Virtually all research and data collection/epidemiology systems rely on the ICD coding in classifying the diseases that are studied.

Professor Eun, Chairman of World Congress of Dermatology 2011 will publish a book on dermatology. This book will be released at the time of the World Congress of Dermatology 2011 meeting. He has requested that I take the post of associate editor for this book. - (1) The textbook advisory committee has been approved and its members have been named by the central council.
- The advisory committees will oversee the arrangements to bring out a new edition of the (2)text-book periodically at an appropriate time.
- (3)The advisory committee will ask the editor/s at that time to convene a meeting of the editorial board, constituted by the editors in consultation with the advisory committee to assign the chapters on the different subjects to the authors who will be decided by the board.
- The editor/s should obtain a written or E-mail consent by the author to update the chapter or (4) write a new chapter and submit it within a stipulated time-frame. If the author does not submit the chapter in the stipulated time, the editor/ and the advisory committee will cancel the assignment. The editor/s with the help of editorial board assign that chapter to another author following the due procedure.
- (5) If any chapter is not found of the standard required for the text-book, the editor/s will inform the advisory committee. The advisory committee may authorize the editor/s to return the chapter and may assign the chapter to another author following the due procedure.
- Any difference of opinion expressed in the editorial board meeting may be resolved by the (6)advisory committee, whose opinion should be binding.
- Any legal matter pertaining to the text-book may be discussed by the editor/s with the (7) advisory committee and appropriate action should be decided, if necessary in consultation with the president of I.A.D.V.L. and its executive.
- Any dispute/difference with publisher may reported by the editor/s to the advisory (8)committee. The advisory committee will help to resolve dispute/difference by interacting with the publishers.
- (9)The price of the text-book should be decided by publisher in consultation with the editor/s. It should be approved by the advisory committee. If thought proper, the advisory committee may seek the help of the national executive to subsidize the book out of the royalty obtained from the sale of the text-book.
- (10) A new advisory committee will be constituted for a new edition of the text-book by the general body.

1. Membership drive:

2. Educational activity among IADVL members:

TRICHOCON AP 2008

We have successfully conducted a CME on hair disorders, "Trichocon AP 2008" on 27th April.It was attended by about 240 dermatologists including the faculty. There were about 225 registrations and the activity was appreciated by one and all. It was for the first time that a CME of this scale and magnitude was conducted under the banner of IADVL in the state of AP.

The activity was held at The Alumni hall, Gandhi Medical College, Hyderabad.

COSMECON AP 2008

A cosmetology/surgical cosmetology workshop and CME was organized on 27th July at Hotel Golconda, Hyderabad. Speakers from various parts of India participated as faculty. About 250 delegates, from all over Andhra Pradesh attended the program.

CUTICON ANDHRAPRADESH 2008

Cuticon AP 2008, the 27th annual state conference was held on 8th and 9th of November at Taramati Baradari, Hyderabad. The 2-day scientific program went on smoothly but about an hour behind schedule. The highlight was the attendance. About 370 delegates participated in the annual meeting. Surprisingly on Sunday afternoon after the Valedictory, there were still about 300 people at lunch. There were 2 orations, 5 plenary sessions comprising of 11 speakers, 2 panel discussions and a quiz, besides the free papers, award papers and poster presentations. Out of the 23 faculty, 10 speakers were from outside the state and the rest were local luminaries from the state of AP. Only 34 papers could be accommodated because of time constraint. 10 books," Dermatology" by Jean Bolognia were awarded to 10 meritorious participants. Dr S Sacchidanand, National IADVL president, released an e -souvenir cum abstract book on the occasion.

A CD of the proceedings of Cuticon AP 2008, including the plenary and other program is being written and will be distributed to all the members of IADVL AP. Preliminary round of the IADVL Glaxo National Quiz was conducted by Dr Abir Saraswat, with Dr V K Somani as the observer.

The general body meeting was held on 8/11/08 at about 6 pm.

It was decided to purchase a flat in Hyderabad to function as a central permanent office of IADVL, AP. There is a blog section where members can interact with each other on various issues pertaining to the specialty.

5. World psoriasis day:

On Oct 29th, on the occasion of world psoriasis day, free psoriasis detection and treatment camps were held at 4 places in Hyderabad. Dr D B N Murthy, Dr A Durgaprasad, Dr I S Reddy and Dr V K Somani conducted the camps.

6. Updating member records:

We felt an acute necessity of correct members' addresses when we took over. So we have painstakingly collected the member details from all over the state. We are planning to print a totally current and updated member records directory for the state of AP before 31st Dec 2008.





