Hon. Treasurer's Note

Greetings from IADVL Headquarters!

The current Executive Committee of IADVL has introduced certain changes in the association's banking operative procedures since it has taken charge of IADVL's treasury in April, 2016. As we now have our headquarters in Delhi, the bank account in Ansari Nagar, New Delhi branch of SBI opened and operated by the Immediate Past Secretary and Treasurer has been maintained. Barring a few transactions during the first fortnight of April this year, this bank account has been used to receive all incoming funds only and no expenditure except transfer of funds to other two newly opened accounts of the association. These two accounts - one "IADVL Academy" a/c in Guntur (with Bank of India) for all expenditures of Academy and the other at Guwahati (with SBI) for all other expenditures of IADVL - are being operated jointly by Academy Convener and Treasurer, IADVL & Sec. Gen. and Treasurer, IADVL respectively. The main account in New Delhi shall remain in the same place while the other two will go to places with change of Convener, Academy and Treasurer, IADVL. This mechanism has effectively segregated the income and expenditure and the effort involved in preparing the Income-Expenditure a/c presented herein was thus reduced significantly.

Starting this year, all the expenses of Academy shall be routed through the Academy bank a/c to which the amount sanctioned to Academy for the financial year shall be transferred from the main bank account in New Delhi. This new mechanism will go a long way in quick disbursal of grants and awards etc. and will bring in significant financial autonomy to Academy, IADVL.

After procuring Service Tax registration, IADVL has paid its first Service Tax this June for the financial year 2015-16. Service tax liability is huge on IADVL and for this year the liability was actually not budgeted. Our auditor has suggested certain changes in the management of IADVL's finances which shall be taken up for discussion in this Central Council meeting. I hope these be implemented after proper discussion and amendments wherever deemed necessary by learned members and once that is done, I am sure all tax liabilities on the association will come down and we shall have more savings from our conferences and other activities in future.

In these 4 months, we have managed to get the pending L'Oreal grant money credited to our account, thanks to the efforts of Dr. Ameet Valia. The royalty on IADVL Textbook was a pleasant surprise and we remain thankful to the team led by Dr. Sachidanand for this. DERMACON 2016 and DERMACON 2017 teams deserve huge applause for their contributions to IADVL kitty.

I shall conclude this report with the Income Expenditure accounts for the first four months of the current financial year, more precisely from 1st April, 2016 to 8th August, 2016.

Long live IADVL.

Minutes of IADVL EC Meeting 2016

Date: 30 April & 1 May, 2016 **Venue:** IADVL Headquarters, Darya Ganj, New Delhi

The historic first ever EC meeting at the IADVL Headquarters (HQ) in New Delhi started just after noon on Saturday, 30 April with the IADVL President welcoming all EC members and invitees. The following EC 2016 members and invitees attended the meeting - Dr. Devesh Mishra, Dr. Venkataram Mysore, Dr. Yogesh Marfatia, Dr. Shyamanta Barua, Dr. Rajib Gogoi, Dr. Anil Ganjoo, Dr. B. B. Mahajan, Dr. Prabhat Kumar, Dr. Biju Vasudevan, Dr. Ameet Valia, Dr. K. A. Seetaram, Dr. Suresh Joshipura, Dr. Dinesh Mathur, Dr. Rashmi Sarkar, Dr. V. K Sharma, Dr. Rishi Parashar, Dr. M. L. Gambhir, Dr. V. K. Jain, Dr. Rajeev Sharma, Dr. Binod Khaitan, Dr. Manas Puhan, Dr. Manish Gautam, Dr. Sudip Das, Dr. Rohit Batra, Dr. Siddharth Sonthalia and Dr. M. Ramam.

Dr. Devesh Mishra thanked the Hon. Secretary General, Dr. Shyamanta Barua and Vice President, Dr Anil Ganjoo for the huge effort put in inaugurating the IADVL HQ in April. All Committees appointed through mutual discussion amongst the Presidential triumvirate were approved by the members present in the EC meeting. In view of ITATSA Chairperson Dr. Kiran Nabar resigning from his post, Dr. Rajeev Sharma was nominated as the new Chairman with his prior acceptance.

IADVL HQ Staffing

Proposal by Dr Shyamanta Barua & Dr. Rajib Gogoi: IADVL HQ will function as National Secretariat from now on.One caretaker - Mr. Balam Singh Bisht - is working at INR 10,000 per month. His services may be continued. The two secretarial assistantsalready doing the work from previous tenure should continue –Ms.Hina (INR 18,000/month) and Ms.Vandana (INR 15,000/month). Dr.Rashmi stated that these two lady staff had gained good experience during her tenure. Six months period can be earmarked to assess their work. Working hours will be 8 hrs (9am-5pm) five days a week.

