address by the President followed by briefing by Chairman Scientific. All other events awards release of books can be planned for Day-2 during IADVL felicitation day. 6) Serve working lunch only during conference. One gala dinner only. Till 9 PM only soft music to be permitted during dinner.

It is very difficult to interact with each other if loud music commands and demands attention.

7) ACAD IADVL - Honorary Secretary may be permitted to delegate the day to day operations to any representative of his choice. 8) Venue selection of DERMACON by elections

Dr. Satyadarshi Patnaik, Odisha

I put forth my following proposals to be discussed during the GB meeting in jaipur.

Recently the free paper presentation afternoon sessions during DERMACON are running short of audience thus frustrating and demoralising the speaker who has endured a lot of pain staking efforts for his presentations. As a result private practitioner people from lesser known regions lose their zeal to present paper. This is happening mainly due to the following reasons:-

 Pharmaceuticals holding alluring game shows with awards and compliments during scientific sessions which should be stopped. They may do this during lunch or after 5pm

2. Sight seeing trips are organised by organising secretary mainly in afternoon which reduces the audience

3. Local marketing. (famous available products may be marketed in conference stalls)

On the other hand audience may be encouraged by instituting awards for the delegate having maximum attendance during paper presentations. Attendance can be obtained during start and end of session. Award may be given to the delegate who puts the most pertinent and authenticated question to the speaker.

Proposal for start of new awards and grants Venkataram Mysore LM KN 3211

It is a matter of some concern that very few research grants are given out by IADVL- the only one available now is by Loreal. Like wise there are no awards for innovations, nor for any community dermatology activity.

In view of this , I suggest that the following grants awards be instituted out of IADVL funds:



- IADVL research grants, worth 50,000 Rs, one for each Special interest group totaling a maximum of Rs 10 lakhs
- b) Innovations award of Rs 25,000 one for each SIG totaling a maximum of Rs5,00,000
- c) Award for outstanding community dermatology project by an IADVL member Rs 25,000
- d) One award for innovations by any dermatologist Internationally- worth 1000 US dollars- this will raise the profile of our association in the international community and help our bid for WCD

The Acadmy can be entrusted with the task of framing guidelines for these. The funding for these awards should primarily come from the Academy budjet- Interested companies and individuals may also sponsor it. The reports should be implemented from this year only -2012.

Proposal for standard operative procedures in IADVL

- Dr. Venkatram Mysore LM/KN/3211
- Dr. Arijit Coondoo

a)

Proposed that a protocol for Standard Operative Procedures in official functioning of IADVL be formulated Explanation:

A Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) is a set of written instructions that document a routine or repetitive activity followed by an organization. The development and use of SOPs are an integral part of a successful quality system as it provides individuals with the information to perform a job properly, and facilitates consistency in the quality and integrity of functioning of the organization. In IADVL, there are several administrative procedures which are carried on each year- eg. handing over charge in the case of the President, Honorary General Secretary and Honorary Treasurer; methods of documentation and conduction of general body minutes; methods of website maintenance/yahoo groups, conference guidelines etc. Likewise, several points submitted by members and subsequently passed on AGM often pertain to administration and not necessarily to constitution. Eg. Distribution of work to vice presidents, joint secretaries, Website organization, some financial guidelines such prior intimation to treasurer and finance committee chairperson for any project above one lakh. Such agenda neither get included in constitution nor is there any other system to document them as a book.

This results in different types of problems e.g. agenda initiated by the past president remains incomplete while the new President starts his own agenda which may or may not be completed during his tenure. The new Hon. General Secretary and the new Honorary Treasurer take a few months to understand the system of day-to-day administrative and financial functioning of IADVL which is becoming more and more complicated as the Association expands. Many agenda which are approved by AGM for enhancing efficiency are often not implemented at all. There is poor documentation of administrative processes, with the result that administration varies from one year to the next, varying with each president and committee.

Hence for prompt and efficient continuity in official functioning of IADVL formulating SOPs is now an urgent need of the day.We humbly request the august body to appoint a taskforce to draft SOPs to stream line administration and enhance efficiency. The taskforce will submit the draft proposals to the CC meeting in 2012 and will be finally passed in AGM at 2013. The report of the taskforce after approval should be published in IADVL newsletter and also placed on website.