- **Dr. S. Sacchidanand**: People doing DDV currently can be made PLMs and once they clear FCPS / DNB they can be made they clear FCPS / DNB they can be made LM.
- **Dr. V.K. Sinha:** if not recognized by university then they should not to be made LM.
- **Dr. S. Sacchidanand/ Dr. Gurmohan Singh** / P.hd without DVD / MD cannot be made members of IADVL.
- **Dr. S. Sacchidanand;** If degree are entered in MCI registration certification then they can be made LM.
- **Dr. Rajeev Sharma** suggested to set standards for becoming members.
- **Dr. Kamleshwar Kumar:** Avoid MCI recognition as criteria. Only allow government recognized degree.
- **Dr. S. Sacchidanand** allow all members who are qualified dermatologists.
- **Dr. A.K. Jha Amar**: Allow Ams and OMs to continue, only LM & PLM can cause financial crisis.
- **Dr. Rajeev Sharma** told only 11 OMS are there in IADVL roster.

Psoriasis Society of India based at Chennai.

On behalf of psoriasis society of India, it gives me immense pleasure to inform you that PSI has established 2 research awards to motivate to find the cause and cure for psoriasis in India.

The details of the awards are

- 1. Prof. P.N.BEHL'S AWARD; This will be presented to best dermatologist in the country for treating psoriasis and psoriatic arthritis patients. This award consists of Rs.10, 000 cash and IFPA certificate. Criteria for this award are minimum of 5 yrs experience in treating psoriasis patients and presentation of 2 research papers in any of the national conference about psoriasis. The nominee will be selected jointly by PSI and IADVL Regional representatives.
- 2. Prof. PATRICK YESUDIAN AWARD; This will be presented to M.D.Derma students for doing best thesis in psoriasis. This award consists of Rs 7,000 cash and IFPA certificate. The nominee will be selected jointly by PSI and IADVL Regional representatives.
- Both these awards will be sponsored by Win-Medicare Pvt.ltd and will be presented by PSI PRESIDENT in every year DERMACON with effect from 2010.

- Members will not miss their conference outing once a year as they are doing now by attending a zonal conference or a national conference each year.
- There will be more posts available to preside at the national conference or four zonal conferences for senior members who want to serve and guide the association.

I.A.D.V.L. TEXT BOOK OF DERMATOLOGY ADVISORY COMMITTEE

- (1) The textbook advisory committee has been approved and its members have been named by the central council.
- (2) The advisory committees will oversee the arrangements to bring out a new edition of the text-book periodically at an appropriate time.
- (3) The advisory committee will ask the editor/s at that time to convene a meeting of the editorial board, constituted by the editors in consultation with the advisory committee to assign the chapters on the different subjects to the authors who will be decided by the board.
- (4) The editor/s should obtain a written or E-mail consent by the author to update the chapter or write a new chapter and submit it within a stipulated time-frame. If the author does not submit the chapter in the stipulated time, the editor/ and the advisory committee will cancel the assignment. The editor/s with the help of editorial board

assign that chapter to another author following the due procedure.

- assign that chapter to another author following the due procedure.
- (5) If any chapter is not found of the standard required for the text-book, the editor/s will inform the advisory committee. The advisory committee may authorize the editor/s to return the chapter and may assign the chapter to another author following the due procedure.
- (6) Any difference of opinion expressed in the editorial board meeting may be resolved by the advisory committee, whose opinion should be binding.
- (7) Any legal matter pertaining to the text-book may be discussed by the editor/s with the advisory committee and appropriate action should be decided, if necessary in consultation with the president of I.A.D.V.L. and its executive.
- (8) Any dispute/difference with publisher may reported by the editor/s to the advisory committee. The advisory committee will help to resolve dispute/difference by interacting with the publishers.
- (9) The price of the text-book should be decided by publisher in consultation with the editor/s. It should be approved by the advisory committee. If thought proper, the advisory committee may seek the help of the national executive to subsidize the book out of the royalty obtained from the sale of the text-book. Royalty obtained from the sale of the text-book.
- (10) A new advisory committee will be constituted for a new edition of the text-book by the general body.

the annual calendar of IADVL. However, the meeting incurs huge expenditure. While the initial meetings were sponsored by pharma companies, expenses of the 2008 MIDERMAMEET meeting had to be borne entirely by IADVL due to lack of sponsorship. We understand the expenses involved were huge, amounting to several lakhs. We are deeply concerned with this situation and feel that if such a situation continues in future, with huge annual withdrawals form corpus amount of IADVL, the financial health of our association will be seriously compromised. In view of this, we would like to suggest the following:

- 1. Every effort will be made by the executive committee to procure sponsorships for the MIDERMAMEET.
- Travel and accommodation expenses of all members attending the meeting may be reimbursed from the sponsorship,, either partially or completely, depending on the amount of sponsorship.
- 3. If sponsorship is not available, then travel and accommodation expenses of members will not be reimbursed by IADVL funds. IADVL funds will be used only for arranging the venue, audiovisual expenses, lunch for attendees and expenses of executive committee members only. All other members attending the meeting(such as former presidents, central council members etc) will bear their expenses/or be sponosred by their state associations. The upper limit for such an expense to be incured by IADVL will not exceed Rs 3 Lakhs. This amount will be drawn from the interest accrued on IADVL deposits and NOT from the corpus fund. ON no occasion and for no reason what ever, will any money be withdrawn from corpus fund. We request this august body to deliberate on our suggestions and issue appropriate directions.

We wish to submit the following points for deliberations by the AGM in DERMACON 2009 Bengaluru. We request you to kindly include them in the agenda

1.Conference website: Presently website of each dermacon conference is a separate and new website designed by the local organizing committee. This means that each website has a new name, new design, new text and is different form previous conference websites. Each organizing committee has to put on a lot of time and money to design this. We suggest that hereafter, all future conference websites will be designed from the existing IADVL website and will be named as www.iadvl.org/dermacon2009 or 2010 or 2011 etc

The advantages of such a system would be:

- a) uniformity
- b) link to an existing mother website

- c) easier access and easier recognition
- d) less work for org committee- all common sessions and their rules(such as award session, quiz) etc have just to be copied.
- e) Scientific program, speakers, rules for abstract submission etc will be easily available for reference; this will help to design scientific program properly and to avoid repetitions
- All abstracts to be linked to this website and hence can be read any time later also.

We request that such a system be adopted from DERMACON 2010. Similar system may be adopted for state conferences also.

Proposal for MID DERMACON: DERMACON has become a huge conference with nearly 4000 delegates making it difficult to organize. Presently it can be organized only by few large cities. This is denying opportunity for smaller 2 tier cities to organize national level meets. In view of this we propose that IADVL organize a summer meeting, which can be termed as MID-DERMACON, in the months of May-July 2009. We also suggest that in stead of organizing this as a new conference, a zonal conference (on rotating basis between each zones) be elevated to the national level and named as MID DERMACON. In other words one zonal conference each year will become MID DERMACON and this would pass on from zone to zone. It will thus be held in each zone once in 4-5 years.

In addition to giving opportunity for smaller cities to host conference, it would also bring in additional revenue to the IADVL. It would also have another advantage- the Central council meeting can be clubbed with this conference and hence the expenditure currently being incurred on CC meetings (running in to several lakhs as in last year) will be avoided as all central council members would arrive as delegates (as it now happens for DERMACON CC meeting).

We request the august body to consider these points.

I am forwarding this letter of Dr Pannikar to your office. As president of IADVL it would be nice if you can send



a rejoinder to Messers Banot publications expressing our associations stand supporting Dr Pannikar and asking them to delete those offending paragraphs.

The offending text is on page 390 under the Chapter 8-Demography and Family Planning subsection- Family Planning item b.-foetal health, which states _ "the quality of population can be improved only by avoiding completely unwanted births, compulsory sterilization of all the adults who are suffering from certain diseases such as Leprosy and psychosis."

Similarly on page 277 under leprosy Control and item Others it states that "preventing contact with infectious cases and fomites is an accepted methods for controlling the spread for any communicable disease, and leprosy is no exception."

Such statements made at a time when programmes are trying to reduce stigma and discrimination against people suffering from leprosy and mental ill health. I consider this as a gross violation of basic human rights and against human dignity. The way the subject matte has been dealt with displays a total lack of understanding of leprosy and its control. Such statement in reputed textbooks of medicine would have disastrous consequences on management and control of

communicable diseases in generally and leprosy control in particular in India.

In the same textbook on page 268 under Chapter 5 Epidemiology of communicable diseases, section V Surface Infections., under the heading Leprosy, item social pathology which states that "Over the centuries, a legend has grown around leprosy that it is highly contagious and that it is incurable. Even today, in spite of scientific information available about leprosy, this legend is deeply rooted in the minds of most people at all levels of society, with the result that social ostracism is apparent everywhere."

Under the same heading on page 277, under Health education, under item General Public it states "the public should be made aware that leprosy is not a hereditary disease; it's a bacterial disease like tuberculosis; it is curable; not all leprosy patients are infectious; regular and adequate treatment is essential to obtain cure and prevent disabilities, and that the patient needs sympathy and social support."
