Dear Colleagues,

We are in the last quarter of year and much activity has taken place during the past 6 months. The first ever combined MID-DERMACON and CC MIDDERRMA meet held at Hyderabad in July 2012 went off well. The general feedback from the members was positive for both events. IADVL is in the process of finalizing the methods of conduct of future MID-DERMACONS and is calling for applications from various state bodies for hosting it next year in this newsletter. Hopefully, the process would be smoothened in next few years.

For the first time this year, multicenter studies proposed by SIGs (of IADVL academy of Dermatology) were invited for funding. And of the applications received, three multicenter studies were found suitable. It is reassuring to see the increased interest in research in members of IADVL. There has been an increased response from members for IADVL-Loreal research grants as well as for IADVL training fellowships. A record number of 43 applications were received for IADVL- Loreal research grants and about 75 applications were received for IADVL training fellowships. This is very heartening, as such increased participation reflects the increased awareness in members of IADVL initiatives and activities.

Our state branches are very active during last 3 months. More than 350 new members have joined IADVL till now this year. Information regarding observing Vitiligo and Psoriasis day were received from number of State IADVL offices. Many state branches have already held their CUTICONS successfully. The IGNQPP is going on smoothly with the help of all the members involved in the process.

We are in the middle of elections for new national executives for year 2013 and except for initial glitches; the process is going on smoothly. By the time the next issue would be out, it would be New Year and the new national executives would be in place.

Notes from Treasurer's desk

Dear Members,

Season's Greetings

We are nearing the end of this financial year and let me take the opportunity to appraise you about the finances of our association. IADVL hosted the MIDDERMACON and CC mid-Derma meet together this year successfully and by this we could reduce our expenses considerably. However, as the treasurer of IADVL for the past 8 months I have realized that the financial health of IADVL needs urgent attention. The Income sources of IADVL are limited and trickles in drop wise, while the expenditure outflow is constant and ever increasing. We are publishing three Newsletters every year which are supported neither by advertisements nor sponsorships.

Good news is that our official journal IJDVL is financially very sound and much better placed than the main organization, the IADVL. In fact, most of the money IADVL is holding at present actually belongs to IJDVL, which I realized to my surprise recently. The actual capital reserve of IADVL is so low that it worries me while preparing the budget for next year. In such a situation, the continued contributions from IADVL funds to already healthy IJDVL need to be re-viewed. In addition to restructuring outflow, we have to seriously look at the methods to increase income sources of IADVL, (1/4th of the collected membership fees and 20% of DERMACON excess are the only capital sources at present), otherwise in future it would probably become difficult to run the association in the same manner with ever increasing membership and needs. There is also a need to look at methods to avoid dependency on money from DERMACON excess to fund the association.

One more aspect which needs to be addressed is the transparency of audit reports on income & expenditure at DERMACON and National IADVL. I request all the members to think seriously and come up with suggestions to improve the income of IADVL and reduce the expenditure.

On 14th July 2012 Session-I

Agenda discussed at EC IADVL meet held on 28th and 29th April, 2012, and brought forward and discussed at CC Meet at Hyderabad on 14th and 15th July 2012.

1. The Dr. Toresekar proposed IADVL diary of having all the details of IADVL and its activities. **Discussion:** Dr. Toresekar explained the need for having dual E-diary and IADVL personal diary. Dr. A J S Pravin: Events and dates to be incorporated in the diary –. **Result: Approved.**

2. DVL welfare trust issues were elaborated by Dr. Chetan Patel. Proposed a single payment mode to become life member if any member accepts to pay one lump sum amount Rs. 10,000/- as it would suffice for 30 years of his life to take care of yearly contribution. We can open this for members all who had already joined also. As of now the annual membership is Rs. 300/- apart from the joining fee. We need to encourage younger generation to join it. The indemnity coverage for those would like to opt for it would be Rs. seven lakhs, per case and Rs. fifteen lacs aggregate per year, once it is applicable. One legal advisor should be at Baroda and there is a need for legal support at state level as consumer protection act issues need to be addressed in the local courts. Dr Chetan Patel at the

end said that he would come with modified rules after discussing with DVL trust trustees by MID DERMA cc meet. Dr Chetan Patel's Presentation: Discussion: Matter should be put on website. There queries from the members can be discussed. **Result: Passed**

3. Proposal by Dr Cr Srinivas - The Kandhari award: The prestigious Kandhari award of IADVL should not be given to any person from the state which is organizing DERMACON to avoid conflict of interest and selection bias. It should preferably from other states of India. Discussion: A committee to be formed having members except from organizing DERMACON. So members can decide qualified candidate for this Kandhari award. **Decision: Passed by CC**

Result: Not Approved

4. Additional advance of Rs 20 lakhs to ICD from IADVL : Proposal by Dr VK Sharma: Dr VK Sharma came with the request to IADVL that he is need of 20 more lakhs, in addition to 50 lakhs already given, to him for expenses involved in the preparations for ICD.

Decision: It was passed by EC. Result: Advance granted. House requested Dr VK Sharma to submit the accounts for 50 Lakhs taken from IADVL for ICD2013. After receiving which IADVL would release the 20 lakhs sanctioned as advance.

5. IADVL Academy of Dermatology Proposals: Proposed by Dr. Shyamanta Barua

a. Following restructuring of the composition of the Academy was proposed: (a) Induction of the IADVL President Elect as an Ex-Officio member (b) Induction of the Immediate Past Chairperson and Convener of the Academy as advisors and (c) Induction of the IDOJ Editor as a member. **Decision:** All three proposals were unanimously passed.

b. SIG Evaluation: The task of evaluation of the SIGs was undertaken for the first time ever by the IADVL Academy. Dr. Shyamanta apprised that SIG Urticaria and SIG Dermatopathology performed best and were closely followed by SIGs on Dermatology Nursing, Pigmentary Dermatoses and Dermatotomy. On the other hand, the SIGs on Paediatric Dermatology, Genodermatosis and Trichology performed poorly. Dr. Shyamanta stated that the Academy awaits the recommendations of the EC and CC based on this evaluation. **Decision:** It was opined that letters should be sent to all non-functioning SIGs asking for this lapse while others suggested remedial measures for them. Some also opined that these poorly performing SIGs should be either scrapped or revamped.

c. IADVL SIG Research Grant: It was proposed that an IADVL SIG Research Grant be instituted to fund multicentric research projects in the thrust areas of each SIG. Applications have been invited from all



SIGs. A sum of Rs 10 lacs has already been allocated for this annual grant.

d. **SIG Sessions in DERMACON:** It was broached that SIGs be represented at DERMACON on a rotational basis. The Local Scientific Committee of DERMACON 2013 has informed that up to four SIGs can be allotted sessions at Ahmedabad. The EC has, accordingly, empowered the Academy to suggest four SIGs after exclusion of those specialties otherwise represented in the scientific programme through focus sessions and sister society meets. **Decision:** Accepted.

e. **Guidelines for Pharmaceutical support for SIG activities:** It was mooted that all SIG CMEs/Workshops/Conferences supported by pharmaceutical companies will be governed by Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) in place for CUTICONS/DERMACONS. If a grant has to be accepted for scientific publications, it would be acknowledged with - "Publication has been made possible by an educational grant from". It should be categorically mentioned in an official agreement with the concerned pharmaceutical company that it cannot construe such sponsorship as an endorsement of any product or instrument or similar by IADVL. **Decision:** Approved.