Proposal for strict action against erring medical equipment (Laser Companies) (Dr Vivek Mehta (LM/ND/4813)

I am life member of IADVL. My membership number is- LM/ND/4813. I want to Request the Proposal for strict action against the medical equipment companies having have a major presence in all national and regional conferences who default in providing the equipment on time or provide duplicate equipments or refurbished equipments rather than providing genuine equipments or who do not respect the initial agreement between the doctor and company. I will like to draw your attention in my case. I placed order with Mr. Dilip Meswani, Coherent medical systems, Mumbai for purchase of True Co2 fractional Sellas C1S F1 Surgical laser systems For Rs 12.20 lacs. 12 lacs was the cost of machine and I agreed to pay him extra 20000 rupees for the dollar rate fluctuation. I had paid him Rs 3 lac 5 thousand rupees (3,05,000 as 25% advance) through cheque no-758386 dated 15/10/2011. Proforma invoice given to me clearly states that delivery time is-4-5 weeks. After not getting response for 5 weeks when I contacted the owner Mr Dilip Meswani, he asked for one week extension that lapsed on 30/11/11. When I tried to contact person named Mr Prem Ranjan at the Delhi branch of coherent medical system, he told me to pay more money as dollar rate is high. During the initial agreement it was quite clear that I was paying him additional 20000

rupees for dollar fluctuation. After waiting for 6 weeks and getting harassed mentally, when I contacted Mr Dilip Meswani to return the advance that I paid him, he refused to return it. I have already initiated legal action against the company. I request you to take a suitable action against the companies who clearly breach the trust by blacklisting the distributor and company and not allowing them to participate in any of regional and National Conferences. I also request you to give caution against the defaulting companies to other members so that no one else suffers the way I have been suffering for last 6 weeks. We do them favor to exhibit their products and they are cheating us.

Proposal for AGBM closing year 2011 at DERMACON 2012.

1. At present the office of the TN branch of the IADVL is in shambles. There has been lot of violations and flouting of the constitutional bylaws where the AGBM was conducted in a reprehensible manner not following any of the agenda.

Dr. A. Krishna (1928-2011),

Dr. A. Krishna (1928-2011), completed his MBBS at Stanley Medical College, and specialized in the then nascent field of Dermatology/Cosmetic Dermatology.

He was a resident under Dr. C.S.Livingwood (who was the first president of the American Academy of Dermatology) at the Henry Ford Hospital, Detroit and post graduate with Dr.Arthur.C.Curtis at the University of Michigan. He also trained for a year in Dermatopathology with Dr. Herman Pinkus at the Wayne State University.

During the above mentioned period, he also trained in Cosmetic Dermatology under Dr.Beninson. After a brief stint with Stanley Medical Hospital as an honorary dermatologist, Dr.Krishna set up his private practice in Mylapore where the clinic still functions.

Dr.Krishna has held the posts of President, IADVL, Karnataka-Tamil Nadu branch and was also the All India president.

He was a Fellow of the American Academy of Dermatology and Life Member of the American Medical Society of Vienna.

He has presented many scientific and technical papers across the globe, especially on CRYOGENICS and was recommended by Dr.R.Srinivasan(IIT-M) for Fellowship of the Indian Council of Cryogenics; the only medical doctor to be so nominated.

Incidentally, Dr.A.Krishna was the son of Dr.Anantha Narayana Iyer, the 2nd Indian principal of Stanley Medical College, who, following his retirement took a 6-year contract to start the Kashmir Medical College.

Dr.A.Krishna's son Dr.Anand Krishna and daughter, Dr.Vidya Rampradeep are both renowned dermatologists.

Dr Ramaswamy Ganapati Passed 6TH JULY 1930 - 13TH NOV 2011

It is with deep regret that we write the obituary of a personal friend, a Professional associate and a Fellow worker. Dr Ramaswamy Ganapati passed away peacefully on 13th November 2011.

He was a keen observer, an expert clinician, a committed scientist and above all, a kind and loving doctor. Born in a middle class family in the southern most part of India, Tirunelveli, Tamil Nadu on 6 July, 1930, he completed his medical education in Madras. Dr R Ganapati started his career by establishing a Primary Health centre in Valathi in South Arcot district in Tamil Nadu. During this period he had the privilege of having first informal lessons in leprosy from Dr K Ramanujam whom he used to visit often.