It was decided that some petty cash (around INR 5000) was to be given to Dr.RashmiSarkar for handling day to day affairs of the HQ- sweepers, cleaning etc. This can be handed over to staff for one month by Dr.Rashmiand later as decided

by Dr. Shyamanta. Expenditure report has to be submitted monthly. The Hon. Secretary General has an assistant at his place employed at a monthly salary of INR 10,000. INR 5000 was also proposed for a person to assist the Hon. Treasurer with updating of accounts.

Physical membership forms would be received in HQ, digitalised and then sent to Hon. Secretary General for verification and approval. Thereafter, mails will go out to the applicants with their membership details and certificates. PLM to LM conversions can happen entirely over mail. If online module becomes functional, Dr. Shyamanta declared that it might then be possible to issue membership certificateswithin a week of receipt of valid applications.

Election circulars, business meeting points circulation are regular jobs which should be done at IADVL HQ with the help of these staff. Registrations, scholarships, events calendar can all be done with their help. Response to membership query can also be handled. Alerts to all members for events can be done from here. Ballot papers coming back can also be traced to the receivers and addresses corrected. Archiving can also be done.

The secretarial assistants working in the HQ have to be salaried staff. Therefore, contract has to be signed with the employees. TDS returns require digital signatures and it has to be in place. Monthly checks by auditors would make it easy.

Decision: The proposals were agreed to by the house.

Working of HQ: Dr. VK Sharma brought in the point of paperless working in the HQ. Dr. Shyamanta said that his primary focus is to streamline membership issues and hoped that the State Secretaries would cooperate towards this end.

Service tax: Since IADVL and DERMACON organisers have different accounts, so any transaction from that account to IADVL will involve service tax. It might be better if IADVL can handle DERMACONs with its own account. Auditors must also be the same. If it is given as educational grant, then can service tax be saved? So can it be given under different heads



and tax can be saved? The amount going back to the state should be directly from DERMACON. The states will have to pay service tax.

Membership module:Membership fees: INR 8400;INR 1800 each for State and Journal and rest to IADVL. It was resolved that the chargestowardselectronic payment of membership dues will be borne by member.

Website: Membership module to be incorporated. Change of address can be done here and will reflect in all places. E-voting can also be incorporated. Dr AmeetValia said that the applications for grant/ awards can also be incorporated in the website. The IADVL app being done is still incomplete and Dr.Venkataram Mysore was requested to look into it. Dr.Reddys are probably ready to sponsor it.

IADVL Newsletter:The IADVL NEWS Vol 12 Issue 1 was released. It has also been uploaded on the website.

Accounts: Separate bank account for Academy with same PAN. An amount of INR 60 lakh earmarked for the Academy will be transferred to the account. Grant amount will be separate. The house sanctioned payment of INR 3,81,000towards renovation work (internet connectivity, CCTV cameras, biometric system, telephone connectionsetc) done at the IADVL HQ, mainly through the supervision of Dr Anil Ganjoo. Approved budget will be followed. Payment of INR 2,00,000 to IDOJ was agreed to and passed. The President proposed that Hon. Treasurer should give a six monthly report to make accounts transparent.

Mayadevi fellowship: The Academy will invite applications from centres other than PGI.It will be only dermatosurgery fellowship. The phototherapy part will be deleted. Dr.SubrataMalakar of Rita Skin Foundation has agreed in principle to take students for this fellowship on the same name. Dr.Bhushan Kumar has agreed to it.

Lawyer must be retained for a case to case consultation. A legal advisor appointment from Delhi was considered as a permanent option.

EADV session in Vienna was confirmed. 20 speakers will be allowed.

Bar code issue for voting to be sorted out by Constitution Committee. The Election Officer, Dr.C. R. Srinivas, conveyed that he does not want barcoding of ballots. Constitution Committee told that barcode is better and stated that bar code means a particular number that identifies ballot paper. The number will be known only to the Election Officer. The house resolved to continue with the same dates as previous year for this year's election.

Decision: Barcode is actually used instead of signature of Election Officer and that is agreeable.

IMPACT CMEs:Dr AmeetValia stated that Novartis have approached with a sponsorship for 16 Psoriasis workshops. 6 Sigma would mediate the administrative arrangementstowards organising the CMEs.Dr. Valia said that Novartis wants an agreement and they have agreed to the entire sponsorship of these workshops. Novartis wants one test and 4 pilots with royalty of 1 Lakh per CME between June 2016 to June 2017. It was decided that the scientific content will be entirely decided by the SIG Psoriasis and Academy and there will be no interference byNovartis.