f. **IADVL Training Fellowship issues:** As per the GB decision at Jaipur, the IADVL Academy will, henceforth, screen applications for these training fellowships. The Academy Chairperson & Convener will constitute a panel of Academy Members for such screening. Evaluation of existing Fellowship centres would be initiated and criteria for approving new Fellowship centres would be drafted by the Academy. The following proposals were mooted regarding these fellowships: (a) the fellowship amount should be hiked to Rs. 10,000 (b) the policy of one faculty for one subject should be implemented and (c) the fellowships should be opened up on honorary basis for overseas countries over and above the present fellowships. **Decision:** All three proposals were passed.

g. **IADVL Academy on the web:** It was proposed that there should be a dedicated web page of the IADVL Academy in the association website with space/links for SIGs. **Decision:** Accepted. The Academy Convener was asked to liaise with the Hon. General Secretary for this purpose.

h. **DERMACON Orations & Award Papers:** It was proposed that the online abstract submission process should be updated with all modalities for rejecting incomplete or invalid applications, wherever applicable. **Decision:** Passed. The Scientific Chairperson of DERMACON 2013, Dr. Y. S. Marfatia, stated that the changes asked for will be put in place.

i. **The local city/town/region sub-branches of IADVL State Branches should be named as IADVL Chapters for clarity and ease of administrative hierarchy and function.** This nomenclature of "Chapter" should be made applicable for all new local units of IADVL

as well as for those who have been functioning previously by the name of sub-branches. **Discussion:** Dr. Shyamanta Barua then clarified that although the concept of sub-branches is there in the constitution, a uniform nomenclature for them is lacking, which is the basis of this Already functioning IADVL city/town/region sub branches e.g. Bangalore Dermatological Society or Malabar Dermatology Club) may continue as such but all new sub-branches should be hereafter named as IADVL Chapters. **Decision:** Passed

j. **Proposal: Mandatory inclusion of all IADVL Life Members into the IADVL General Yahoo e-Group** membership of IADVL General Yahoo e-group should be made mandatory for all Life Members (LMs) of IADVL. Once all the existing LMs are enrolled into the group, all new LMs should be automatically drafted into the group at the time of validating their membership. **Discussion:** Dr. Ramesh Bhat opined that this was followed for all new LMs during his tenure as Honorary Secretary, IADVL but it was seen that many LMs opt not to join the group. Dr. C. R. Srinivas stated that the proposal holds merit and should be implemented. **Decision:** Passed in principle

6. **DERMACON 2013 Progress report by Dr. Ranjan Rawal (Org. secretary):** There is a good progress in the matter of DERMACON 2013 to be held from 24th to 27th January, 2013 at Ahmedabad, Gujarat. CME theme would be the 'current concepts in Dermatology'. The venue for the conference is Gujarat University Convention & Exhibition Center which is in a class of its own. Sessions will be start at 08:30.am sharp. Regarding SIG participation, 6 group slots will be randomly selected as proposed by Dr. CR Srinivas. SIG's groups would have a max. time of 1 hour each. Sister societies would be accommodated. Posters would be in electronic format. Abstract book will be given in CD form. As per GB resolution no music will be there during lunches, only light music will be in evening. Heavy music after 9:00.pm. IADVL E-groups would have 30 minutes to 45 minutes in prime time for their presentations. Slot for get-together of IADVL e groups would be provided in one of the halls after scientific programme.

7. **Allocation of DERMACON Venue through ballots: Proposed by Dr Suresh Talwar:**

Dr. Talwar proposed having DERMACON venue through ballots for 1 year. If is successful then bids it should be next 3 years. Bids for the DERMACON venue should be 2 ½ years in advance as per norms form various stated IADVL. Name of proposed city, name of the bidding state, name of the organising secretary, name of the scientific preferred secretary should be included in the bids, he suggested. The election officer will prepare a ballot paper for venue selection having details. Voters can have 1,2,3 choices of venues.

Decision: It was passed unanimously.

8. **Guidelines for Pharmaceutical support for SIG activities:** Dr Kiran Godse had brought forward this issue by a proposal of IADVL approval for their SIG activity supported by a Pharma company. EC



felt that it is heartening that the activities of many SIGS are being supported by Pharma industries. However, they may use this opportunity to promote their products by labeling them as being approved/supported by these SIGs of IADVL. Dr Barua suggested that the guidelines for Pharmaceutical support for SIG activities can be as follows: CMEs/Workshops/Conferences can be supported by pharmaceutical companies as is done in CUTICONS/DERMACONS and will be governed by Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) when they are in place. If a grant has to be accepted for scientific publications, it would be acknowledged with – "This publication has been made possible by an educational grant from..... " or "Print courtesy from educational grant of ". It should be categorically mentioned in an official agreement with the concerned pharmaceutical company that it cannot construe such sponsorship as an endorsement of any product or instrument or similar by IADVL.

Result: Passed.

9. Dr. Sacchidanand proposal: The Bid for DERMACON from any state branch should also contain a proposed budget and the amount of savings that they will contribute. The organizers should sign an agreement (Org. Chairman, Org. Secretary and Treasurer) that they will abide by IADVL rules and guidelines. That the Organizers will submit the complete audited accounts within six months of the conference. This has to be compulsorily printed in IADVL news and circulated before CCM.

Discussion: The organizers of DERMACON should sign an agreement (Org. Chairman, Org. Secretary and Treasurer) that they will abide by IADVL rules and guidelines. **Result: Already is being practiced, if not, should be done: passed.** 2. Accounts of DERMACON of that year should be published in second issue of that year IADVL news booklet, which means they should be submitted by MID derma CC meet of that year.

Result: Passed

10. Indian Journal of Dermatology, Venereology and Leprology (IJDVL) issues: by Dr. D.M Thappa: Medknow is the publishers of IJDVL. He opined that IJDVL could generate more revenue by charging for downloading PDF files. There are new features and it make it compactable for IPAD. In India will be free. In outside India it will be chargeable.

Result: Passed

New Proposals received and discussed in the CC Meet & AGB meeting for Dermacon 2013 on 14th & 15th July, 2012

1. Dr. C.R. Srinivas - President Proposal

Proposal for cancellation of Workshop during DERMACON

As per our constitution DERMACON should not be for more than 3 days and one day CME. However many local body organize a standalone workshop apart from CME and even along with CME as a parallel session. CME is a plenary session and no parallel workshop

should be organised. No workshop should be permitted one day prior to CME also as this prolongs the stay and some may choose to attend the workshop and skip CME and conference to cut short duration of stay. Even if permitted the organizers should obtain prior permission and it should be merged with DERMACON.

Discussion Dr. Suresh Talwar raised the point that most of the workshops held prior to DERMACON funds raised between 50 to 1 Crore. That almost becomes un-accountable. Decision: The proceeds of the preconference workshops should be included in the accounts of the conference. Dr. Joshipura informed that this is already being implemented at DERMACON 2013. Decision on cancellation of workshop to be taken at AGBM.

2. Proposal by Dr Devesh Mishra

Regarding Quorum for CC meet and our AGBMs

The number of members to be present as a must should be 7 (at least 3 can be other than office-bearers) for CC meet and 40 for AGBMs respectively, is grossly less than desirable. Our member strength is now nearing 7500 (around 6000 being LMs). Also number of state presidents and Sec. + EC members is over 50 without adding CC members from states.