Later he joined Acworth Leprosy Hospital (ALH) as Assistant Medical Officer where he had the opportunity to see lots of patients, something like 300 old patients and 50 new cases daily and learning clinical aspects of leprosy from an eminent teacher, Dr N Figueredo This coupled with an emotional satisfaction of serving in a neglected medico-social field created a lasting impact and proved to be a turning point in his career. The opportunity of doing clinical research in leprosy emerged when he was appointed as the Research Officer. The post of Research Officer and the experience he gained were most crucial in determining his future contributions in leprosy.

While at ALH his vibrant enthusiasm and his commitment to work inspired his colleagues and associates to form an activist group from amongst the staff who joined the



rebellion against injustice and thus an NGO by name Acworth Leprosy Hospital Society for Research, Rehabilitation and Education in Leprosy (ALH-RRE Society) was registered.

It was an extremely uncomfortable and restless seven year service in leprosy (1963 to1970) that he had to put up with in ALH. In 1970-71 he had the opportunity to go to Chingleput and worked under Dr Desikan at his own cost.

His stature in the medical fraternity enabled him to start leprosy treatment service of high quality in medical institutions particularly teaching hospitals. He assisted the Government of India in his capacity as the member of National Leprosy Eradication Commission, the highest policy making statutory body as well as Maharashtra Government as a member of State Leprosy Council and Chairman of the State Rehabilitation Committee. He functioned as consultant to Govt. of India / WHO for assessment of training of centres in 1986-87 and for MDT Districts from 1987 to 1998. He was a member of the WHO Expert Advisory Panel from 1991 to 2000.

He published over 300 scientific papers some of which represent outstanding landmarks on various aspects of leprosy. A recent analysis of publications by scientists in leprosy journals (1950-2007) carried out by independent experts revealed that Dr Ganapati was in the company of seven distinguished Indian authors who have to their credit more than 120 papers indexed in "Medline" (Leprosy Review, 79, 387-400.2008).

President of India honoured Dr. Ganapati by conferring the National Award of PADMASHRI in the year 1983. The highest scientific honour of the country for exemplary research work in leprosy namely, JALMA Trust Fund oration Award was conferred on him by the Indian Council of Medical Research in 1986.

The loss of Dr R Ganapati is deeply felt by all leprosy workers who knew him and all leprosy patients who were benefitted by him.

Dr Inderjeet Kaur

Prof Inderjeet Kaur was born on 22nd October 1948.She graduated from Punjabi University,Patiala in 1972 and obtained her MD in Dermatology,Venereology and Leprology from the same college in 1979.She started her teaching career in Dermatology as a Registrar in Rajindra Mediacl College,Patiala.In 1980 she joined our department at the PGI as a Senior Resident and remained attached to the Institute in various capacities for 31 years till her untimely,unexpected and unfortunate demise on 7th September 2011.

She became Professor in 2006. During this vast academic career she authored more than 175 papers in peered reviewed indexed National and International journals and presented about 30 important papers at various conferences. She was an active member of several academic associations including IADVL. She successfully held various organizational positions in different coinferences, CMEs and workshops organized under the aegis of these bodies

Her special areas of interest were leprosy and psoriasis in addition to cliniacl dermatology. Her clinical acumen was cute and superb. She gave importance to every minute detail on whatever lesions were there on the skin.

She was a great teacher and took keen interest in academic performances of the residents. She was always concerned about the general well being of her residents. A few generations of dermatology residents learnt the art of clinical observation from her. In addition, her concern for social, financial and psychological impact of the disease on the patient



was praiseworthy. This was a virtue that her students also observed, experienced and learned to imbibe in their clinical practices.

Her contributions to Dermatology were recognized by many organizations. She was awarded Fulford Oration by IADVLin 1998 and was the resceipient of Maria Duran Medal in 2010. This award is to honour memory of Maria M. Duran former Secretary-Genaral and Executive Vice President of the International Society of Dermatology.

Prof Inderjeet Kaur had to face several difficulties in her life due to prolonged illness of her husband, a famous cardio thoracic surgen at the PGI.She remained unfazed through all these difficulties, faced them with courage and poise.She almost single handedly reared her two children and established them in life.

Her death has created a a vacum which would be difficult to fill. It is a loss to the Dermatology fraternity. During my long associations of more than 25 years with her I never saw her loosing her cool. She was always smilling and in retrospect we now realize there was a sadness in this smile

which we unfortunately could not pick up. Every body who had met her even once would miss her. She contributed a lot towards

Dermatology and these will be remembered always It is difficult to imagine Dermatology Department at the PGI without Prof Inderjeet Kaur

We pray to God that her soul rests in peace.