IADVL-GSK Quiz:Members expressed reservation on the draft MOU, especially with regard to the cancellation clauses. If cancelled, GSK wanted full refund. It was decided that a revised MOU will be redrafted and sent to GSK in a weekafter consensus on these points and mode and date of payment. The schedule of cheque payments will also be mentioned. So refund clause has to be removed. Cancellation must be by mutual agreement and arbitration to be settled in Delhi. Other clauses to be modified accordingly. It may be presented as an educational grant to avoid taxes, otherwise they have to bear it. Revised MOU will be sent to GSK for their redressal and reply as fast as possible. The IADVL Quiz Committee Chairperson and Convener will co-ordinate the administrative arrangements. The agreement will be written from IADVL side by a hired lawyer/ retainer.

IADVL Academy: 2014 grants - L'Oreal INR 5,83,000; Galderma15 lakhs annually. 2015 grants not yet received from Galdermato be borne by IADVL. Sun Pharma MOU not traceable. Sun Pharmaexecutive has said it is 14 lakh for 2 years. According to us it is Rs 14 lakh/year. IADVL funds have been utilised. Companies are yet to pay up. All MOUs to be handed over by previous Secretary to Dr. Shyamanta. Glenmark is willing to give 7 Lakhs for the projects on fungi and vitiligo. This can be utilised for the projects. Sun Pharma will be willing to give 13 lakhs for grants if they are given Dermagyan sponsorship too. Torrent ready to continue for sponsorship for workshops; 3 lakhs can be proposed as sponsorship for each workshop. 5 LASER workshops are being conducted. If states are ready, then the money earned from Laser workshops could be used to coconduct other SIG workshops like leprosy, dermatopathology for free along with these workshops.

Decision:Galderma should be served notice to pay up remaining money as early as possible. Other proposals of companies were agreed to.



Termination of Wiley contract for IADVL concise textbook-Editors given permission to write the same to Wiley once the contract is read by EC.

The President put a proposal for 2 biographies of eminent personalities with a budget of Rs 1 Lakh for the same. Dr Shyamanta opined that the history book should instead be updated with achievements of personalities given space. The history book has not been updated for 10 years. Dr Rishi Parashar expressed views that eminent personalities can be honoured instead. How personalities will be selected was debated.

Decision: The house decided that IADVL Dermatology times can carry columns dedicated to eminent personalities and the history book should be updated. Can be made into a e-book too. Dr. D. M.Thappa and Dr.UdayKhopkar can be requested to lead the history update project.

Evoting portal: It was decided that the previous portal was now working well and will be continued. State Secretaries to be involved in getting more e-votes. It was suggested that a e-voting Coordinator be made for each state who is made responsible. No of e-voters registered should be a point for best branch. It was opined that % of evoters registered must instead be considered. Each CUTICON should have a booth for e-registration. The information on number of PLMs who convert to LM and have e-registered should be informed by State Secretaries to the Hon. Secretary General.

Community Dermatology: IADVL Day observations to continue. Dr. M. L.Gambhir raised a point that it should be extended to slums too. It was decided that States should do the necessary spending for these observation of days and centre assistance to be taken only if required. Dr.Ameet said that help of respective SIGs can be taken. Media cell should publicise. Dr Umashankarwill be Coordinator for Vitiligo Day at national level. SIGs can be involved in making content. Schools should also be part of this.A provision of 2 lakhs can be made in dire consequences. Whether 8 May can be considered as IADVL Foundation day was also brought up by Dr.Marfatia.

ITATSA: Dr Rajeev Sharma gave a detailed outline for ITATSA. The main objectives aimed at were amending schedule H and banning irrational FDCs. Educating GPs, masses about the same. List of drugs has been prepared. An idea of sending 5 bulk messages to all members regarding steroid abuse was also brought up. State level coordinators are to be appointed. Dr Shyamanta said at present only 8 States had sent in their details. If no co-ordinator is appointed it was decided that the President/ Secretary of that state would have to take the responsibility. A Whatsapp group

comprising all Presidents and Secretaries of States with the EC, Chairperson & Convener of Committees and State coordinators was planned to be introduced for better coordination. In every CUTICON 10 minutes slot for ITATSA was proposed. News letter should carry details and media cell should be involved. Press conferences will have to be done. Posters in clinics have to be displayed. A website with a page link to IADVL should be developed.

Dr. Shyamanta informed that ITATSA has been placed as a tab in the homepage of the revamped association website.2 lakhs budget was released by the President to ITATSA for its activities with a proposal of increase to 5 lakhs if approved by GB. It was also decided that e-posters for ITATSA could be sent to state coordinators who could then take printouts and distribute. 4 page poster through IJDVL is also an option.

Constitution Committee: Dr. VK Sharma raised a point that all proposals should go through Constitution Committee and Dr. Venkataram Mysore and previous EC members clarified that all points related to constitution definitely are going through committee. Dr Shyamanta brought out a point that there are two versions of SOP available and the latest one has to be updated to prevent confusion. All new branches should send their constitution to the ConstitutionCommittee before sending to GB for passing. TS for Telangana and GO for Goa were abbreviations agreed to. The President also asked the ConstitutionCommittee to resolve the issue of what criteria is to be followed to see that which member should actually belong to which state branch. Also e-version of the SOPsshould be updated every 6 months atleast.