We can have more numbers for fulfilling the "quorum" to reflect our true member's strength at these meets. As the present no's from the present constitution is old and grossly insufficient. Ref. IADVL Constitution 2010, page 42, Quorum.

Result: No decision arrived at.

3. Proposal from Dr P Narasimha Rao and Dr DBN Murthy:

Proposal 1. Increase in the allocation/provision for telephone/mobile bill expenditure in constitution for President, Hon Gen Secretary and Hon Treasurer.

Background: At present our constitution (page 25 under head expenditure) limits the expenditure on telephone bill of Hon Gen Secretary and Hon Treasurer to maximum of Rs 5000 per year which is grossly insufficient in this era multiple usage of mobile (texting, telephoning, emailing, downloading info etc) for IADVL official purposes.

Discussion: It was informed to the house by Dr Ramesh Bhat, past secretary and Dr Betkerur, the finance committee chairman that it is a printing error in the constitution and should have been Rs 5000 per month, instead of per year. House agreed to correct the error in the constitution.

Proposal 2. Proposal for opening current account for IADVL - propose the following for your perusal and consideration: IADVL EC may be permitted to open a current account in addition to SB account and fixed deposit accounts in same branch of the nationalized bank, fully following existing rules and guidelines of opening such an account. (Screened by finance committee)

Background: As per our constitution, (page 24, No. 20) IADVL can



open a SB account and fixed deposit account in any nationalized bank in its name. However, there is no provision for opening a current account, which is required for smooth functioning of IADVL financial activities.

Reasoning of need for current account: With increasing need for online bookings (such as booking of online tickets for EC meet, CC meet etc) and increasing international monetary transactions (transfer of membership fee to ILDS, or other international IADVL transactions, participation in society meetings) there is a need for IADVL secretariat to perform internet based national and international banking transactions, for which a current account facility is required, as such facilities are not being extended to SB account.

This may be permitted on the similar guidelines as applicable to the opening of SB account and should be in the same branch on the name of IADVL only. Both account may be linked and shown as IADVL accounts only. A small part of IADVL funds may be kept in current account as and when needed for such transactions.

Discussion: Discussed in detail. Finance committee members to whom it was sent participated. Dr VK Sharma also took part in the debate. Result: CC passed the proposal of opening of current account in the same lines of SB account but the current account's upper limit should be Rs. 2,00,000/ only.

4. Proposal from Dr P Narasimha Rao (screened by Constitution committee already) Proposal for inclusion of names of states Goa, Uttarakhand etc in our constitution I have observed to my dismay that in whole of our constitution there is no mention of two states, Goa and Uttarakhand. They have to be mentioned as part of combined branches of "Maharashtra & Goa" and as "UP and Uttarakhand" Maharashtra is wrongly mentioned as single state branch in our constitution, although it has been a combined branch with Goa for a very many years.

Also the details of the states and UT which form a part of North East branch have to be clearly mentioned. In effect, all the states and union territories of India have to have mention somewhere in our constitution, stating to which larger state they form a part or mentioned as a part of combined branch. This would make IADVL truly a pan Indian DVL association.

Discussion: Passed.

5. Proposal by Dr Suresh Talwar for changes in constitution

a) Pg 5 IMPORTANT DATES TO REMEMBER: To add: "31 July Last date for submission of abstracts for orations and award papers 31 July Bidding of DERMACON: Two and half years before the actual conference, i.e. for Jan 2015 conference one should bid by 31 July 2012"

b) Pg 11 (11a) : "New state branches may be formed by a minimum of 25 (instead of 15) life members"

c) Pg 58 (ANNEXURE VI 2): To add the highlighted: The IADVL

Academy of Dermatology will work under the supervision of the IADVL Executive Committee. Its members will be 10-12 eminent dermatologists with an academic background and EC members. This should include IADVL President, Immediate Past President, President Elect, Honorary General Secretary (This was passed in Bangalore EC). Representation of all zones and the AFDG should be considered.

Result: Passed

6. Proposal by Dr. Venkataram Mysore

Proposal 1: All iadvl award winners should be recognized by printing their names, along with their work done and reason why he/she was given the award, and the nature of the award, in iadvl newsletter and in conference abstract book. Presently only their names and names of awards are being announced and it becomes unclear as to why the awardee has been awarded.

Decision: The list of award winners would be included in IADVL news Bulletin.

Proposal 2: I had submitted the following point to central council in 2011:

The constitution states on Page no 34, 35 post of secretary, treasurer, Joint secretary that they Must have been actively involved in the affairs of the Association in an official capacity *either at the central level or in the branch, combined branch level or a Central Council member from the branch for a minimum period of 2 year either continuous or with breaks. However it is not specified what the official capacity is. This means that any member with no significant administrative experience or even minimal experience (such as CC member for two years) in the association can contest for the two most important positions in IADVL. This is a serious lacuna which needs to be addressed. This was then referred to the constitution committee which accepted the suggestion and recommended modifications in their report and submitted to AGM in DERMACON Jaipur. However, to the best of my knowledge, these have not been implemented in this year's election. I request you to kindly inform the house about the status of the changes as advised by the constitution committee.

(Opinion on Dr Mysore Venkatram's proposal by Dr Suresh

Joshiyura: Dr Joshiyura mentioned that Dr M Venkatram's proposal was indeed discussed at Constitution committee meet in 2011 Subject: Amendment moved by Dr. Venkataram Mysore: Since the qualifications necessary for the post of secretary and president are not specified properly, the following may be added to the existing matter in the relevant clauses: Position of Hon. Secretary: A candidate should have served as a secretary or treasurer at the state level or a joint secretary or treasurer at the central level Treasurer: A candidate should have served as a secretary or treasurer at the state level or a joint secretary at the central level. This will be added to the qualifications already listed.

Result: Passed



7. MP IADVL issues: Dr Devesh Mishra, the Vice President IADVL as its representative urgent resolve all MP pending issues and help the members to arrive at a mutually acceptable agreement to work together as a single unit. Dr Devesh established contact with the members of IADVL MP. A meeting was organized at Bhopal on 27th May, 2012. IADVL appreciates all the MP members for cooperation. The consensus opinion arrived at Bhopal meeting was discussed. Members of CC, members of EC of MP and invited member from MP Dr Chandel along with the National EC discussed this matter in detail. Members expressed their desire for the resolution of MP issue amicably. House unanimously supported all the decisions arrived at Bhopal meeting by raising of hands and wished that MP IADVL to implement it in letter in spirit.

Result: Members of MP agreed to resolve the issues of MP branch as per the Bhopal consensus proposal. (The state branch of MP in the AGBM held during its CUTICON passed the Bhopal proposal smoothly in October, 2012. IADVL national EC congratulates all the members of MP IADVL for resolving the outstanding issues amicably)

8. Dr. Atul Kocchar's Proposal: for reducing amount for Deposit fee passed at AGBM at Jaipur for contesting election. 1. Deposit should be same for all post. It should be Rs. 5,000/. 2. Refunded if candidates withdrawn. Dr. Roopak said it should be called Deposit as not the fee. The Deposit should be same for all posts.

Decision: The proposal forwarded to be GB Ahmedabad.

9. Dr. Shyamanta Barua:

1. Sub branch of state branch should be named as Chapter of IADVL: This is regarding sub branches of state branches of city or town branches should named as IADVL chapters for function & hire key & for the clarity is of higher administrative. Local Dibrugarh branch of IADVL is called as chapter of N.E States branch. New ones should be named as sub branches of the state branch wishes to form should be named as Chapter of IADVL. - Passed.

2. Mandatory inclusion of Life Members in E-Groups: All life members of IADVL should be included in E-Groups. Discussion: It was discussed. Members felt that although it is ideal to have all as members of e groups, at present only about 500 odd members are enrolled for e groups. More should be encouraged to join it. - **Decision:** Passed.

10. Proposal of SOPs for CCMIDDERMAMEET: From IADVL SOP Committee, Chairman, Dr. Arijit Coondoo: a total of three proposals were sent. House was informed by the secretary Dr P Narasimha Rao that all the three proposals were put up on iadvl.org for members to look and propose/suggest changes.

Decision: The house unanimously decided that the proposals shall be taken up at annual AGBM at DERMACON 2013 after the suggestions from members are received.

Extra ordinary General body meeting of IADVL: Held at 11 am on 15th July 2012 at Hyderabad.
(EGBM attended by 52 Members)

Issues taken up:

Opinions given by Constitution committee on two issues referred them: Constitution committee. Constitution committee of IADVL consisting of Dr. Suresh Joshipura (Chairperson), Dr. Ameet Valia (Convener) Dr. Byravarathinam, Dr. Arijit Condo, Dr. K.H.S Rao, Dr. Putta Srinivas & Dr. Ramesh Bhat M. (recused himself) opined in two issues referred to them as follows:

Issue 1: Whether the decision of ABGM to permit Karnataka Branch to host DERMACON 2015 at Mangalore is valid?" Opinion: The unanimous opinion of the Constitution Committee is that this decision does not conform to the provisions under the Constitution of IADVL. The situation has arisen because of the decision to merge DERMACON 2014 with the ICD. Though this issue has not been specifically referred to the Committee, the Committee is of the opinion that the constitutional validity of this decision should be determined by scrutinizing the minutes of the AGBMs in the Jaipur DERMACON."

Issue 2: Whether the decision of ABGM for commencing year 2012 to merge ICD and DERMACON 2014 is constitutionally valid? Opinion: "The unanimous opinion of the Constitution Committee is that the decision does not conform to the provisions under the Constitution of IADVL because of the following reasons: Combined CC & AGBM for commencing year 2011 held on 5th Feb, 2011 at Gurgaon had resolved against the merger. The minutes of the above meeting were confirmed by the CC & closing year AGBM held on 9th Feb, 2012 at Jaipur. As per the IADVL constitution, an international conference can be combined with DERMACON only in "exceptional circumstances" and such a situation has not been brought out before the GB to reverse the decision of the two previous Gbs".

Both issues were put to vote for member's opinion at EC meet held at Coimbatore in April 2012: **Issue one:** Merger of ICD and DERMACON 2014. **Decision:** EC passed it unanimously in favor of merger. **Issue two:** Organising of DERMACON 2015 by Karnataka branch of IADVL at Mangalore: **Decision:** Passed by majority decision of EC members. The consequences and reasons of these decisions taken by the EC against the opinion of Constitution committee were discussed. The house finally decided to hold an Extra ordinary General body meeting (EGBM) after MID DERMA CC meet for approval/ratification of its decisions. As per the above decision an EGBM was called for at Hyderabad on 15th July 2012 at 11 AM:

Decisions taken at EGBM Held at 11 am on 15th July 2012 at Hyderabad:

1. Merger of ICD and DERMACON 2014. **Decision: House approved the merging of ICD 2013 with DERMACON 2014 by majority raising hand on its favor.**



2. Allotment of DERMACON 2015 to Karnataka branch of IADVL to be hosted at Mangalore: **Decision: House approved the allocation**

of DERMACON 2015 to Mangalore, Karnataka Branch of IADVL by majority raising hands on its favor.

New Proposals received from members for inclusion in the agenda for CC and AGB meeting at DERMACON 2013

1. Proposed by Dr. C.R Srinivas:

Proposal 1: IADVL DERMAZONE: The IADVL national body and State bodies are structured but ZONES are not properly structured. However ZONAL meetings are held and is very popular. This proposal is to usher uniformity in the operation of the ZONES. Each Zone will conduct elections per the constitution of IADVL or Elect office bearers on the floor during ABGM. Members of IADVL will become members of the respective Zone. - Zones will be divided as in Annexure iv , section 1 of the Constitution.

DERMAZONE will be organized by the ZONE once in a) ONE year - , b) TWO years. (if organized in 2 years the number of meeting will be less but if it is held once an year then ZONES can host IADVL-GSK Quiz)

The Zonal office will maintain a bank account. All zones will have its own constitution as per the guidelines for the IADVL State Branch. However it should be along the lines of IADVL constitution.

Merger of CUTICON & DERMAZONE: The Host Branch will a) merge the CUTICON with DERMAZONE OR, b) There should no Merger Or , c) The option to merge or not is left to the ZONE. **Since 50 % of the savings will go the IADVL the remaining 50 % will be shared** a) equally between the zone and the state hosting the meet, b) Zone gets it all, c) 50 % for Zone and 25 % for the host state and 25 % for other states.

Business Meeting during DERMAZONE: a) Only for the ZONE, (b) For the Zone & States on request,

Central Council: a) All states will be equally represented and each state will nominate/elect 2 members for the central council during the AGBM of the State chapter., b) States to nominate depending on the strength of members ie 25 % of the of the total strength of the Central Council members. c) One member for every 50 members/25 members - PRESIDENT, SECRETARY AND 1 MEMBER FOR EVERY 50 MEMBERS

Funds: a) The centre will not provide money and zones should raise funds on their own. - YES. However on request centre can provide refundable 1 lac, b) An additional amount of rupees one thousand will be collected by the state and transfer it to the zone when new members are registered.

Annual or Bi Annual Conference will be called: a) DERMAZONE, b) DERMACON-ZONE, c) ZONECON - Yes with modification **ZONECON - EAST 2007**, d, DERMAZONE-EAST 2007, DERMAZONE-SOUTH 2007 etc

Venue Selection. 1. Zonal rotation of DERMAZONE, 2 By Election or on the floor during ABGM of DERMACON. 3. Either of the 2 options to

be decided by the ZONE.

Proposal 2: Dr J.C. Shroff Memorial Award & Prof Ratan Singh Award

Guidelines for selecting Professor K.C. Kandhari award should be applicable for nominating Dr J.C. Shroff Memorial Award & Prof Ratan Singh Award.

Proposal 3: by CR Srinivas: Building bridges-To include Indian Journal of Dermatology (IJD) as a official journal of national IADVL:

Indian Journal of Dermatology is a flourishing journal with Pan India acceptance. However the journal is edited from WB and all the Editors are from the state. Our constitution permits each state branch to have its own journal or news letter. However the Journal is popular attracts authors from all over the country and abroad as well. We have a huge membership and at present IADVL have just 2 Journals and a third established journal will be a welcome addition. It is proposed to link IJD site to IADVL site. The IJD accepts the President and Secretary of IADVL on its editorial advisory board as ex-officio members. The IJD will accept one Associate Editor (one additional post may be created) and one member of the Editorial board will be from Members of IADVL from rest of INDIA. The IJD will print IADVL related news and announcement. Articles published in IJD will be considered for National awards on par with articles published in IJDVL and IDOJ. The national Editorial committee will include the Executive Editor of IJD , IDOJ and IJDVL and meetings will be chaired by Chief Editor of IJDVL. If the IJD has instituted awards or wishes to introduce awards the GB of the WB branch is free to decide the criteria for the recipient of the award. IJD will be responsible for its financial transactions and IADVL will not be involved in such transactions.