MID DERMACON 2016:It will be held at Mayfair Convention Centre, Bhubaneswar on 13-14 August, 2016. It was decided that the SIG should conduct the sessions allotted to them but faculty for that session should not comprise members from only the SIG. Academy should be involved in the discussions.

It was decided that 2 nights stay is required for the EC members. When the budget for the MID DERMACON was presented it was pointed out by many members that the cost was too high for rooms, food, liquor and hall booking. It was decided that a revised budget was to be put up by 2 weeks and another team would inspect the venue before June. The Organising Chairperson/Secretaryare responsible to report the progress of the conference to the State President & Secretary.

ADC 2016: To be held at Mumbai on 13-16Oct, 2016. Dr. Manish briefed the house about the progress of the Congress. The Bank statement has not been received by Hon.





Treasurer. It was decided that all the EC members have to be provided free registration and accommodation for the conference.

DERMACON 2017:The Organising Secretary, Dr. Sudip Das, presented the details. He said that seed money has been returned to IADVL West Bengal with bank statement. Bar coding has been done for all aspects. Certificates except delegate certificate will be available from website. SARAD secretaries will be invited as earlier suggested. A proposal for holding CME in 2 halls was put up. Members said that since AGBM was already going on parallel to CME, this can be agreed to. It was decided that a proposal to revise DERMACON Model will be put up by Dr.Venkataram Mysore (including parallel CME in 2 halls) in the CC meet and then decision will be taken. Dermatalent exhibition halls provision was discussed and agreed to. A primetime session each for ACAD and Resident forums was also agreed to.

People Connect Cell:News releases, updation of website and report after a major event were discussed. It was decided that the observation of days like Vitiligo day should be observed in hospitals on the exact date, but for the general public the previous day/ next day/ next holiday as convenient may be utilised to convey awareness. It was decided that the SOPs of media cell are to be followed as to who should conduct press conferences. 5 lakhs budget was approved. And a detailed proposal for budget is to be put up at the CC meet.

Practice Management Cell: Proposal to hold 3 PMC CMEs (Aurangabad- 10th July; Jaipur-11th Sep; Hyderabad - Oct/Nov) agreed to. 2 newsletters (e-version to avoid costs) to be brought out. Clinic software has been passed by GB. Only if pharma support is obtained, it can be undertaken.

IJDVL: The Editor, Dr.M. Ramam said that pharma support to journal was on the decline. 10 lakhs excess expenditure has been done. However no money has been asked for from IADVL since last 3 years. It was decided that the Rs 1800 per new member portion which is due should go to IJDVL on demand note and any further requirement will be put up for sanction.

IDOJ: 2 Lakhs sanctioned for office. As IDOJ does not have a separate bank account, actual bill reimbursements would be made.

GovernmentLiaisonCell:The Convener, Dr.BinodKhaitan, presented details. Dr.Venkataram Mysore said that DNB Fellowships would begin. Drug Controller meet is scheduled for 13 May. A comprehensive list of FDCs to be banned is being made. The footnote change in Schedule H is a significant achievement.

Editor Elect, IADVLTextbookis yet to be decided

Dr.YogeshMarfatia proposed that PLM-LM conversion should be undertaken at quick pace and State Secretaries should be made responsible. Members database, list updation and e directory is a challenge which will be taken up.E voting must be made compulsory for new members. A trial should be done for 3 years to get maximum e-voters. DVL trust needs activation and all members must be able to easily access it. Website updation, SIG PG teachers, thesis report presentation were also brought up.

International Liaison Committee: Proposal for Fellowships to International candidates was discussed. Topics proposed were vitiligo surgery and tropical dermatology. 2 fellowships to SARAD members- 2000 US\$, 2 fellowships for others- 1000\$ will improve image. An idea of reciprocal support was also raised. Point was also brought out that stalls in various conferences can be put to welcome members and international ambassadors can be appointed.

A proposal was put up that the proposals to be discussed in AGBM should be put up early in the course of events. Opinionscan be given online and only final decisions can be taken in GB. This would ease matters and reduce time wastage. Accounts can also be put up online.

IADVL branding was also discussed. A letter by ITATSA to international societies would help.

Dermatology times: E copy sanctioned. Print copies only if sponsored. 2 Joint secretaries would be on Editorial Board along with President and Hon. Secretary General.

An amount of INR 6000 per issue on bill reimbursement mode was sanctioned for the e-news bulletin of the Residents –Residream.

The meeting concluded with the vote of thanks by the Hon. Secretary General and closing remarks of the IADVL President.