Proposal by Dr Suresh Talwar:

DERMAZONES to have president and secretary PAN no and account. The post will rotate amongst member states .Each president to be in chair for 2 years .Work will be to supervise activities of state branches, initiate academic activities, and supervise finances. 20 %of CUTICON savings will go to DERMAZONE .Financially they help states who do not have much resource

2. Proposed by P. Narasimha Rao

Proposal 1: Audited Accounts

Suggested modification. The Hon. Treasurer will circulate an audited account of income and expenditure and liabilities of previous year in the second/ third circular newsletter.

Background: As per The Constitution in page no.25 last Para. "The



financial year of the Association shall be from 1st April of a year to the 31st March of the next year. The Honorary Treasurer will circulate an audited account of income and expenditure and liabilities of the previous year in the first circular/newsletter issued by the center”.

Reasoning: It will be very less time gap between closing of financial year and first circular/newsletter. It will take more than 60 days time for chartered accountant to give audited statements after closing of financial year.

Hence we propose such a change: it would be convenient for circulation an audited account of income and expenditure and liabilities of previous year in the second / third circular newsletter of IADVL.

Proposal 2: IADVL - TRAINING FELLOWSHIP 2013

As per **Annexure V: Rules for IADVL Training fellowships**: The fellowship will be open to any member or provisional life member of the IADVL who is not working in the same institution.

Amendment/Suggestions Members who wish to apply for **IADVL** Training fellowships has to complete his/her degree/diploma to avail IADVL Training fellowships.

4. Proposal by Dr. Basavaraj K.H : Creation of separate link for the public in our existng IADVL website

Basis of proposal: There is a intense need for public awareness programmes (on Vitiligo, Leprosy, Psoriasis, AIDS etc.,) and patient educational activities. This can be implemented through existing IADVL website with separate link for the public providing information of facts and myths about common conditions that affect our skin, hair, and nails. This unbiased content is reviewed by IADVL members for accuracy.

Hence I propose the creation of separate link for the public in our existing IADVL website with information about common dermatoses and public awareness programmes.

5. Proposal by Dr. Abhishek De: 1. To set up an IADVL Specific Interest Group or sister society on bullous diseases with a special emphasis on the genetic blistering disease. 2. To designate the SIG assignment of formulating evidence based guidelines for management of different immune-bullous diseases.

Basis of Proposal and Need felt: Genetic and Autoimmune bullous diseases encompass a wide variety of disorders where significant advancement happened over the last two decades. Because of contradictory evidences and also relative lack of data from our country especially regarding the newer therapeutics including the biological; I believe that the time has arrived for IADVL to set up a SIG to formulate an evidence based approach most suitable for our countries. Facilities to study genetic blistering diseases are non-existent in major part of the country. There is no registered data base for Epidermolysis Bullosa and its prenatal diagnosis and holistic

treatment approach. This SIG may help dermatologists from different part of the country in diagnosing and managing cases of EB. Specific EB groups are largely missing in India.

My proposal: a) To Set up a SIG for bullous disease comprising of dedicated researchers/consultants in the field. b) Give them an assignment to formulate a guideline for management of immunobullous diseases. c) To set up a national level registry for epidermolysis bullosa

6. Proposal by Dr. Atul Mohan Kochhar : Combining of Dermacon 2014 with ICD

Introduction & Background: AGBM at Jaipur agreed to a merger of Dermacon 2014 with ICD and rescheduled/ Preponed it so that both can be co-organized in the month December 2013 in New Delhi. Also, the extraordinary GBM held during the Mid-Dermacon at Hyderabad overruled the constitutionally committee and endorsed the same decision.

But the modalities of revenue sharing/ tax implications of remitting of share of profits to the ICD though promised, have not been deliberated and also the interest of IADVL members are seemingly being hugely affected. IADVL members who are keen only to attend the DERMACON have no option but to pay a huge consolidated fee (costing a minimum of US\$350).

There is also a reported (yet to be confirmed) loss of over Rs 20 Lakhs already because of some obscure legal hassles of change of venue. This is against the interest of the IADVL Members and the constitution of IADVL. Keeping this in mind, I propose that:

The Proposal: 1. The IADVL members who wish to attend only the regular DERMACON but not the ICD should be allowed to only pay only a conventional sum. 2. The financial agreement, as promised earlier, should be put on the IADVL website as early as possible. 3. The revenue sharing (of profits) between IADVL and ICD should be discussed thoroughly and clearly delineated so as not to face any embarrassment later on. 4. The Loss more than Rs 20 Lakhs to the IADVL, if any, should be explained

7. Proposals by Dr Devesh Mishra:

Proposal 1: Dr Devesh Mishra-IADVL directory: Present IADVL Directory is under preparation. A PDF copy of the directory will be attached to our IADVL website. More and more members should send photo and details to quickly complete the data. Website addition in the members details should not be a taboo in CD version in future.

Proposal 2: Adjustment in dates of ensuing election-2013: In view of combined ICD and Dermacon on 4th December, 2013 All cut-off dates for different stages of this year's election be kept the SAME except last date for receiving the ballots and the counting and formal declaration of results which needs to be be preponed a bit.



e.g. 15th June- filing nomination, 15th July- withdrawing nomination, 15th August- Confirmation of candidates, 1st October- 31st October- Sending ballots. REMAIN UNCHANGED.

NEED CHANGE-20th to 25th November-last date for receiving ballots, Next date-Counting and formal declaration of Results.

1. Dr Devesh Mishra -Dermacon Savings

We should save money wherever possible. Best opportunities are our conferences e.g. Dermacons. I saw Lucknow and Gurgaon Dermacon's submitted accounts. It showed that Lucknow collection was around 4 crore and money submitted to IADVL was around 1.2 crore. Gurgaon had collected 5.3 crore ,yet saved around 1.2 crore. Jaipur I don't as yet. My humble submission is that Dermacon savings be made 30% of collection; at present they are 20%. This is very much possible. Money is required for ever growing IADVL activities.

2. Dr Devesh Mishra-PHOTO and ID copy in Dermacon and New IADVL member forms

There should be mandatory provision of color PHOTO not only for Dermacon Registration forms but also in new member's IADVL registration forms. This is for automatic IADVL Directory entry and upgrades. There also should be requirement of an ID proof in form of Voter I Card/ Passport no./ or Driving license . PAN cards details have not clicked with members considering the no. of members participating in e-voting. This issue should be finalized. People applying without IADVL LM No. should pay 50% above the member's registration money. This is for incentivizing our members as well as for encouraging others to quickly join IADVL.

3. Dr Devesh Mishra-AGBMs to be held in daytime; be represented by members predominantly.

Presently, our national GBMs are attended by present, past and possible future office bearers mainly. A committee was formed to work and find ways to increase GB member participation. It is yet to take off. As DERMACON venue is to be decided by voting, number of members attending AGBMs is likely to fall drastically. Another way out could be to **have AGBMs in daytime**. One more way to could be to involve more ordinary members i.e. first timers to take up organizational and academic responsibilities in IADVL.

4. Dr Devesh Mishra-VISION 2025

The time has come to think big and forward. Asia and whole world is growing. It is high time that we have consolidated ideas and goals to be achieved within decided time frame. Vision 2025 is apt. IADVL has to become big, a model association and showcase its strength globally. A few ideas-

- WCD is important. Together we work and win.
- I understand that only 75-80 persons registered for e-voting. While around 2600 members voted last year. **E-voting is need of the hour**. We need to do it.

c) Emphasis should be on creating new leaders to take care of diverse increasing work of IADVL. Work and posts be assigned to younger ones, i.e. below 45 years age.

d) Uniform IADVL constitution for all state branches to be put in place by 2015.

e) Uniform MBBS curriculum for Dermatology all over India is needed. We should do it, and not just talk about it.

f) A committee be formed immediately to draft "Vision 2025".

5. Proposals by Dr. Deepak Parikh

Proposal-1: There are many stalwarts who have excelled as dermatologists and richly deserve recognition. However, currently there is one award only and hence many respected seniors may not get recognition in their lifetime. They do not ask for it, it is not about money, it is our way of showing gratitude. Why depend upon donations to acknowledge them? **I propose that IADVL** should give "Life time achievement award" to 3-4 respected seniors. It should consist of "Shawl, Shrifal (coconut) and a Scroll".

Proposal-2: IADVL needs to reach out to its members. Two of the IADVL initiatives – e-voting and directory got lacklustre response. I found many dermatologists were either not aware or had doubts which were not clarified. We need to reach out to our members effectively. I propose

a) IADVL central/state office bearers should address for 5-10 min. on 1st day, plenary session after first guest lecturer during DERMACON, DERMAZONE and CUTICON showcasing what are present and future plans and what are different activities and initiatives association has taken. This lecturer Should be prepared by President in consultation with EC members. Who will present? Central team i.e. President, Sr. and Jr. Vice-President, Hon. Gen. Secretary, Treasure or President-Elect. In the absence of them state President/Secretary should read out presentation provided by centre.

b) IADVL stall: IADVL must get prominently located stall during DERMACON. (The site of stall to be decided by central team that visits the venue). The stall should be minimum 2m by 2 m. IADVL can prominently display its activities and members can get their grievances addressed on the spot.

c) We need to upgrade our website to match international organisations especially when we are hosting and bidding for world congress. They wish to know about us and our activities, to judge if we are capable or not?

d) Not to print IADVL news but put it on website - we save print and posting.

e) We can have our member's data base on web easy to find and NO NEED to print directory one in 2-3 years.

Proposal-3: I understand that AGM passed a proposal that IADVL Academic committee chairman and convener cannot resign their



post before their tenure is over. This to me is against fundamental right of an individual and why only for one committee? I suggest

Proposal a): All committee chairman and convener cannot resign their post mid-year. If they wish, they should inform the house and resign before AGM of closing year so that AGM of next year which meets next day can appoint new office bearers. **Proposal for the AGM of 2013 i.e on Sat**

Proposal b): The next IADVL DERMACON and ICD will be held one after other we need to modify constitution to allow once change in dates of election schedule as well as dates for inviting applications for various awards during DERMACON.

6. Proposal's by Dr. Akshay Jain

I am submitting the following proposal for discussion at GB with your consent.

Proposal; 1.

A) Those who want to take part as a quiz master should apply on a written format to National General Secretary with attached copies of the certificates establishing/supporting their claims regarding conduction of quizzes or winners of the quizzes in the past. Those who are more experienced should be given edge over the others clearly on the transparency basis to arrange a great show. The selection process should be over till June/July or it can be done at midyear CC meets in presence of all the national executives to ensure proper selection and no bias.

B) One who conducts national level quiz ones, would automatically be out of the format for next 3 years. After 3 years he/she can again be chosen from level 2 as a zonal quiz master, if interested. This step is mandatory to give more chances to new comers and to increase number of more experienced people which we need to conduct a hassle free quiz, always. The number of newly selected quiz masters should exceed more than 4 per year to give perfect bench strength for future.

Proposal 2. Need for rotation policy

Me and Dr Rohit Batra, jointly want to submit a proposal: During DERMACONS, the chairpersons should be rotated every 3 yearly basis. One who chairs the particular topic in one DERMACON should not be allowed to chair the same session till next 3 years. It will infuse new knowledge for the listeners as there would be different chairpersons speaking on the same topic. Same should apply to the speakers also. One speaker speaking on a topic should not be allowed to speak on the same topic for next 3 years.

7. Proposal from Dr. Ramesh Bhat M

The number of papers submitted to DERMACON Award Paper session is very high. We also have so many awards. However constitution permits only 12 papers. I hereby request to have atleast

36 papers for the award paper session. The rules for award papers is also arbitrary and it has to be for members below 35 years and for PG Residents (irrespective of age, In case of service candidates)

The scholarship given by IADVL to attend AAD/ WCD or ICD should be restricted to one time only for members. A member who has received one scholarship should not be considered for future scholarships.

8. Proposal from Jayadev Betkerur

Division of Surplus money of International conferences conducted by IADVL

India is hosting and likely to host many international Dermatology conferences. They will be conducted by IADVL with active participation from local state branch. It may be that in future many states may bid to conduct these conferences and elections may be necessary as in case of SARAD 2015. As of now there are no guidelines for division of surplus of these conferences. The entire amount has to go to IADVL national.

As the event will be conducted mainly by the local organizing committee, my **proposal** is that the surplus of any international conference conducted by IADVL **be divided as done for DERMACON** surplus. This will help in compensating for the amount spent by the local branch for 1. Campaigning. 2. Publicity. 3. Sponsoring visits of various committees etc.

9. Proposal by Dr. Suresh Talwar:

1. IADVL finances -IADVL is financially not very sound. It is holding ILDVL money giving it appearance of a rich body. It immediately requires some measures to curtail expenditure as we cannot depend on DERMACON savings. I propose following measures:

a) For CC meet the air/rail travel expenses be paid by respective state branches for their members attending CC meet. IADVL will only take care of accommodation (1 day only). State branches have enough funds now a days.

b) 20 % of all collections from DERMACON, DERMAZONE and CUTICON to be given to National body.

c) Share from IADVL to IJDVL be stopped immediately as IJDVL is financially very sound. It gets revenue from ads, 20% share from DERMACON savings and 50 % share from membership fees. Instead both these should be credited to IADVL funds. However this decision may be reviewed every 2 years.

Proposal 2:

Strict supervision of DERMACON balance sheet is necessary. I suggest the following Performa to be filled by organizers of the DERMACON

Proposal 3: Regards to IADVL academy of Dermatology the propose the following:

a) New SIG: like Laser and Aesthetic SIG to be created and non functional to be abolished.

b) Selection of committee members: Academy chairman, convener and members to be appointed by selection process after seeking volunteers, if possible. Regional balance to be maintained. The same process may be considered for appointment of members for various committees.



10. Proposal by Dr. Shyamanta Barua , Dr. Arijit Coondoo, Dr. Arun Inamadar Modifications for Dr. L. N. Sinha Memorial Award

This award is presently given to a member of IADVL aged below 45 years on a zonal basis for overall contribution to the specialty. It is categorically mentioned in the constitution that this award is not determined exclusively for scientific achievement. Therefore, as a corollary, it follows that weightage should also be given to one's contribution to the association and commitment to the specialty. It has been seen for the last couple of years that there has been a major dilemma in selection of awardees. This is due to the fact that there is a big queue of eligible candidates for the award within a zone as the next opportunity for application comes after 4 long years as also owing to the absence of evaluation criteria. In this backdrop, we propose that (i) this award be given to an IADVL member aged less than 45 years from each zone every year and (ii) that definite criteria with weight age for both academic and organizational contribution be laid down to aid in the evaluation of applications for this award.

11. Proposal by Dr. DBN Murthy & DrSuresh Talwar :Proposal to restructure IADVL finances to make them healthy:

Back ground: IADVL at present is financially not very sound. The IJDVL money which it is holding is giving it a false appearance of a rich body.

IADVL as on date has a total fixed deposits of Rs 4.4 crores out of which about 3.5 crores belongs to IJDVL, thus leaving about 90 lakhs with it. Out of this there are few liabilities yet to be met to a tune of 20 lakhs from the DERMACON surplus funds received from Jaipur DERMACON. Please note that the annual budgetary requirements of IADVL is about 1.2 crores. As this being the case, urgent measures to strengthen IADVL financially need to be undertaken.

1. There is a need to look newer avenues to increase the income. IADVL has no income sources except the membership fee (of which it only gets 25% of the total fees) and DERMACON excess, if any (of which it gets only 20% of it). Other incomes coming in as sponsorships (GSK funds for quiz or loreal grants) have to be spent in toto to the respective related activities only every year. We propose the following changes to increase the IADVL income.

a) Sharing of revenues between IADVL and IJDVL is to be stopped immediately as IJDVL is financially very sound and self-sufficient. (IJDVL at present had funds of approximately 5 crores, [3.5 crores with IADVL and 1.3 crores with IJDVL itself]). IJDVL is at present

getting 15 % share from DERMACON savings and 50 % share from membership fees. Instead we propose that both these should be credited to IADVL funds from this year till IADVL becomes financially healthy. This decision may be reviewed every 2 years or as found necessary. Finances earmarked for other purposes from DERMACON excess may also be reviewed.

b) A minimum of 50% of MIDERMACON, DERMAZONE and 20% of CUTICON financial excess should be transferred to National IADVL.

c) As per the recent changes in the tax laws, IADVL has to pay service tax of 12.5% on all its earnings which include membership fees, sponsorship fee and other incomes. The same may be collected from the members and sponsors by increasing the fee/sponsorship appropriately.

2. We also propose following measures to curtail expenditure.

d) As most state branches of IADVL have enough funds at present. I propose following measures: The air / rail travel expenses of its CC and EC members be paid by respective state branches for attending Mid year CC meet. IADVL will only take care of accommodation, that too for one day only.

e) IADVL news bulletin is printed thrice a year by IADVL. This bulletin may be given to a sponsor. Or alternatively IADVL can have advertisements in the IADVL news bulletin.

f) The newly launched IADVL venture <http://dermindianatlas.org> where in images of Dermatology are being posted can also be given to a sponsor for management to improve finances.

We request the finance committee to look at these proposals and do the needful so that same may be put up in CC meet of DERMACON 2013 to be held at Ahmedabad, in January 2013.

12. Proposal by Dr. Biju Vasudevan, Editor: Dermatology Online Atlas : Obtaining permission from journal editors for photographs for Derma India Atlas

“DerminDainAtlas” is an ambitious project of the IADVL aiming to put together photographs of skin disorders in Indian patients at the online site of the atlas, the first of its kind in this country. The database of the journal will be made up by photographs. In order to give an initial fillip and strength to this database, it is proposed to take permission from Editors & Publishers of IJDVL, IJD & IDOJ so that photographs from these journals can be obtained for uploading into the atlas.

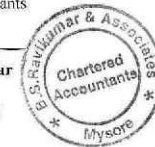

IADVL invites bids for hosting MID-DERMACON 2013

Bids are invited to host MID-DERMACON in 2013 from Smaller cities of IADVL state Branches

Bids are invited for **MIDDERMACON 2013** to be organized along with **Central Council (CC) IADVL meet. Preference in the Bids would be given to smaller cities of India to host MIDDERMACON 2013.** However if no suitable bid is received it can be allotted to any city.

When to Hold: Ideally in August 2013.

How to bid for MIDDERMACON: Application of Bids to hold MIDDERMACON 2013 should reach IADVL secretary by 31st December, 2012. The bid should mention the venue, names of organizing secretary and scientific chairman. Each bid should be endorsed by the president and Secretary of the IADVL state branch. Preference will be given to any zone other than west zone this time as DERMACON 2013 is already being held at Ahmadabad, which is at West Zone. Those cities where Zonal IADVL conferences (DERMAZONES) are being planned can also bid for this MIDDERMACON and in such a case both need to be merged. In case no bid is received till end of December 2012, the venue would be decided in the AGB meeting at Ahmadabad in Jan 2013.

Guidelines of conduct of MIDDERMACON: Duration: Two days, on a Saturday and Sunday. Saturday first day CME - topics of Clinical Dermatology/ involve SIG group/parallel workshop can be organised. Sunday-Second day of conference. For scientific programme, local scientific team will be the main planner. IADVL

Academy of Dermatology and Special Interest Groups (SIG) would coordinate and help the local scientific team in its implementation.

Business meetings of various committees would run parallel to the conference on first day. **Central council (CC)** meet will be organised on second day. IADVL will pay the bill for travel and maximum one day accommodation of about 80-100 Central council members attending the CC meeting during MIDDERMACON. The arrangements will have to be made by local org committee; the bill will be paid out of the savings of MIDDERMACON. However if there is any short fall, it will be paid by IADVL. The secretary IADVL will actively coordinate in hosting the CC meet with the local organizers.

Accounts/Finance: It should be managed just like DERMACON. Sharing of money should be as per norms of DERMACON. However a guarantee of minimum 20 % savings of total fund collection has to be undertaken by the organizers, (subject to its approval from AGBM at DERMACON 2013). **Seed Money:** IADVL proposes to give seed money to the organizers of MIDDERMACON which has to be returned by the organizers within 30 days of completion of the conference.

Winner of the bid would be announced/ decided during the opening year AGBM at DERMACON 2013. Other details would be informed to the successful bidder after DERMACON 2013.

The IADVL-L'Oreal Indian Hair and Skin Research Grants - 2013

The 'IADVL-L'Oreal Indian Hair and Skin Research Grant' 2013 jury meeting was held on 2nd November 2012 at Hotel Ashoka, New Delhi. It was presided over by Dr C R Srinivas, President, IADVL and attended by Dr Stephane Commo, Dr Arun Inamadar, Dr J-P Ortonne, Dr D M Thappa and Dr Michele Verchoore who were the jury. Dr Suresh Talwar was the observer and Dr P Narasimha Rao and Dr Ameet Valia were the facilitators. The applications were blinded and objectively judged on the basis of originality, technical innovation, feasibility, and relevance. Of the 43 applications received from the members of IADVL, 14 research projects were provisionally selected and financial grant amounting to ₹ 23.18 lakhs were recommended, subject to their Ethics Committee approval. The projects need to be completed before December, 2013.

Activities of the Special Interest Groups (SIGs): Following is the list of 20 SIGs with their respective Coordinators and a brief overview of their activities this year.

Atopic Dermatitis: (Coordinator: Dr. Sandipan Dhar): A focus conference on Atopic Dermatitis - ATOPICON - was held on March 3-4, 2012 at Mumbai. Therapeutic guidelines on Atopic Dermatitis have been drafted.

Cutaneous Adverse Drug Reaction: (Coordinator: Dr. Uday Khopkar): Initiated reporting of CADR on IADVL website through Google forms which allows automatic compilation of reports.

Dermatology Nursing: (Coordinator: Dr. Vineet Kaur): An interactive workshop on Basic Skincare for nurses and allied healthcare professionals was held at Nepal Medical College, Kathmandu as part of the scientific program of SODVELONCON held on March 30 - April 1, 2012. A CME program on dermatology nursing was organized by Government College of Nursing, MB Government Hospital, Udaipur in collaboration with Dept. of Dermatology, RNT Medical College, Udaipur on June 2, 2012.

Dermatopathology: (Coordinator: Dr. M. Ramam): A microscopy session was conducted at SMS Medical College, Jaipur on February 10, 2012. A hands-on Dermatopathology workshop was held in collaboration with Dermatopathology Society of India (DSI) and IAPM, Delhi Chapter on March 31, 2012 in New Delhi. An educational feature - Photomicrograph of the month - was launched on IADVL Academic Yahoo Group. An International CME on Dermatopathology was held in collaboration with Father Muller Medical College and DSI at Mangalore on August 31-September 2, 2012.

Dermatosurgery: (Coordinator: Dr. Raghunatha Reddy): It was involved in the pre-conference live workshop of DERMACON 2012 held at Jaipur on February 8, 2012. It conducted the CME and workshop during CC MIDDERMACON held at Hyderabad on July 14-15, 2012.

Leg Ulcers: (Coordinator: Dr. Reena Rai): It was the first SIG to submit the Therapeutic Guidelines for Venous leg ulcer. It conducted a panel discussion on leg ulcer at DERMAZONE South 2012 held at Wayanad on September 21-23, 2012.

Leprosy: (Coordinator: Dr. H. K. Kar): Dr Sujai Suneetha, member of SIG organized a CME-cum-workshop on "Use of high resolution ultrasonography in leprosy as a diagnostic tool" on November 11-12, 2012 at Hyderabad. It was attended by more than 50 delegates. Dr Leo Vissar, Neurologist and experienced nerve sinologist conducted the workshop along with Dr Suman Jain.

Occupational & Environmental Dermatology: (Coordinator: Dr. Chembolli Lakshmi): The multicentric study on parthenium prevalence has been completed in October 2012 and data collection and assimilation is in process. It is also drafting therapeutic guidelines for parthenium dermatitis.

Pemphigus: (Coordinator: Dr. Jyoti Nath): It has submitted the first draft of the therapeutic guidelines on Pemphigus.

Pigmentary Dermatoses: (Coordinator: Dr. Davinder Parsad): The therapeutic guidelines on vitiligo have been submitted. Work has started on a book on melasma.

Psoriasis: (Coordinator: Dr. Sanjay Ghosh) A full day workshop on Psoriasis with lectures, panel discussion & live demonstration of psoriasis scores, different phototherapy methods & protocols was held at Kolkata on July 22, 2012. A Psoriasis Newsletter was released on the same day. Therapeutic guidelines on Psoriasis have been submitted.

Psychodermatology: (Coordinator: Dr. Shrutakirithi Sheno) Organized a training programme on non-pharmacological interventions in dermatology on November 17-18, 2012 at Manipal.

STI & HIV: (Coordinator: Dr. Y. S. Marfatia): It is presently designing patient information leaflets on HSV 1 & 2.

Teledermatology: (Coordinator: Dr. Jayakar Thomas): It organized a Video Conference CME on Dermatopathology on January 8, 2012; an International Dermatology Update on February 4, 2012; and a Hair Disorders CME on May 27, 2012. A Sister Society meeting was held at DERMACON 2012 in February, 2012 at Jaipur.

Urticaria: Dr. Kiran Godse A workshop on Urticaria & Angioedema, featuring international faculty such as Dr. Zuberbier, Dr. Maurer and Dr. Carlsten, was held in collaboration with Global Alliance Asthma Allergy Network (GAL2EN) at Goa on March 16-18, 2012. Therapeutic guidelines on Urticaria are under preparation.

SIG Trichology: (Chair Person Dr. S. Murugusundram). SIG Curriculum Development & Training: (Chair Person Dr. Jayadev Betkerur), SIG Paediatric Dermatology: (Chair Person Dr. S. Criton) and SIG Genodermatoses: (Chair Person Dr. Ravi Hiremagalore) have not reported any activity till the time this report was prepared.

Other activities of IAD:

1. Evaluation of the Orations and Award Papers for DERMACON 2013: The Academy undertook the evaluation of the six applications for the Orations for DERMACON 2013 by sending them for review to all members of the Academy and the Central Scientific Committee. The results of the evaluation were tabled during the Central Scientific Committee meeting held at Ahmedabad on October 7, 2012. It also evaluated the abstracts for the Award Papers for DERMACON 2013 and prepared a ranking list of the same.

2. SIG Evaluation: The task of evaluation of the SIGs was undertaken for the first time ever by the IADVL Academy and performance report was tabled at the IADVL CC meet at Hyderabad. SIG Urticaria and SIG Dermatopathology performed best and were closely followed by SIGs on Dermatology Nursing, Pigmentary Dermatoses and Dermatosurgery. SIGs on Paediatric Dermatology, Genodermatosis and Trichology performed poorly. Based on this evaluation, the EC and CC have recommended remedial measures for the non-functioning SIGs. 'SIG Dermatology clinical trials' was discontinued this year.

3. IADVL SIG Research Grant (ISRG): It was instituted to fund multicentric research projects in the thrust areas of each SIG. A sum of Rs 10 lacs have been allocated for ISRG 2012. As many as nine SIGs had submitted proposals for this grant. The SIGs whose projects have been selected for this inaugural ISRG are (i) Leprosy - Efficacy of newer drug regimens in leprosy: an open comparative multicentric study; (ii) Psoriasis - Prevalence and clinical patterns of psoriatic arthritis in India: a multicentric study and (iii) Leg Ulcer - Detection of contact allergens in patients with chronic leg ulcer. Ethical committee clearance has been made mandatory for award of this grant. The approved grant for each project will be released in installments subject to approval of interim project reports and utilization certificates.

4. SIG Sessions in DERMACON 2013: The Academy was asked to suggest four SIGs for Ahmedabad after exclusion of those specialties that were otherwise represented in the scientific programme through focus sessions and sister society meets. The SIGs selected for DERMACON 2013 are: Curriculum & Training Development, Pemphigus, Leg Ulcers and Dermatology Nursing.

5. IADVL Training Fellowship issues: The IADVL Academy is presently screening applications for the 2013 training fellowships. The Academy Chairperson & Convener have constituted a panel of Academy Members for this purpose. The Academy has also undertaken evaluation of existing Fellowship centres and is drafting criteria for approving new Fellowship centres.

6. IADVL Academy on the web: The Academy Convener is liaising with the Hon. General Secretary, IADVL towards creation of a dedicated web page of the IADVL Academy in the association website with space/links for SIGs.
